5. General Control Objectives for the Incident (include alternatives)

MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES

- Provide for safety of incident personnel and the public.
- Provide for protection of private lands and infrastructure within the Salmon River corridor and adjacent communities.
- Provide accurate and effective fire information to the public, residents and cooperators.
- Minimize impacts to natural and cultural resources by utilizing Resource Advisors.

OPERATIONAL OBJECTIVES

- Keep fire within existing containment lines.
- Provide initial attack for new fire starts on the Salmon/Scott River Ranger District north of North Fork Salmon River and within the District boundary.

6. General Weather

---Red Flag Warning in effect until 11 pm Wednesday for thunderstorms and gusty outflow winds---

Day: Continued Hot and Dry. 10 % chance of afternoon thunderstorms. High temps 84 – 90 above 4500 feet and 95-100 along Sawyers Bar Road.

Night: Some smoke under the inversion. Partly cloudy above 4000 feet. Overnight lows 59 -63 along the river valley and 62 -67 above 4500 feet.

7. Resource Protection Guidelines



- Follow national policy for retardant avoidance.
- Apply fire as needed to maintain even backing down slope so the fire is not susceptible to long uphill runs.
- Map and document all areas where burn out was implemented.
- Back haul all trash to Idlewild.
- Ensure screens and foot valves are used when drafting.
- Ensure appropriate approvals are in place for use of helicopters and mechanized equipment for fire related work in the wilderness.
- Utilize resource advisors as needed to manage sensitive resource locations.

...Red Flag Warning in effect until 11 pm Wednesday for thunderstorms and gusty outflow winds...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A hot and dry weather pattern will continue over the fire today. Poor humidity recoveries will result in a dry start to the day above 5000 feet. Temperatures are expected to reach 100 degrees at Sawyer's Bar again, and afternoon humidities will be very low. Smoke should continue through the day under an inversion which will weaken some by 12 pm. Will need to watch closely for a round of late day thunderstorms but current data suggests the main threat will stay south and east of the Salmon Complex.

Weather Forecast for Monday: Continued dry and hot. 10% chance of afternoon thunderstorms through sunset.

TEMPERATURES: High 84-90 above 4500 feet and 95-101 along Sawyers Bar Road.

HUMIDITY: Trending lower with afternoon minimum humidities 10-16% at lower elevations below 3000 feet and 18-28% above 4500 feet.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP – Northeast 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph in the morning Div B, E, M, S and T. Afternoon winds will favor a westerly direction at 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY – East 4-8 mph through 10 am then upcanyon/westerly 3-6 mph, increasing to 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph 2 pm - 8 pm.

HAINES INDEX: 5 (Moderate) **LAL:** 2 **CWR:** 0%

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion through 12 pm...then weakening.

Monday Night: Some smoke under the inversion. Partly cloudy above 4000 feet.

TEMPERATURES: Overnight lows 59-63 along the river valley. 62-67 above 4500 feet.

HUMIDITY: Humidity 25-35% at 6 pm across the fire landscape...increasing to 50% by morning above 5000 feet. Higher overnight recoveries of 75% are expected at lower elevations near the river valley.

20 FT WINDS:


RIDGETOP – West 5 to 10 mph through 9 pm then Northeast 4-8 mph overnight.

SLOPE/VALLEY – West winds 5 to 10 mph through 9 pm then east winds 3-6 mph overnight.

LAL: 1 **CWR:** 0%

Extended Forecast: The Red Flag Warning issued for Siskiyou County continues through Wednesday evening for thunderstorms with gusty outflow winds. Storms will trend wetter Tuesday and Wednesday. Cooler temperatures and higher humidities are expected Tuesday into Wednesday.

INPUTS

WEATHER SUMMARY: A hot, dry pattern persists over the fire through the period with poor humidity recovery beginning the day at higher elevations. **A RED FLAG WARNING IS IN EFFECT FOR THUNDERSTORMS AND GUSTY OUTFLOW WINDS.** Temperatures are expected to break 100 along the river and humidity values will be down in the teens. Lingering smoke throughout the day will limit visibility. Increasing cumulus in the afternoon could produce a thunderstorm around the fire but the main threat is further south and east.

OUTPUTS

GENERAL: Another day of dry conditions will bring any remaining fire to life and if undetected spots or unburned fuels interior exist expect them to show themselves. Fuels will readily consume down assisting with the mop-up and control efforts. Be aware that fuels are readily available so if fire does get in a position with the aid of slope or wind it will burn actively and will likely outpace resources without support from aircraft or equipment, this is particularly important for those tasked with IA responsibility in the fire area.

SPECIFIC:

Branch I: Activity will be limited to unburned islands interior of control lines. Heat is likely to be found in larger diameter fuels, stumps and ground fuels that haven't consumed. Expect any remaining fire to show itself today with the sustained hot, dry weather. Once again, rolling material will be a factor for Division Alpha with the chance to spread fire across Sawyers Bar Road. Mop-up operations combined with continued consumption of fuels will help to limit the potential of fire escaping the existing control lines. Where minimal suppression tactics have been implemented expect remaining fuels to provide the greatest threat but this will be tempered by favorable winds.

Branch III: Fire behavior will be active again today as spread further downhill into the Jackass drainage takes place. As the fire reaches the bottom of the slope expect to see activity decrease drastically as it interacts with the riparian vegetation with much higher fuel moistures. The threat of fire crossing the stream exists and attention should be given to snags and other ember producing sources that are the likely means for fire crossing. In the higher elevations around Tanners Peak and north of H-4 fire activity will continue to creep and smolder with an occasional flare-up as it finds favorable fuels but it will have a difficult time making a concerted push to containment lines. Elsewhere on the branch fire activity will be limited to larger diameter fuels that will carry fire as they burn down.

Night Branch: Expect poor humidity recovery with very low values as the shift starts. Activity will continue into the evening where fuels remain but the effects of suppression efforts near control lines will be realized with less heat showing. The threat for rolling material will persist through the evening, especially along Sawyers Bar Road.

AIR OPERATIONS

The inversion will weaken around noon with a residual haze in the afternoon. Expect enough visibility to fly but conditions will still be varying and will need re-evaluation throughout the shift. Moderate windspeeds will be present on the ridges and some instability will increase the potential for turbulence.

SAFETY

Take the time during a slow period to review safety protocols found in your IRPG or Six Minutes for Safety and discuss them with your module. Be preventative. If you see something, fix it or communicate it, don't let it be.





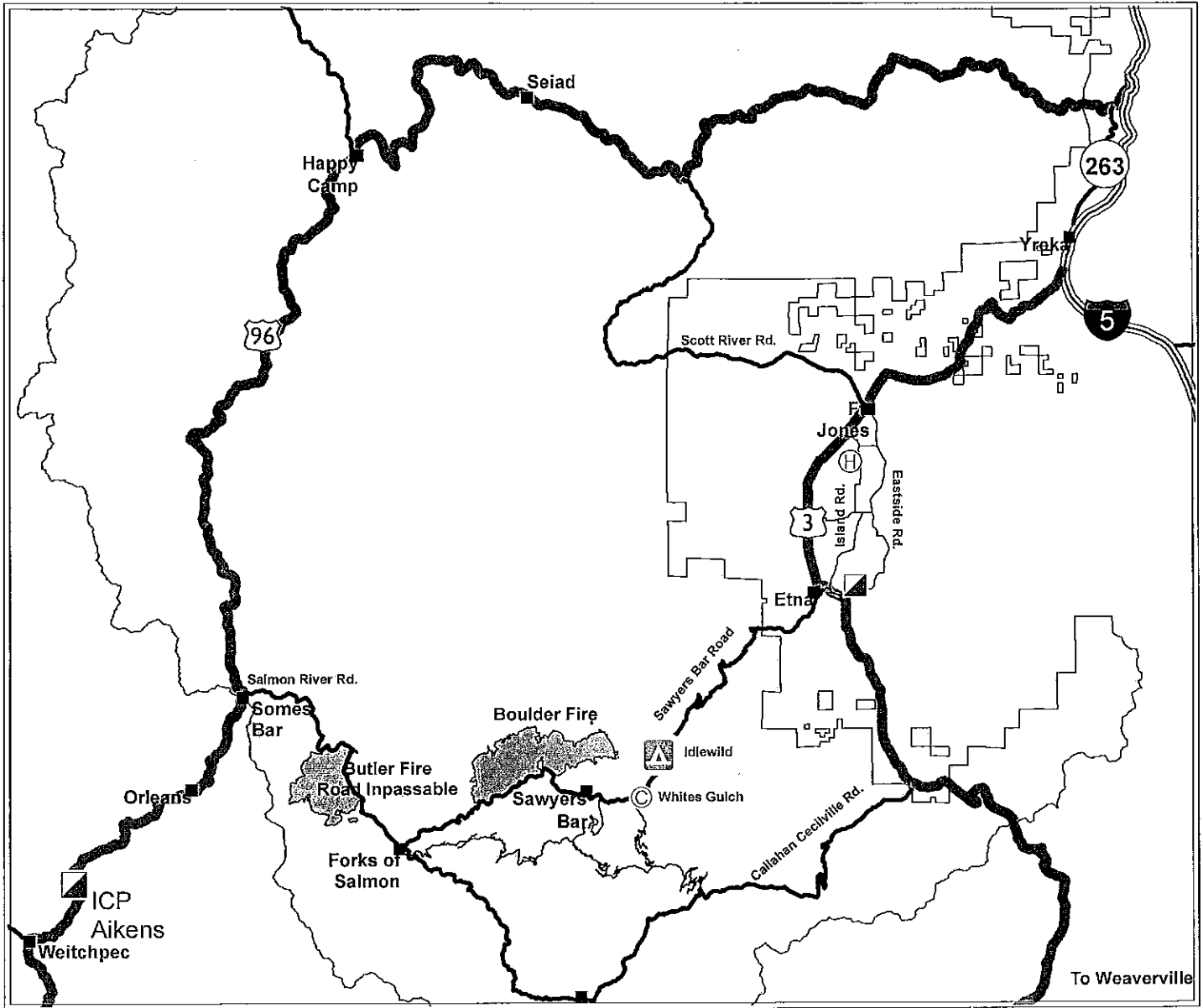
If Declaring an "Incident within the Incident"

The closest Safety Officer and Line EMS will respond to the scene to assist the Branch Director or DIVS. Secure site and begin initial investigation when situation is stabilized.



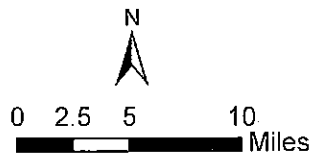
Salmon River Complex Fire Transportation Map
