STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak Inversion to 800 FT AGL, breaking by 1000.

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

High Pressure will dominate the weather today into the weekend with very warm and dry air. Minimum relative humidities will range between 8-15% with poor recoveries at night. Winds will be terrain driven through Monday with upslope/upcanyon winds taking control from 1000 through 2000L, then downslope/downcanyon winds thereafter. Ridgetop winds will favor a northeast to east-southeast direction at night into the early morning, transitioning to southwest and west-southwest between 1000-1200L. For the higher peaks in the far northern areas of the King Fire, expect slightly stronger Northeast winds at night into the early morning hours, becoming west to northwest in the afternoon.

WEATHER FOR FRIDAY NIGHT: Clear. Poor maximum relative humidity recovery.

Low temperatures: Ridges 51-56... Valleys 56-61.

Max RH: Ridges 20-30%...Valleys 30-38%.

Slope/Valley: Downslope/Downcanyon 4-9 mph.

Ridgetop: Northeast becoming east-southeast 5 mph G9...except far northern areas of Branch

Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke in the morning

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

FUELS

Predominantly mature mixed conifer with heavy shrub loading. Fuel loadings are generally heavy. Live fuels moistures remain dry; however the dead fuels still remain moist in sheltered areas.

Thresholds for Active Fire Behavior in the King Fire area (Eldorado NF PocketCard): 20ft Winds (over 5 mph), RH (under 22%), Temperature (over 84°) and 1000hr FMC (under 9%). Currently ERC's from local RAWS stations are 50% and 1000 hr fuel moisture is 13% which is above the threshold for active fire behavior.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Warmer, drier, and lower windspeeds today. As the ERC's continue to rise and 1000 hour fuel moisture continues to drop, fuels are drying out on multiple sunny exposed aspects. Soil moisture in these areas is still high keeping the fine fuel moisture high. However the fuels are still holding moisture under the canopy on all aspects. Heavy fuels continue to burn out; warmer and drier temperatures along with gusty winds the past few days have increased fire activity within the perimeter. Any unburned islands near this activity will need to be monitored.

Unburned islands adjacent to heat sources on exposed southerly aspects could carry fire, if inline with slope and wind. Maximum rate of spread could be up to 6 ch/hr on unshaded southerly aspects. Probability of ignition on southerly exposed aspects is 32%, otherwise 0% on cooler aspects.

Mop up 200' or to the degree necessary to make the likelihood of escape very low: based on experience, terrain, fuel types and fuel conditions, and current/predicted weather conditions. Continue coordinating repair efforts with READ. Remove and backhaul all unnecessary hoselays, pumps, and portable tanks.

8. Special Instructions

Every two hours near the unburned island take weather observations and call into communications.

Divisions must debrief daily with cost apportionment at King ICP and Sunset Base Camp.

Noxious weeds are marked by orange "noxious weed" flagging. Minimize or avoid activities in the area.

Sensitive areas are marked with pink/black checkerboard flagging. Minimize ground disturbing activities in the area.

Field weed wash heavy equipment used off roads in Branch III before leaving to assignment on another section of fire. READ verifies location for wash.

- Caffeine speeds up loss of fluids in your body (limit coffee and cola intake)
- Thirst always underestimates fluid needs (drink before you feel thirsty)
- Potassium-rich foods help greatly (add bananas, citrus, tomato juice to your diet)
- Signs of possible dehydration include rapid heart rate, weakness, excessive fatigue, dizziness, painful urination and dark colored urine

Hazard/Danger Trees and snags continue to be your enemy.




