<p>In the event of a medical emergency contact Plumas Dispatch. The District Duty Officer will be contacted and will either supervise the response, monitor the response if his supervision is not needed, or delegate supervision. Nearest medical personnel will initiate treatment and determine the need for additional medical personnel at the scene and will determine most appropriate evacuation method if needed.</p> <p><b>Serious Trauma or Life Threatening Injury or Illness:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Contact Plumas Dispatch over the Command Repeater Channel</li> <li>2. Request that the designated frequency be cleared for emergency traffic</li> <li>3. Identify the on-scene Point of Contact (POC) by Resource and Last name</li> <li>4. Communicate current status and needs using the Patient Assessment form from the Briefing Guide or IRPG</li> <li>5. Identify on-scene medical personnel by position and name (i.e. EMT Jones)</li> <li>6. Document all information received and transmitted on the radio or phone</li> <li>7. Identify any changes in the on-scene Point of Contact or medical personnel as they occur.</li> <li>8. After patient has been transported contact the District Duty Officer</li> </ol> <p><b>Non Emergency Medical</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Contact Plumas Dispatch and the District Duty Officer</li> <li>2. Use the Patient Assessment in the Briefing Guide or the IRPG if needed.</li> <li>3. Determine best transportation method</li> <li>4. Duty Officer or designee will meet crew leader and patient at the hospital</li> </ol>
