

Low pressure will move over the wildfire late on Saturday, bringing increased wind but also a bit higher humidities. Recoveries should be good by late Saturday night as colder air works into the area. Higher relative humidity and cooler temperatures will move in Sunday and persist through early next week.

> Structure Protection: Wildland Urban Interface Firefighting: IRPG pg. 12-16.

Abandoned Mines: Vertical shafts may be hundreds of feet deep, and hidden by vegetation. Horizontal openings may seem sturdy, but cave in is a real danger.

Walker Mine

If the fire reaches the mine tailings, firefighters should avoid the area. A buffer zone of ½ mile from burning silica dust should be observed. No suppression activities should be initiated in the closure area. If installing containment lines in the area, use existing roads around the mine tailings. Stay out of the area between the roads and the tailings.

Hazard Tree Indicators:

- ✓ Trees that have burned.
- ✓ Shallow tree root systems.
- ✓ Dead & broken top trees.
- ✓ Leaning or hung up trees.


