NORTHEASTERLY WINDS DIMINISH MONDAY MORNING BEFORE SHIFTING SOUTHERLY BY AFTERNOON. RH WILL INCREASE WITH THE WIND SHIFT. A FRONTAL SYSTEM WILL APPROACH THE AREA TUESDAY WITH INCREASED SOUTH TO SOUTHWEST WINDS. HOWEVER, RAIN WILL STAY AWAY UNTIL THE EVENING AND OVERNIGHT HOURS.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

FUELS: Mature mixed conifer with heavy shrub loading. Fuel loading generally heavy. Live fuel moistures remain dry; dead fuel moistures in sheltered areas remain moist.

THRESHOLDS: ENF Pocket Card, 20ft Winds over 5MPH, Temps over 84, RH under 22 and 1000 HR FMC under 9%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR: Gusty winds and lower RH's from the Red Flag Warning could allow fuels adjacent to heat sources on southerly exposed slopes to carry fire if inline with slope and winds. Interior islands of unburned fuel continue to burnout. Some single tree torching is possible in areas where the fire remains well established.

Keep your boots dry and if they get wet stuff them with dry paper to pull moisture out, use dry sox next shift. If you have wet clothing on switch out when you can into dry clothing and keep that clothing dry. Wet clothes are a big hazard and can lead to hypothermia.
- <u>Muddy roads</u>. Divs and crews need to check out roads before
 you commit engines, crews, and heavy equipment to their work
 areas. There is nothing quite like burying vehicles up to their
 axles in mud or sliding off the road, bending metal parts or worse
 yet injuring someone. So check before you commit.
- FATIGUE: Pace yourself. Think about what you are going to do before you do it. Ensure that all your assigned personnel have good sleeping arrangements. 
