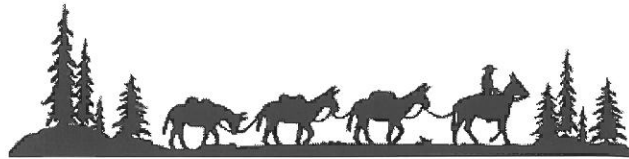




Weather Discussion: A weak trough will move well east of the area today which will allow for southwest to west winds to develop over the ridges during the afternoon. Winds in the valleys are still expected to remain light and smoke will likely remain trapped. Some flat cumulus is expected to develop Saturday and Sunday over the higher terrain, but no rain is expected. A trough could swing through the area by the middle of the next week with an increase in southwest winds and slightly cooler temperatures and the possibility of some light rain.

Weather Forecast For Today (Friday):

Weather: Continued hot and dry. Few afternoon high clouds. Some pyrocumulus possible over stronger columns. Smoke stuck in most of the canyon bottoms.
Max Temperatures: Canyons (1,200 ft) 88-98 °F, Ridges (5,000 ft) 78-83 °F
Min Humidity: Canyons (1,200 ft) 8-13%, Ridges (5,000 ft) 14-18%
Winds (20 foot):
 Lower Slope/Canyons – Variable winds 0-3 mph becoming terrain driven 3-7g18 mph in the afternoon.
 Upper Slope/Ridgetop – East Northeast 6-9 mph becoming Southwest 5-10 mph around 1200.



Winds (20'): Day, Ridges east-northeast 6-9 mph becoming southwest 5-10 around 1200. 3-6. Night, Ridgetop variable 3-6 mph

Continued warm and dry, and moderately instable. Smoke in the canyon bottoms will shade fuels and decrease fire behavior through early to late afternoon. Fire will continue to back under these conditions. Unburned islands within the fire perimeter will continue to consume.

If and when the smoke lifts, fire activity will increase. Fire movement will be influenced by the terrain driven winds, dry fuels, and topography

As smoke lifts and the fuels become exposed to sunlight, the fire could become active including torching, and active crown fire especially when in alignment with the wind and slope. Moderate column growth is possible. Afternoon ridgetop wind will be fairly light but out of the southwest which will be favorable for holding firing operations from the past few days on the south end and reduce spotting potential in a southerly direction. Expect spot fires up to 1 mile.

Night Shift Personnel: Fuels will continue to burnout within the fire perimeter. The only fire growth anticipated will be in Division O near Hummingbird Ck. Low RH recovery on the ridgetops will enable residual fuels to consume.

SPECIFIC:

Division: Q, T, Z, D, F, G,H, J,K: Minimal fire behavior anticipated

Division L: Islands will continue to burn out west of Scott River Rd. Otherwise minimal fire behavior is anticipated

Division M and S: Afternoon southwest winds will be favorable for holding residual heat from firing operations.

Unburned islands will continue to burn out.

Division R: Minimal fire activity expected.

Division N: Fire will continue backing towards Turk Cabin.

Division O: Fire will continue to move south and southeast. Fire is currently burning in a timber stringer. In the bigger picture there are burn scars from previous fires that burned from 2002-2008. Fuels in these burns are mostly brush with downed snags partially across the landscape. And standing dead snags. Generally when fire moves into these burns the spread is from snag to snag, log to log, and when it runs into a jackpot the fire may run through the brush.

Potential Forward ROS on slopes: 1-25CH/HR

AIR OPERATIONS

Smoke cover could limit air operations throughout the day

SAFETY

Ensure lookouts are well placed and are keyed into changes in the weather and increases in fire behavior.

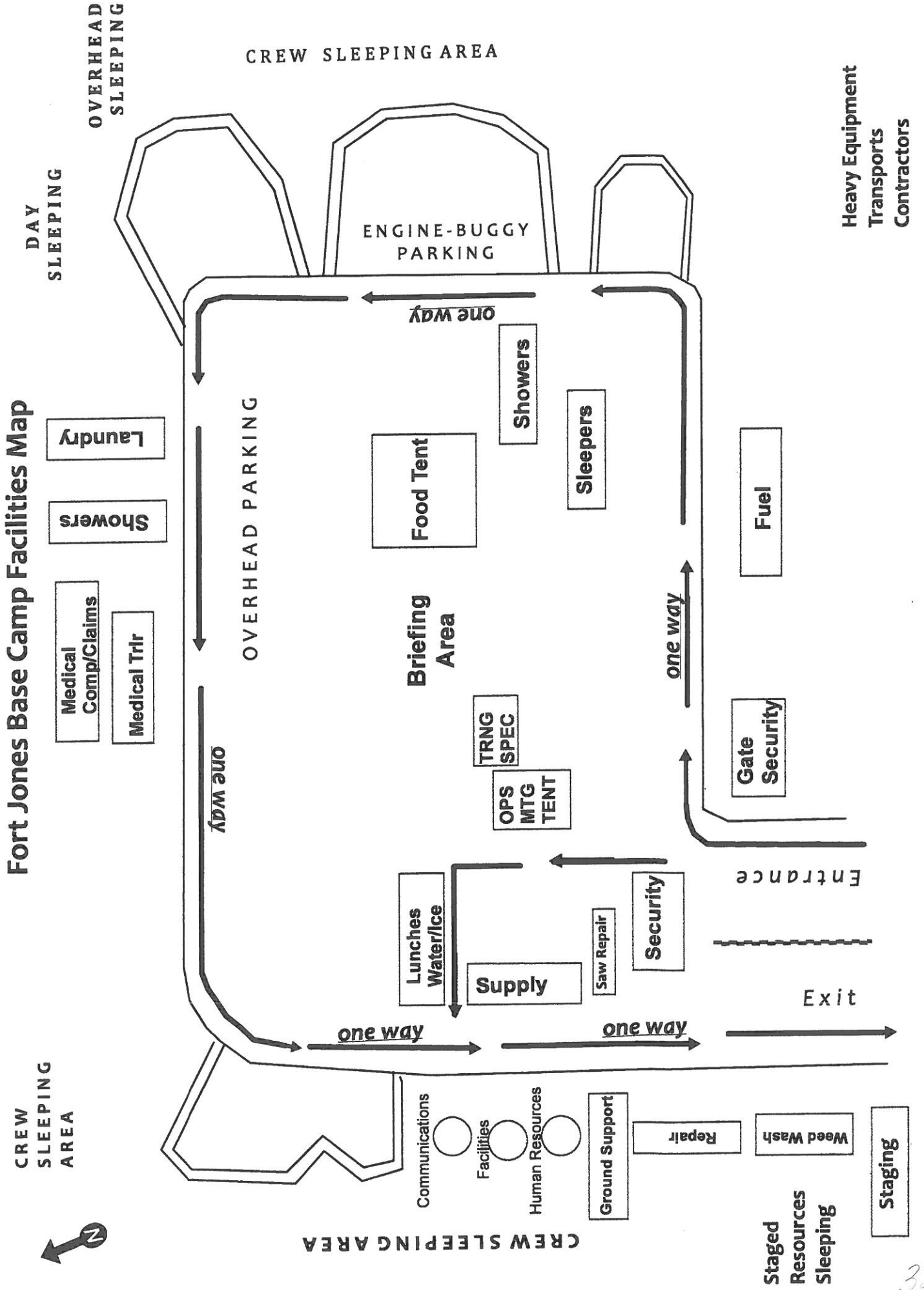

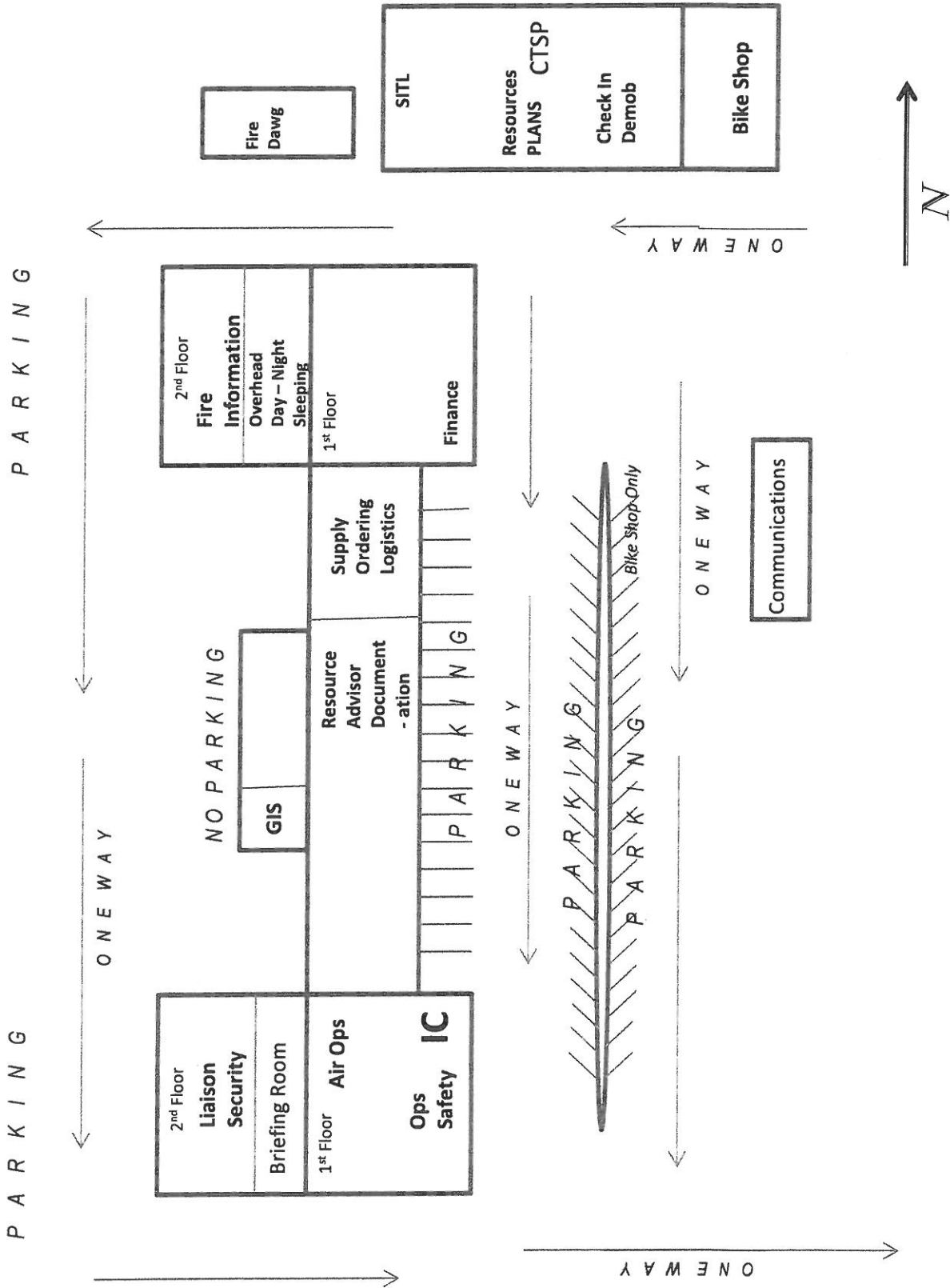

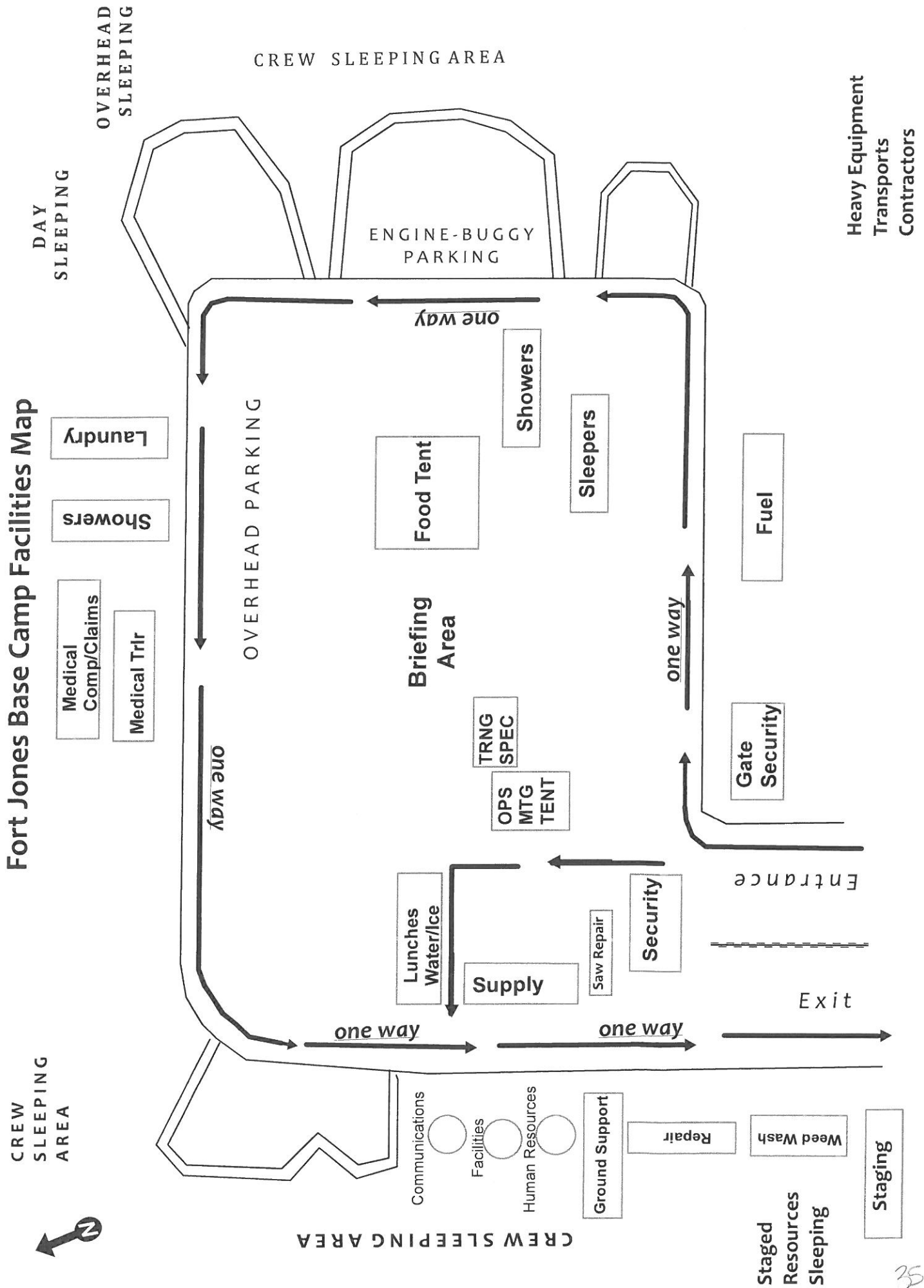
Fort Jones Base Camp Facilities Map
