WEATHER DISCUSSION: An approaching Pacific frontal system will bring strong southwest winds across the fire area today. The area out ahead of this front will be quite dry and unstable so another day of very low humidity is expected. The combination of strong winds and low humidity will produce Red Flag conditions today. The strong winds will continue into the Sunday night period as the Pacific front continues to approach the area. At this time it appears the main cold front will begin bringing rainfall to the fire area sometime mid morning Monday. Wetting rain is expected Monday with a threat of thunderstorms in the afternoon. Any shower threat should end by Monday evening with dry conditions expected Tuesday.

WEATHER FORECAST:

WEATHER: Fair skies. Limited morning valley fog. Some high clouds in the afternoon. .

TEMPERATURES: Highs 75 to 82.

HUMIDITY: Min RH 10-18%

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 8-12 gusts to 20 mph in the morning increasing through the morning and afternoon. Afternoon ridge winds 15-20 mph with gusts up to 40 mph

Minimum RH occurring early morning before rain begins at 55-65%. Southwest ridge and upper west slope winds 10-15 gusts 30 decreasing in the afternoon. Slope winds Southwest to northwest 6-10 gusts to 15 mph decreasing in the afternoon.

Extended forecast for Tuesday: Valley fog in the morning clearing to fair skies by late morning. Maximum temperatures 60-65. Min RH 28-38%. Afternoon southwest ridge winds southwest to west 5-10 gusts 15 mph. Slope winds upslope to upcanyon 3-8 gusts to 12 mph in the afternoon.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

INPUTS:

- Fuels: Live and dead fuel moistures continue to decline. 10Hr fuels are in the single digits, current RAWS observations are 5-7% (7% is critical). Fuels above 4500' will be drier then fuels below 4500'.
- Topography: Be aware of the alignment of wind and topography. Wind speeds traveling through steep canyons can become compressed and increase in speed.
- Weather: Red Flag Warning for Strong winds. Atmospheric instability.

FIRE BEHAVIOR: We're entering a critical burn environment with wind being the key component coupled with low RH. Expect an increase in surface spread. All divisions in the East Zone will see the greatest potential for isolated torching, small slope runs and spotting. Spotting distances may excess .5 miles. When the inversion lifts by mid-morning, fire behavior may increase over the entire fire area.

Day-DIV A: There is and increased potential for small slope runs and moderate fire behavior in receptive fuel beds. Antelope dip is an area of vulnerability. Fuels burning near the line are a threat for spotting.

Night-DIV A: Expect a decrease in activity as cooler temps and wind moderates.

Day-DIV C/E: Fire behavior will be minimal on both divisions, with the Wheeler peak area having the greatest potential. Any open line could experience slope runs. Be mindful of wind vortices caused by steep terrain.

Night-DIVC/E: Minimal fire activity. Direct suppression should be successful.

Day-DIV F/G: Winds have proven to become unpredictable throughout the intersecting drainages. Expect and increase in fire behavior and activity.

Night-DIV F/G: Fire activity may be minimal. The potential still exists for flanking and creeping

Day-DIV I/K/M: Burning islands near the fire line can cast embers up to and possibly exceed .5 miles. Conditions will change in the afternoon as wind gust develop. Expect an increase in fire behavior throughout the shift in the Clover Dip. Railroad Dip and Beaver Dip area.

Night-DIV I/K/M: the potential for nighttime fire activity is possible with the predicted wind. Expect upslope runs, Flanking and spotting.

Day-DIV Q/V/X: Containment lines may be tested by strong winds. Spotting can occur up to and may exceed .5 miles. Night-DIV Q/V/X: Fire activity should be less as strong winds subside and temps decrease.

Keep Your Head in the Game!

Driving

- When driving keep speed at or below the posted speed limit and your headlights on.
- Stay as far to the right of the road as is safely possible.
- Stay alert for oncoming traffic that may "cheat" into your lane.
- Schools back in session, watch for school busses and children at bus stops.
- Always fasten your seat belt before the vehicle is set into motion.
- Slow down, slow down, slow down.

Summary of Suppression Damage Repair Guidelines

Objectives - The objective of the fire suppression is to repair areas disturbed by fire suppression activities into a condition that does not negatively affect natural and cultural resources and will not create to excessive erosion on the landscape. Without compromising public and firefighter safety.

- Reduce the potential for soil erosion and sedimentation
- Reduce the visual impacts of fire line as well other suppression activities when feasible
- Repair roads and drainage structures to a functioning condition
- Protect natural and cultural resources from additional potential damage

Critical Guidelines

Sensitive Sites are marked with yellow and black or red and black striped flagging.


Back-hauled all trash and un-needed flagging. Please leave safety flagging in place.


On Firelines, waterbars should be installed as described below, fire line covered with slash, and entrances blocked.

Dozer Line

Fire line Gradient	Distance Between
(% slope)	Waterbars (A) (feet)
0 to 10	No waterbars needed
10 to 20	100
21 to 40	75
41 to 60 (B)	50 (B)

- (A) These are guidelines and are not intended to restrict the implementation of more or less water bars if the need or lack of need is justified.
- (B) Firefighter safety should be taken into account; if slopes are too steep for safe implementation then waterbars should not be constructed, if sensitive resources are not present.
- DEPTH AND WIDTH: Waterbars need to be cut into surface, do not simply push up soil.
 - Waterbar depths for **dozer lines** should be at least 6 inches; total height from bottom of ditch to the top of the waterbar should average at least 18 inches and not exceed 24 inches.
 - Waterbar depths for **hand lines** should be at least 4 inches; total height from bottom of ditch to top of waterbar should average at least 8 inches and not exceed 12 inches.





Helispots, Safety Zone, Spike Camp, and Staging Areas: These fire suppression activity areas should be repaired to standards similar to fire line repair. Waterbars place where appropriate. Use cleared vegetative material, and slash for soil cover

Watercourses: Remove deposited soil from streams, watercourses, swales, or draws back to the original contour. Remove only as much as feasible without further damage to the watercourse. Restore bank channels at fire line crossings back to the shape seen adjacent to the crossing. Pull perched soil from drainage edges and spread it evenly across the fire line.

- Do not remove large woody debris which was in the channel prior to the fire, bucked limbs and logs in watercourses from fire suppression activities should be removed from the watercourse.
- Where fire lines are constructed within 100 feet of intermittent and perennial streams, use certified weed free straw, wood strands, or slash to increase soil cover and prevent sediment from entering the stream channel.


Summary of Suppression Damage Repair Guidelines


Water Drafting Sites: Water sources developed as a water draft site are to be restored to a condition resembling pre fire use. Remove any dams, dikes, or other impoundments that were created for fire suppression activities.


Concentrations of Slash: Concentrations of slash created by fire suppression activities along roadways, developed recreation areas, and among structures should be chipped and spread across the cleared area. Chip piles should not exceed 6 inches in depth. Where appropriate, concentrations of slash can be lopped and scattered, not to exceed 18 inches in height.

OTHER SUPPRESSION DAMAGE REPAIR NEEDS:

- Repair fences, gates, and cattle guards so that they are functional. These repairs must be related to suppression fire activities.
- Hazard trees should be felled if they pose a safety threat to the general public. Hazard trees to be felled will be identified and marked by a Division Group Supervisor or Felling Boss, using the R5 Hazard Tree Guide.
