.DISCUSSION...

HIGH PRESSURE BUILDS INTO THE AREA FROM THE EASTERN PACIFIC ON SATURDAY BRINGING WARMER TEMPERATURES. NORTHERLY WINDS WILL INCREASE OVER THE WEEKEND AS THE SURFACE PRESSURE GRADIENTS STRENGTHENS. THE WINDS TURNS MORE NORTHEASTERLY BY MONDAY MORNING. BREEZY NORTH WINDS ARE EXPECTED THROUGH THE WEEKEND BUT THE STRONGEST WINDS ARE EXPECTED SUNDAY AND SUNDAY NIGHT ESPECIALLY ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF THE SACRAMENTO VALLEY AND COAST RANGE FOOTHILLS. THE GUSTY NORTHERLY WINDS ALONG WITH LOW HUMIDITIES WILL BRING CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF THE SACRAMENTO VALLEY AND COASTAL RANGE FOOTHILLS SATURDAY NIGHT INTO MONDAY MORNING. BREEZY WINDS AND LOWERING HUMIDITY CAN BE EXPECTED OVER THE SIERRA AS WELL...ESPECIALLY SUNDAY INTO MONDAY. WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO TURN SOUTHERLY ON MONDAY. COOLER AND WET WEATHER IS POSSIBLE TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY WITH A PACIFIC STORM SYSTEM MOVING ACROSS THE AREA.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

HIGH PRESSURE CONTINUES TO BUILD OVER THE FIRE AREA INCREASING THE CHANCE FOR GUSTY NORTH WINDS. THESE CHANGES CAN BRING AN INCREASED RISK FOR PROBLEM FIRE BEHAVIOR. DURING THESE PERIODS LOOK FOR THE FIRE TO CARRY THROUGH POCKETS OF UNBURNED FUEL WITH SHORT RUNS POSSIBLE. SOME SINGLE TREE TORCHING WILL BE POSSIBLE IN AREAS WHERE THE FIRE REMAINS WELL ESTABLISHED.

THRESHOLDS FOR ACTICE FIRE BEHAVIOR RMAIN AT 20' WINDS OVER 5MPH, RH UNDER 22% AND TEMPS OVER 84F.

Package and transport patient to rendezvous with ambulance. Re-route EMS helicopter to rendezvous point as appropriate.

If Declaring an "Incident within the Incident"

The closest DIVS will respond to manage the incident. They are responsible for giving an accurate size up, ensuring scene safety, setting priorities and initiating an appropriate response. The closest Safety Officer and Line EMS will respond to the scene to assist the Branch Director or DIVS. Secure site and begin initial investigation when situation is stabilized.


