


...RED FLAG WARNING FOR VERY LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITIES, DRY SOUTHEAST WINDS, AND UNSTABLE CONDITIONS THROUGH 11PM PDT FRIDAY NIGHT...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: The Happy Camp fire is under an unusually dry airmass with another round of single digit humidity values forecast this afternoon after another dry start. Ridge top winds will continue from a Southeast direction while winds along Scott River Road will primarily be diurnally driven with any smoke creating erratic and gusty winds during the late afternoon hours. Be aware that Haines 5 is forecast again with very dry air aloft creating unstable conditions favorable for plume development during the peak burn period through sunset. Everything is lining up: **Red Flags, High Haines, extremely dry air and offshore winds.** Please remain extra vigilant on the fire lines under these extreme fire weather conditions.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY (FRIDAY DAY SHIFT):

WEATHER: Continued warm and dry. Smoke mainly west of Scott River.
MAX TEMPERATURES: **With Smoke:** Valleys (2,500 ft) 78 – 84 F, Ridges (4,500 ft) 72 – 77 F
No Smoke: Valleys (2,500 ft) 82 – 87 F, Ridges (4,500 ft) 77 – 84 F
MIN HUMIDITY: **With Smoke:** Valleys (2500 ft) 13 – 19%, Ridges (4,500 ft) 15 – 22%
No Smoke: Valleys (2,500 ft) 7 – 12%, Ridges (4,500 ft) 13 – 19%
WINDS (EYE LEVEL):
 Lower Slopes / Scott River Rd: Afternoon upslope 3-5 mph gust 8 mph. Erratic after 4 pm near confluence of drainages along Scott River Rd.
 Ridges – Southeast 4-8 mph with gusts 12-15 mph.
LAL: 1 **CWR:** 0% **HAINES:** 5 (unstable and favorable for plume dominated fire)
STABILITY / INVERSION: Inversion could mix out as early as 1000-1100.
SMOKE TRANSPORT: Southeasterly 10 mph... may shift North to Northeast after 4 pm.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT (FRIDAY NIGHT SHIFT):

WEATHER: Clear then smoking settling into the drainages. **Continued poor RH recovery.**
MIN TEMPERATURES: 52 to 58 F... mid slopes to ridges. 40s drainages and camp.
MAX HUMIDITY: Valleys (2,500 ft) 35 – 45%F, Ridges (4,000 ft) 25 – 35%.
WINDS (EYE LEVEL): Valleys – Downslope / downvalley 1 – 4 mph.
 Ridges – Northeast to East 4-8 mph.
LAL: 1 **CWR:** 0% **HAINES:** 4
STABILITY / INVERSION: Inversion developing after 2200 in lower drainages.
SMOKE TRANSPORT: Southeast 5-10 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY (4500 FT): Areas of smoke. Otherwise, sunny. Continued warm and dry but West winds expected by afternoon. Max Temps: 78 to 88. Min RH: 12 - 22%. Ridge Wind: Westerly 4-8 mph afternoon gusts 10-12 mph. LAL 1. CWR 0%. Haines 4.

FIRE BEHAVIOR FORECAST

GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:

GROUNDHOG DAY! Today will be similar to yesterday. The fire will remain fuels and topography driven with a moderate potential for large fire growth. Primary fire spread is from spot fires caused by rolling material and torching, most of the fire is in a backing alignment. Drainages with continuous fuels have a high potential for sustained runs once the inversion breaks. Falling snags and rolling material will challenge containment lines and will increase the potential for fire spread over barriers that would normally hold the fire. If a large column develops expect spot fires out to 1+miles.

Expect rapid acceleration of fire behavior when the inversion lifts. The fire will go from smoldering and creeping to torching as soon as the sun hits the fuels.

Fire will remain active into the night until the RH recovers to 40%.

SPECIFIC:

- Any fire established in the base of Kelsey Creek has the potential to run out the drainage below Cayenne Ridge.
- East/west aligned drainages have high potential for sustained runs.
- South end of the fire will continue to hold on the PCT ridge. Spots from torching will continue challenge containment.
- The fire will continue to back down to Scott River Rd. If a plume develops expect spotting out to 1.5 miles.
- As the fire approaches the Hwy 96 Scott River Rd intersection battling drainage winds can lead to fire whirl development.
- Long range spotting has the potential to impact Branch V and VI , spots will grow rapidly with flanking slope runs.

Air Operations: Poor visibility has a high potential to limit air operations.

SAFETY:

As the inversion lifts, expect a rapid increase of fire behavior.

Steep country means rolling material, watch for spot fires below you!



Happy Camp Complex Safety Message

September 5-6, 2014

Hazards we face:

- Driving , Visual ,Manual ,Cognitive
- Fatigue
- Weather Changing
- Communications
- Power line - Burning poles
- Pack string

Some possible mitigations could include:

- When driving keep at or below posted speed limit during shift change, stay to your side of the road - be alert for local residents.
- Camp Crud may predispose a fire fighter to fatigue and dehydration, be aware of the health status of your crew members.
- Be alert for changing conditions know what the local diurnal wind patterns is doing.
- Make your plan to reposition to a more secure area, if necessary, and let them be known to all crew members.
- Review the medical plan with your people, know where the line EMT's are located; these procedures could save someone's life!
- Observe for down power lines treat all as "Hot" extinguish burning poles when safe.
- Some basics when working around the pack string:
 - When passing the string stay on the downhill side and keep your crew and equipment together and avoid loud talking.
 - No fast movement or reaching to pet stock on the trail
 - Remove large rocks and stumps from trails to accommodate stock
 - Shut saws off when pack string approaches
 - If near a known bees nest, let packer know







Medical Pre-Incident Planning:

- Identify EMTs and Equipment imbedded in suppression recourses.
- Review the Incident or Forest Emergency reporting procedures
- Review the Incident's assigned Medical resources and their location. (note radio call sign)
- Assure that all assigned supervisors have reviewed and understand the Medical Plan. (if none is available develop a quick plan before engaging)

Arriving at work site:

- Assess access and egress for medical ground units.
- Assure that all resources can clearly articulate their location. (update as they move)
- GPS potential Drop Points or Landing Zones.
- Note weather changes and check on availability of air resources.
- Pre-Position medical supplies

During Response to a Medical Emergency:

- Contact Communications and declare a **MEDICAL EMERGENCY!!**
- Identify the Unit needing help and their location
- Insure that LCES are maintained.
- Obtain patient info and severity.
- Develop a resource list
 - Initial care
 - Sustained care
 - Extrication/evacuation
- Report the Emergency and request anticipated resources needs
- Put two plans in place and start both plans clearly identifying the primary and backup plan to resources assigned.
- During the Evacuation (every 15 min.)**
 - Reassess the treatment and the patient response (Are they getting better?) Do you have the right level of care?
 - Assess the evacuation plans progress and adjust as needed.
 - Assure that additional personnel are available for relief.
 - Up-date Comm/Disp of the progress of the rescue.

PREVENT SEXUAL HARASSMENT

SEXUAL HARASSMENT at work, including emergency incidents, occurs whenever unwelcome conduct on the basis of gender, adversely affects a person's ability to do their job, and contributes to a hostile work environment. Sexual harassment includes, but is not limited to, the following types of conduct:

- ✦ Unwelcome sexual advances
- ✦ Requests for sexual favors
- ✦ Discussing sexual activities
- ✦ Telling off-color jokes
- ✦ Unnecessary touching
- ✦ Displaying sexually suggestive pictures
- ✦ Using demeaning or inappropriate terms
- ✦ Using indecent gestures
- ✦ Using crude and offensive language
- ✦ Commenting on physical attributes
