<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> A large low pressure system over the Pacific Northwest coast will move inland over the next couple of days pivoting small weather disturbances across northern California along the way. One of these small scale systems will pass through Norcal on Monday, continuing the slow cooling and higher RH trend and bringing continued breezy afternoon winds. Another slightly stronger system will pass through Norcal on Tuesday bringing even cooler temperatures and higher humidity as well as a chance of light showers or an afternoon thunderstorm. The main upper low will move to the east by mid week bringing a warming and drying trend for the second half of the week.

### **WEATHER FORECAST:**

WEATHER: Scattered clouds with smoke in the valleys through about noon.

TEMPERATURES: Maximum temperatures 67 to 73 highest to lowest elevations.

HUMIDITY: Minimum humidity 27 to 32 percent.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Winds generally light and variable early morning hours, picking up after about noon to southwest to west 10 to 15 mph with occasional gusts 20-25 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - Light downslope in the morning becoming mainly southwest to northwest 6-10 mph after about noon with gusts up to about 15-20 mph in aligned drainages late afternoon.

HAINES INDEX: 3

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversions breaking around noon. Slightly less stable than Sunday.

<u>OUTLOOK FOR Monday Night:</u> Partly to mostly cloudy. Minimum temperatures mainly in the 40s. Good humidity recovery at 75-85%. Ridge winds dropping off after sunset becoming west to northwest 4-8 mph after midnight. Slope winds becoming light downslope after midnight.

<u>OUTLOOK FOR Tuesday:</u> Mostly Cloudy with a chance of showers and a slight chance of afternoon thunderstorms. Max temperatures 63-69. Min RH 33-40%. Ridge winds mainly northwest 5-10 mph gusts to 15 mph. Slope winds upslope to upcanyon mainly southwest to northwest 5-10 mph.

Extended forecast for Wednesday. Skies clearing. Temperatures warming to the lower 70s to near 80. Ridge winds northwest to northeast 5-10 mph gusts to 15 mph. Slope winds upslope 4-8 gusts to 12 mph.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

### INPUTS:

Fuels: Increased humidity and cloudiness will reduce fine fuel availability and fuel temperature.

Topography: Slopes with higher fuel loading will continue to support fire movement.

\*\* Areas along Hwy 395 \*\* - If fire crests the ridge above the escarpment: Evening and night environmental conditions are not typical along the escarpment. Fire positioned above (West) Hwy 395 will push downhill with little or no notice. especially at and after sundown. Anticipate downslope winds with a magnitude of 15 mph. Eagle Fire 1989, Doyle Fire 1994, and Cemetery Fire 1999 all exhibited this phenomena.

FIRE BEHAVIOR: Expect a decrease on fire behavior toady. Slope runs remain possible with moderate range spotting as fire tops ridges. Timbered locations will see the greatest fire behavior

DIV X: Lighter fuels South of Antelope Lake will be less receptive to fire movement and spotting. However, spots established in the Boulder Creek drainage near Hallett Meadow will have ample fuel to make significant runs toward Lowe Flat (North) and Thompson Peak (East).

DIV V: Fire in the Dry Flat area should close the gap with erratic fire behavior as the two fronts converge. Fire moving up Clarks Creek will encounter heavier timber fuels that will enhance fire behavior.

DIV Q&M: Lighter fuels West of Lone Spring Mtn. will inhibit fire spread until the beginning of the burn period. Some moderate pockets of fuel in drainage bottoms could produce short runs with spotting.

DIV I&K: Drainages in the Rodgers Creek system contain large amounts of fuel. Forecast winds will be in alignment with these drainages. Expect touching, slope runs and spotting during the burn period. Long range spotting has been observed and remains probable.

DIV E&G: Expect fire to move through the heavy fuels of Mt. Ingalls. 267638 Creek and the Big Pine Springs area would be in wind/slope alignment. Torching and crown runs are possible along with long range spotting.

DIV K: Fire will back off the ridge above Ward Creek to the West. Rollout with short upslope runs are possible along ridges and road 25N42.

DIV A&C: Fire will continue to flank and run through the heavier fuel on the slopes of Wheeler Peak. Slope runs will be possible during the height of the burn period. Fire behavior could be enhanced by the Indian Creek drainage (Road 29N43).

### AIR OPERATIONS

Inversion should lift around 1200 with reduced visibility on the East side due to smoke.

### SAFETY

\*\* Escarpment winds can change direction quickly and with little warning. Monitor smoke column for early signs of shifting winds and have alternate escape routes identified.\*\*

### **Incident Management Team Transition**

- Sometimes called the 19<sup>th</sup> Watch Out Situation.
- Take the time to understand the plan. Ensure all resources completely understand the assignment, the Communications Plan, and the Medical Plan.
- Briefings: Required every shift, for all personnel, for new assignments, and for changing conditions.

### Watch Out Situation #4

### Unfamiliar with weather and local factors influencing fire behavior

- Recognize and communicate any change in fire behavior
- Monitor weather conditions throughout the shift and broadcast them to all resources on the division

### Driving

- When driving keep the speed at or below the posted speed limit and turn your headlights on. Is the posted speed limit a safe speed under the current conditions and traffic?
- Use caution on unimproved roads as some have soft shoulders. Some roads are also only one lane with pullouts!
- Road surfaces are variable with washboard conditions and thick dust that can compromise turning and braking.
- Watch for and anticipate stock and wildlife especially from dusk to dawn.
- Always fasten your seat belt before the vehicle is set into motion. Use backers.
- Don't tail gate, especially in dusty conditions.
- Slow down, slow down, and slow down!

### **Personal Safety**

 Make yourself visible to vehicle traffic while working on, or near roads. Use your headlamp or glow sticks.

INCIDENT RISK ANALYSIS (ICS 215a) Day Shift BR/ DIV HAZARDOUS ACTIONS / CONDITIONS MITIGATIONS / WARNINGS / REMEDIES Practice "Defensive Driving" techniques. Traffic volume is high. Use spotters when backing. TRAFFIC HAZARDS AND Always use headlights. ALL Use warning lights when working on roads or traveling in smoke. DRIVING Observe posted speed limits. Use chock blocks, turn wheels into hill. Many roads are narrow and mid slope, use caution. Follow Hazard Tree Safety Guidelines (IRPG p.22-23). Limit number of personnel around snags and their exposure time; fallers must be HAZARD / DANGER TREES ALL qualified for the trees being felled. Be especially alert around snags during wind events. Large green trees can also be dangerous. Follow the line construction protocols and safety precautions for direct and indirect line construction. Watch footing and spacing between firefighters, especially those working below. LINE CONSTRUCTION ALL Make sure LCES is in place. Follow the "Downhill Line Construction Checklist" on IRPG page 9. Do not work above any personnel. Evaluate necessity to send personnel in areas with limited access. Share your Situational Awareness (hazards, changes, etc.) to those who also have a need Radio Communications may be poor in some areas: use human repeaters as needed. ALL COMMUNICATIONS Ensure all personnel are familiar with the incident and IA communications plans. Make sure all resources have radios cloned appropriately. Ensure that non-agency resources understand radio use and procedures. Ensure communications are established with operators. **HEAVY EQUIPMENT** Ensure ground personnel have safety illumination, with light-sticks being the minimum. ALL Maintain a 50'-100' exclusion area around equipment. **OPERATIONS** In timber increase safety distance to 2 ½ times canopy height. Be alert for signs of fatigue and take breaks as necessary. Maintain 2:1 work/rest ratio. Monitor ALL resources for level of fatigue. Recognize the symptoms of fatigue and take action as necessary to provide rest and FATIGUE / COMPLACENCY ALL recovery. Repeated assignments in the same area can lead to complacency making personnel more vulnerable to accidents. Take steps (switching of assignments, training opportunities during slow periods, etc.) to maintain situational awareness for the duration of the incident Conduct thorough assessments before starting work. ### CALIFORNIA INTERAGENCY INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM 4 EXPECTATIONS

### **CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR**

This team is committed to "ZERO TOLERANCE" of careless, illegal, inappropriate and unsafe actions.

Alcohol and/or illegal drugs are NOT allowed within the incident environment or while actively assigned to the incident. Local Law Enforcement Officials will be called to deal with any suspected illegal activities. Each employee has the responsibility to be ready, willing, and able to perform the duties for which they are qualified.

### Sexual Harassment

Inappropriate actions or comments will not be tolerated. Everyone is expected to act in a professional manner. It is your responsibility to stop inappropriate actions or comments immediately upon becoming aware of such. Sexual Harassment must be reported to the Human Resource Specialist or Incident Commander. When outside of your designated sleeping area, you are required to wear at least a shirt, appropriate shorts, and shoes or sandals. If you need clarification of these expectations contact the Human Resource Specialist or IC. What we PERMIT we PROMOTE!!!!

### **SAFETY**

The commitment to and accountability for safety is a joint responsibility of firefighters, managers and administrators. Individuals must personally be committed and responsible for their own performance and accountability. Everyone assigned to this incident can expect an assignment that follows all safety rules & regulations. Every person is expected to perform his or her duties in compliance with all known safety practices at all times. Anything less is unacceptable.

### **EMPHASIS AREAS**

### **Training**

All trainees and trainers are expected to follow the procedures outlined in the California Interagency Incident Management Team 4 **Training Expectations** – **See back page**.

### **Evaluations**

All supervisory personnel assigned will complete an ICS 225 Incident Personnel Performance Rating form for their assigned resources according to agency policy or contractual agreement.

### Injuries/Claims

Ensure all injuries and potential claims are reported to the Comp/Claims Unit for completion of appropriate paperwork. Contract claims will be reported to the Procurement Unit Leader.

### Work Rest Cycles

The 2: 1 work/rest ratio is mandatory. For every two hours on shift you will be required to rest for one hour. Every effort shall be used to limit work hours to a maximum of 16. If circumstances require you to exceed 16 hours, this needs to be coordinated in advance with your supervisor and the Justification/Mitigation form completed to support the excessive hours prior to submitting for approval by the IC. It is your responsibility to comply with this direction and provide the appropriate documentation to your Supervisor and Finance.

### **Position Qualifications**

Personnel shall only be assigned to positions for which they are qualified. Proof of qualifications shall be approved prior to being assigned to any fire line position. Non-fireline positions may be filled based on the word of the employee pending home unit confirmation, which must be requested immediately. Contract dozer operators, tactical water tender operators and contract fallers must provide proof that they have received the annual fire refresher training.

### Engagement/Disengagement

The 10 Standard Orders & 18 Watchout Situations will be followed at all times and mitigated as needed. Staying aware of your situation is critical. This includes Geographic Area and incident briefings. Follow the Risk Management Process outlined in the Incident Response Pocket Guide.

### **Debriefing**

All Branch Directors/Division/Group Supervisors will report to their Supervisor and Situation Unit at the end of the operational period for debriefing with emphasis on the accomplishment of objectives. All unit logs (ICS 214) will be turned in after the debriefing to Documentation reflecting accomplishment and/or special incidents that occurred during the operational period.

### **Crew Time Reports/Shift Tickets**

It is your responsibility to ensure all time is properly accounted for and recorded each shift. The records are to be <u>reviewed and signed</u> by the next level supervisor. A finance "Rules of Engagement" document will be provided in the IAP explaining further requirements.

### Social Media

It is your responsibility to know and understand guidelines for firefighter photography, video and social media use. California Interagency Incident Management Team 4 goal is simple: to participate online in a respectful, relevant way that protects our incident's professional reputation, does not confuse the public about the incident and follows the letter and spirit of the law. Be mindful that social media postings can be viewed as unprofessional, damage careers and lead to disciplinary actions. For further information, contact the Public Information Officer.
