CONTINUED FOOR RH RECOVERY. WINDS SHOULD REMAIN FAIRLY LIGHT AND TERRAIN DRIVEN

FRIDAY THROUGH SATURDAY. A STRONGER TROUGH APPROACHES THE BURN AREA ON SUNDAY

BRINING A RENEWED THREAT OF THUNDERSTORMS ALONG WITH COOLER TEMPERATURES AND


