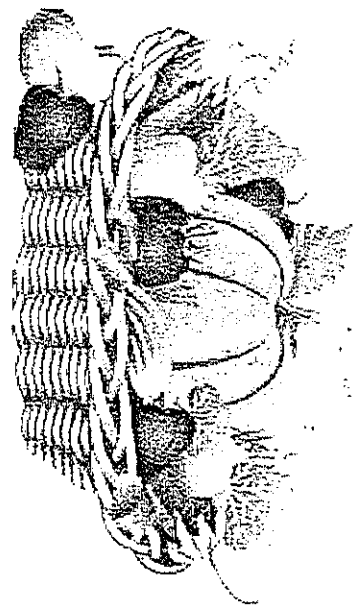

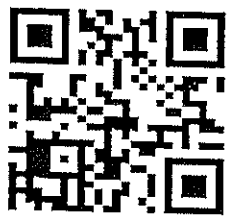

MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES:

- Provide for safety of responders and public.
- Utilize appropriate suppression tactics to secure uncontained fire edge.
- Assess and implement fire suppression repair.
- Establish and maintain positive relationships with cooperating agencies and the public.
- Provide timely and accurate fire information.
- Keep costs commensurate with values at risk.
- Support initial attack within the Temporary Flight Restriction.

CONTROL OBJECTIVES:

- Repair priorities:
 1. pull hose & backhaul fire equipment (pumps, tanks)
 2. water bar dozer and hand lines utilizing the repair plan
 3. open priority roads (hazard tree removal & chipping)
- Keep fire within current perimeter and containment lines.

*** GUSTY NORTHEAST TO EASTERLY WINDS THROUGH EARLY THURSDAY MORNING ***

WEATHER TODAY: Gusty Winds, otherwise Sunny, warmer and drier. Areas of smoke.

TEMPERATURES: 69-79 *Trend: Up 3 to 5 degrees*
RELATIVE HUMIDITY: 13-20% *Trend: Down 15-20%*

20 FT WINDS:

Slope/Valley: East 20-25 mph G35 mph until 1300L...then decreasing 12 to 20 mph.
Ridgetop: East 20-25 mph G35 mph until 1300L...then decreasing 15 to 25 mph.

LAL: 1. STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion to 1700 ft AGL, breaking by 1300.

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Sustained easterly to east-northeasterly winds of 20 to 25 mph with gusts to 35 mph will continue through 1400L, then abate to between 10 and 25 mph. Minimum relative humidities will range between 13-20%. Easterly to southeasterly winds will gain momentum again Wednesday evening/night over the mid and lower slopes, but will weaken after midnight at the ridgetops, as winds will shift to the northwest. As a result, weaker east-northeast winds will occur at night and through the morning hours, before transitioning to an upslope/upcanyon wind by afternoon - Thursday through Monday. Expect poor recovery in the relative humidities as very warm and very dry remain in place into early next week.

WEATHER FOR WEDNESDAY NIGHT: Gusty east to southeast winds with Poor relative humidity recovery. Clear sky with areas of smoke.

Low temperatures: Ridges 49-53... Valleys 54-59.

Max RH: Ridges 25-35%... Valleys 30-40%.

20FT Winds:

Slope/Valley: East to east-southeast 15 to 25 mph.

Ridgetop: East to east-southeast 10 to 20 mph until midnight...then becoming NNW 5-10 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY: Gusty winds in the early morning, otherwise Sunny, warmer and continued dry. Areas of smoke in the morning.

High temps: 70-80.

Min RH: 10-18%.

Valley/Slope winds: East to southeast 10-20 mph...becoming upslope/upcanyon 6 G11 mph after 1100.
Ridgetop winds: Northwest 5-10 mph...becoming west to southwest 5 g12 mph in the afternoon.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

FUELS

Predominantly mature mixed conifer with heavy shrub loading. Fuel loadings are generally heavy. Live fuels moistures are dry; however the dead fuels have moistened up as a result of the rain from a few days ago.

Thresholds for Active Fire Behavior in the King Fire area (Eldorado NF PocketCard): 20ft Winds (over 5 mph), RH (under 22%), Temperature (over 84°) and 1000hr FMC (under 9%).

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Warmer, drier, and east-northeasterly winds with gusts up to 35 mph! Today will be a test for our westerly and southerly control lines. This will be the third day of drying since the precipitation, and fortunately the fuel moisture on most aspects are still very high. Exposed southerly aspects could carry fire especially if they are lined up with the wind and will need to be monitored. Rate of spread could be up to 15 ch/hr or more on unshaded southerly aspects. Southerly aspects that are shaded by canopy still have higher fuel moisture and will not burn as readily. Heavy fuels will continue to burn out throughout the entire fire area.

Transportation

- **Driving on the Incident** - Hazardous mountain roads are common.
- **The right vehicle for the right road for the right reason.**
- Eleven Pines down into the Rubicon, watch for burnt out trees and debris coming down on the road.
- Scout roads before sending up large suppression vehicles.
- Mosquito is narrow, winding and has few wide spots for turning around or getting by opposing traffic. The bridge on Mosquito that crosses the South Fork of the American is very narrow, nothing bigger than a pickup will fit over the bridge.
- Inattention, distracted driving, or nodding off due to fatigue could easily result in tragedy. Keep your speed down.
- Driving through the communities Georgetown and Placerville please slow down.

Fireline

- Heat; Emphasize hydration, stress symptoms and treatment of heat illness.
- Brief crew on working with Helicopter bucket drops; get out of the drop zone "No exceptions".
- As winds increase snag awareness should be emphasized.
- **Consider increased focus on securing the perimeter.** Hot spotting without follow-up patrol, cold trailing, and mop-up will not put the fire out in these fuel conditions



The closest DIVS will respond to manage the incident. They are responsible for giving an accurate size up, ensuring scene safety, setting priorities and initiating an appropriate response.

The closest Safety Officer and Line EMS will respond to the scene to assist the Branch Director or DIVS. Secure site and begin initial investigation when situation is stabilized.
