WEATHER DISCUSSION: The upper level low pressure that has been nearly stationary off the Pacific Northwest coast will move into Oregon Thursday afternoon. Will maintain good maximum relative humidity recovery through Friday morning. Minimum relative humidity's will range from around 40% mid-slopes to 55% ridge-tops. Wind gusts up to 25 mph can be expected during the afternoon and early evening. For Friday and Saturday, much warmer air and lower relative humidity's will occur. This is forecast to continue through next week.

The fire will remain fuels & topography driven. Fire spread continues to be from heavier fuels burning log to log and rolling material. Falling snags will challenge containment lines and will increase the potential for fire spread over barriers that would normally hold the fire. Rates of spread will be from 1 to 8 chains per hour with flame lengths 1-4 feet in the timber. With the present alignment of our fire expect mainly backing and flanking fire. Short uphill runs are probable where heavy fuels, brush and slope align. Spotting if any will be short range less than 400feet.

#### **SPECIFIC:**

#### What Happens When You Get It:

Once urushiol touches the skin, it begins to penetrate in minutes. It is completely bound to the skin within 8 hours. Urushiol is the oil inside the plant that caused the allergic reaction to 70% of the population

You may develop any or all of the following:


- Red Rash
- **Blisters**
- Swelling

#### What To Do When You Get It:

Stop the symptoms before they start. If you know you've been exposed, cleanse the area immediately with plain soap and water to remove urushiol before it has a chance to bind to the skin. To remove the oil from your skin, scrub the area for several minutes. but do not break the skin, then rinse with cool water for several minutes. Once the area has been cleansed you may need to apply

a topic ointment or further medical treatment.






