


*** GUSTY EAST TO SOUTHEAST WINDS THROUGH THURSDAY MORNING ***

POOR RELATIVE HUMIDITY RECOVERY THROUGH EARLY NEXT WEEK

WEATHER TODAY: Gusty east to southeast winds will be maintained through Thursday morning. Otherwise, sunny, warm and dry conditions continue. Areas of smoke in the morning.

TEMPERATURES: 71-81 *Trend: Up 2 to 3 degrees*
RELATIVE HUMIDITY: 10-18% *Trend: Down 3-5%*

20 FT WINDS:

Slope/Valley: East to southeast 12-18 mph G25 until 1100...then upslope/upcanyon 6 G12 mph.
Ridgetop: Southeast to south 10 mph G15 until 1200L... then Southwest 8 mph G15.

LAL: 1. **STABILITY/INVERSION:** Weak Inversion to 900 FT AGL, breaking by 1000.

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

East to southeasterly winds will continue at the mid slopes and valleys until 1100 with sustained winds 12 to 18 mph and gusts to 28 mph. Upslope/upcanyon winds will take control thereafter. Ridgetop winds will be south-southeast to south in the morning, then becoming southwesterly in the afternoon with gusts to 15 mph. Minimum relative humidities will range from 10 to 18%. Warmer temperatures and very dry air will continue through early next week as minimum relative humidities fall into the single digits Friday through Sunday. No precipitation foreseen through the first half of October.

WEATHER FOR THURSDAY NIGHT: Clear with poor maximum relative humidity recovery.

Low temperatures: Ridges 49-54... Valleys 57-62.

Max RH: Ridges 25-35%... Valleys 35-45%.

20FT Winds:

Slope/Valley: Northeast 7-12 mph until 2300L...then becoming east 10 mph G15.

Ridgetop: Northeast 7 mph G15 until 2400L...then southeast 5-15 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR FRIDAY: Sunny and warmer. Continued dry with areas of smoke in the morning.

High temps: 74-84.

Min RH: 8-15%.

Slope/Valley winds: East to southeast 10 mph G15 mph until 1100...then upslope/upcanyon 5 mph G12.

Ridgetop winds: South 7-12 mph until 1200...then Southwest to West 8 mph G15.



WEATHER SUMMARY:

Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke in the morning

Temps and RHs – Max Temp 71-81° RH 10-18% LAL 1

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

FUELS

Predominantly mature mixed conifer with heavy shrub loading. Fuel loadings are generally heavy. Live fuels moistures remain dry; however the dead fuels still remain moist in sheltered areas.

Thresholds for Active Fire Behavior in the King Fire area (Eldorado NF PocketCard): 20ft Winds (over 5 mph), RH (under 22%), Temperature (over 84°) and 1000hr FMC (under 9%). *Currently ERC's from local RAWS stations are 24% and 1000 hr fuel moisture is 18%.*

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Warmer, drier, and lower windspeeds in the afternoon. Fuels continue to dry out on sunny exposed aspects, but are still holding moisture under the canopy and on northerly aspects. Gusty east-northeast winds are blowing needle cast into the burn area and could be of concern in the future. Heavy fuels continue to burn out; warmer and drier temperatures along with gusty winds have increased fire activity within the perimeter. Any unburned islands near this activity will need to be monitored.

Unburned islands adjacent to heat sources on exposed southerly aspects could carry fire especially if they are lined up with the wind. Rate of spread could be up to 12 ch/hr on unshaded southerly aspects. Probability of ignition on southerly aspects is 32%, otherwise 0% on cooler aspects.

7. Control Operations

Mop up 200' or to the degree necessary to make the likelihood of escape very low: based on experience, terrain, fuel types and fuel conditions, and current/predicted weather conditions. Continue direct line construction on the 800 acre unburned island. Continue chipping and removal of all debris along the roadways in the Division. Remove and backhaul all unnecessary hoselays, pumps, and portable tanks.

8. Special Instructions

Every two hours near the unburned island take weather observations and call into communications. Divisions must debrief daily with cost apportionment at King ICP and Sunset Base Camp. Noxious weeds are marked by orange "noxious weed" flagging. Minimize or avoid activities in the area. Sensitive areas are marked with pink/black checkerboard flagging. Minimize ground disturbing activities in the area. Field weed wash heavy equipment used off roads in Branch III before leaving to assignment on another section of fire. READ verifies location for wash.



Major Hazards and Risks:

- ✓ **Snags** continue to be a major hazard. Fire has been burning for weeks expect more snags to come down as burning and smoldering around their base reduces the structural integrity.
- ✓ **Situational Awareness** - Conduct thorough briefings with your crew on all components of the IAP. Weather forecast should be highlighted in crew briefing today. Crews know where your EMTs and REMs are, and ensure communications are in place. Make LCES personal for your piece of real estate.
- ✓ **Fire Behavior** - Watch for areas previously cold to come back to life due to days of drying and winds.
- ✓ **Communications** - Command seems to have good coverage, inform communications if you locate any dead spots. Keep in constant communications with your crew, adjacent forces and appropriate overhead. Test command before engaging —use human repeaters where needed to ensure positive communications.
- ✓ **Driving Safety** - Slow down, we have no reason to be rushing around. Expect logging traffic on Eleven Pine to Wentworth Spring south. They will be hauling 8 loads at 6:00 AM and then 8 more loads at 1200. This will continue Throughout our time here on the incident.
- ✓ **Heavy Equipment** - Ensure all personnel are visible to dozers, maintain communications and mitigate overhead and rolling hazards. Maintain adequate separation between dozers and crews. Utilize traffic control on roads when transporting dozers to different parts of the fire.



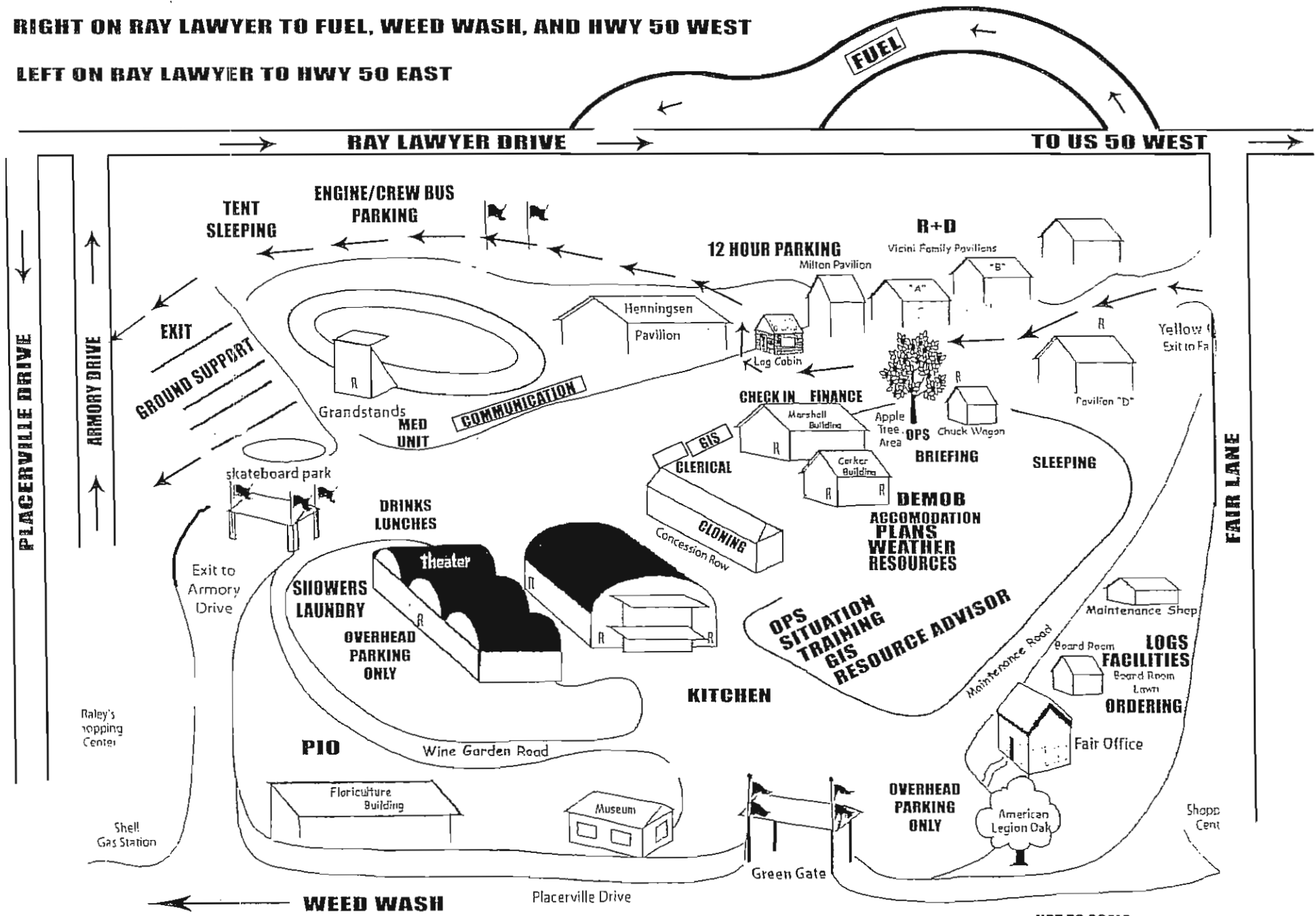

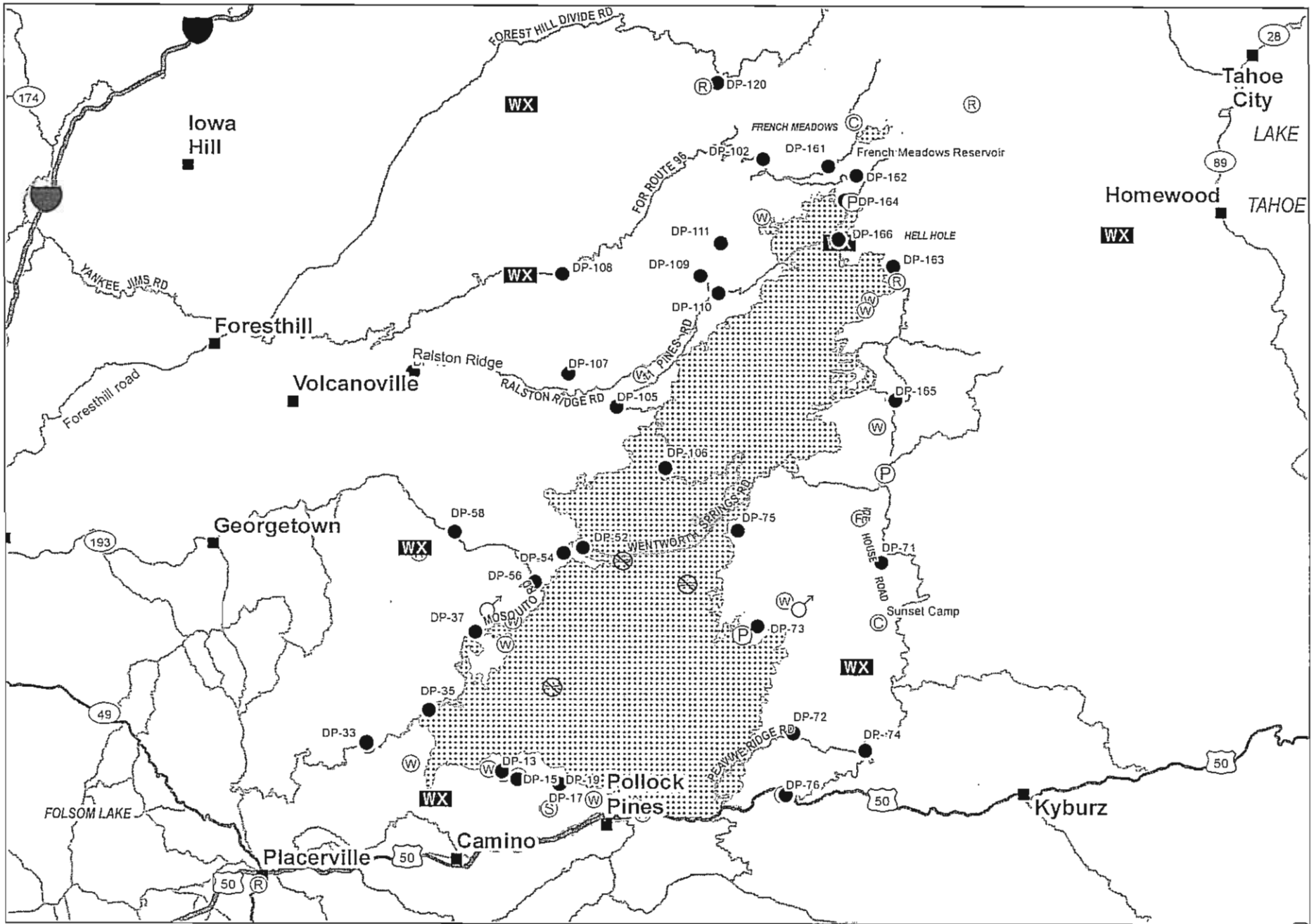
