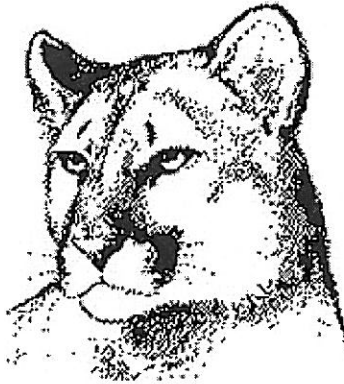



WEATHER DISCUSSION:

High pressure holds on for one more day before gradually weakening midweek. Therefore, another hot and dry day is expected around the King Fire. Winds will generally be light to moderate and predominantly terrain drive. Overnight humidity recoveries will remain poor tonight, but mainly over the higher slopes and ridges. Tuesday through Thursday temperatures will cool a few degrees and humidities will increase slightly.

WEATHER TODAY: Sunny, warm, and dry.

TEMPERATURES: Ridges: 75-80... Slopes/Valleys 81-92 **24 HR Trend:** Little Change
RELATIVE HUMIDITY: 10-17% **24 HR Trend:** Little Change

20 FT WINDS:

Slope/Valley: Downslope/Downcanyon 4-9 mph until 1000... then upslope/upcanyon 6 mph G13.
Ridgetop: East to northeast 8 mph G17 until 1000-1200... then southwest to west-southwest 6 mph G15.



WEATHER SUMMARY:

Mostly sunny, warm and dry

Temps and RHs – Max Temp 75-92° RH 10-17% LAL 1

20ft Wind –

Slope/Valley – Downslope/downcanyon 4-9 mph until 1000, then upslope/upcanyon 6 mph gusts to 13 mph

Ridgetop –East to northeast to 8 mph gusts to 17 mph until 1000-1200, then southwest to west-southwest 6 mph gusts to 15 mph.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR**GENERAL:****FUELS**

Predominantly mature mixed conifer with heavy shrub loading. Fuel loadings are generally heavy. Live fuels moistures remain dry; however the dead fuels still remain moist in sheltered areas.

Thresholds for Active Fire Behavior in the King Fire area (Eldorado NF Pocket Card): 20ft Winds (over 5 mph), RH (under 22%), Temperature (over 84°) and 1000hr FMC (under 9%). *Currently ERC's from Bald Mountain RAWS station is 60%. The 1000 hr fuel moisture is 11% which is above the threshold for active fire behavior.*

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Continued warm and dry as indicated by the rise in ERC's and lower 1000 hr fuel moisture. Fuels are drying out persistently on multiple sunny exposed aspects, and the soil is beginning to dry out as well. However the fuels are still holding moisture under the canopy on most aspects. Heavy fuels continue to burn out throughout the interior.

Mop-up has been mostly successful around the entire fire up to 200' inside the perimeter. Unburned islands continue to burn out as the fuels dry on all aspects. Maximum rate of spread could be up to 6 ch/hr with 2' flame lengths on unshaded southerly aspects if inline with slope and wind. Probability of ignition on southerly exposed aspects is 32%, otherwise 1% on cooler aspects.



**AIR OPERATIONS:**

Lower windspeeds and clear air will be favorable for air operations.

SAFETY

Stump holes and fire weakened trees continue to pose a safety issue while engaged in mop-up. Stay mindful throughout your shift of those and all potential hazards.

 Complete mop up where needed to meet 200' mop up standards. Evaluate and repair contingency handlines from Peavine Point to Nevada Point Trail. Install water bars and pull vegetation back onto dozer lines per repair plan on Blodgett and Peavine Ridge. Continue repair of cold direct fire line. Continue coordinating repair efforts with READ. Remove and backhaul all unnecessary hoselays, pumps, and portable tanks.

8. Special Instructions
 Every two hours South Rim of Rubicon Ridge take weather observations and call into communications. Divisions must debrief daily with cost apportionment at King ICP and Sunset Base Camp. Noxious weeds are marked by orange "noxious weed" flagging. Minimize or avoid activities in the area. Sensitive areas are marked with pink/black checkerboard flagging. Minimize ground disturbing activities in the area. Field weed wash heavy equipment used off roads in Branch III before leaving to assignment on another section of fire. READ verifies location for wash.

- Suppression repair continues around the fire. Continue to provide safe working area around excavators, and masticators. Masticators can throw debris for very long distances, get with each operator and determine safe working "stay back zone" for each piece of equipment.

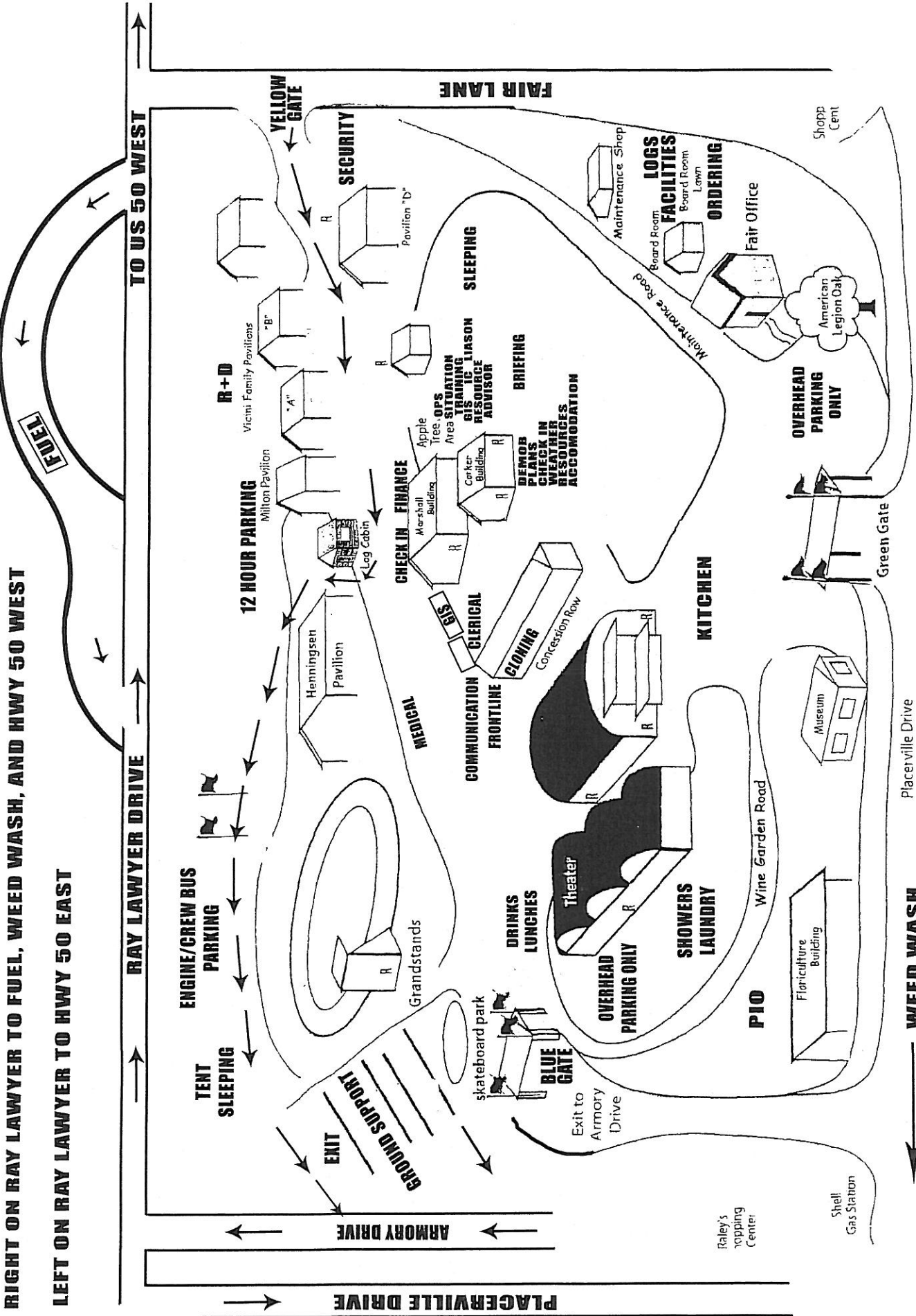
