

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A low pressure system in the Gulf of Alaska will pivot several small scale weather disturbances through the Pacific Northwest and far northern California over the next several days. One of these disturbances past to the north Saturday night bringing gusty evening winds to be followed oday by cooler temperatures and higher humidity. Lighter winds are expected today as Norcal sits between systems. Another one of these systems will move into the Pacific Northwest on Monday keeping conditions mild and bringing increased winds but not as strong as we saw yesterday. Yet another weather system will pivot through Norcal on Tuesday bringing still cooler temperatures, higher RH and even a chance for showers.

WEATHER FORECAST:

WEATHER: Mostly Sunny except smoke in the valley through about noon.

TEMPERATURES: Maximum temperatures 75 to 83.

HUMIDITY: Minimum humidity 22-27%.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - West winds 2 to 5 mph in the morning hours picking up after about 1100 to 5-10 mph with gusts up to about 15 to occasionally 20 mph in the late afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light downslope in the morning becoming upcanyon mainly southwest to northwest 3 to 6 mph with occasional gusts to 14 mph in the afternoon.

HAINES INDEX: 3

STABILITY/INVERSION: More stable than on Saturday with inversions breaking around noon.

OUTLOOK FOR Sunday night: Scattered clouds developing. Minimum temperatures 35-45. Max RH recovery 70-80% ridges to over 85% lower slopes. Winds southwest to west 5-10 mph on the ridges after about 2000 becoming light downslope on the slopes

OUTLOOK FOR Monday: Scattered clouds. Max temperatures 70-78. Min RH 27-34%. Ridge winds southwest to west 10-15 mph with occasional gusts to 20 mph. Slope winds mainly southwest to northwest 6-10 mph with gusts up to about 15 mph.

Extended forecast for Tuesday: Mostly Cloudy with a chance of showers or afternoon thunderstorms. Max temperatures 65-73. Ridge winds mainly northwest 5-10 mph gusts to 15 mph. Slope winds upslope to upcanyon mainly southwest to northwest 5-10 mph.



MAJOR HAZARDS AND RISKS

- Driving: Slow down; less than 20 through Taylorsville. Fasten seatbelts and use backers.
- > Hazard Trees: Assess ALL Trees in Work Areas....In addition to suppression and mop-up operations, assess hazard trees when you take breaks and park vehicles. Check out your IRPG pgs. 22-23.
- Abandoned Mines: Vertical shafts may be hundreds of feet deep, and hidden by vegetation. Horizontal openings may seem sturdy, but cave in is a real danger. Lethal concentrations of deadly gases can accumulate in underground passages.
- Transition: Risks to fireline personnel increase during transfer of command periods regardless of the size or complexity of the incident.
- Marijuana Grows: There is always the possibility of illegal marijuana grows in the fire area. These sites are known to contain extremely toxic insecticides and/or rodenticides etc. If you see unusual containers be cautious.

Fire Order of the Day:

Give Clear instructions and ensure they are understood

- Ensure all are involved in your briefing within your span of control
- Communicate hazards to others
- Acknowledge messages and instructions
- ASK IF YOU DON'T KNOW OR UNDERSTAND!!

Know the medical plan before you need it. Three answers to know.

- ✓ What are you going to do if someone gets hurt?
- ✓ How will you get them out of here?
- ✓ How long will it take to get them to a hospital?

Don't forget.....

BE ALERT....Situation Awareness KEEP CALM.....Leadership

THINK CLEARLY....Risk Management ACT DECISIVELY....Accountability
