

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Very dry and unstable conditions with gusty east winds will affect the fire today. Haines 5 suggests plume dominated fire potential this afternoon if the fire breaks the inversion. Gusty east ridge winds could surface in some of the drainages today, especially those that are oriented east to west. Winds will continue to be from the east and gusty tonight on the upper slopes and ridges.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY (THURSDAY DAY SHIFT):

WEATHER: Very dry with gusty winds. Areas of smoke.

MAX TEMPERATURES: With Smoke: Valleys (1,200 ft) 83 - 88 F, Ridges (4,000 ft) 73 - 80 F

No Smoke: Valleys (1,200 ft) 88 – 94 F, Ridges (4,000 ft) 78 – 85 F

MIN HUMIDITY: With Smoke: Valleys (1,200 ft) 13 - 20%, Ridges (4,000 ft) 15 - 22%

FIRE BEHAVIOR FORECAST GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:

The fire will remain fuels and topography driven with a moderate potential for large fire growth. Primary fire spread is from spot fires caused by rolling material and torching, most of the fire is in a backing alignment. Drainages with continuous fuels have a high potential for sustained runs once the inversion breaks. Falling snags and rolling material will challenge containment lines and will increase the potential for fire spread over barriers that would normally hold the fire. If a large column develops expect spot fires out to 1+miles.

Expect rapid acceleration of fire behavior when the inversion lifts. The fire will go from smoldering and creeping to torching as soon as the sun hits the fuels.

Fire will remain active into the night until the RH recovers to 40%.

SPECIFIC:

- Any fire established in the base of Kelsey Creek has the potential to run out the drainage below Cayenne Ridge.
- East/west aligned drainages have high potential for sustained runs.
- South end of the fire will continue to hold on the PCT ridge. Spots from torching will challenge containment.
- The fire will continue to back down to Scott River Rd. If a plume develops expect spotting out to 1.5 miles.
- As the fire approaches the Hwy 96 Scott River Rd intersection battling drainage winds can lead to fire whirl development.
- Long range spotting has the potential to impact Branch VI, spots will grow rapidly with flanking slope runs.

Air Operations: Poor visibility has a high potential to limit air operations.

SAFETY:

As the inversion lifts, expect a rapid increase of fire behavior. Steep country means rolling material, watch for spot fires below you!

 of the potential for haz-mat situations, County notifications will be necessary.
 Refresh yourselves with the structure protection plan.
- Fire behavior conditions can be localized on different Divisions of this fire, pay attention to the local and changing conditions in your division. Stay vigilant to the Fire Behavior forecast and updates. Take weather observations in your Division and share.
- When in your Division/Group do you know where your Safety Zone is? Travel time from your current location? Alternate Safety Zone?
- Branches and Divisions monitor the fatigue levels of your crews; those that have been in Coyote mode for several days may need closer attention to their welfare.
- Review the medical plan with your people, know where the line EMT's are located; these procedures could save someone's life!
- Ensure your radio communications are in place prior to engagement; notify your DIVS if you have problems. Use on "tac net" to exchange critical information.
 Figure out a alternative if the Command Channel is busy.




