

5. General Control Objectives for the Incident (include alternatives)

MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES:

-Provide for firefighter and public safety by utilizing the risk management process.

-Minimize damage to natural and cultural resources by using resource advisers, cultural resource specialists.

-Protect and minimize fire effects to residential structures, communities, infrastructure and private property and timber lands.

-Provide timely and accurate fire information to key stakeholders, the public, and cooperators.

-Support and coordinate initial attack within the TFR.

-Manage costs commensurate with values at risk.

CONTROL OBJECTIVES:

-Hold fire within existing containment lines and keep fire:

South of the O'Neil Ridge west to Seiad Creek

East of Elk Creek

West of Scott River and Baldy Lookout.

North of Cayenne Ridge and Elk Creek

6. General Weather

The air mass is still dry and somewhat unstable but Haines of 4 is forecast. Humidity values will still be critically low but in comparison to previous days will trend higher. Afternoon up-canyons will be strongest and adverse to the line in Div K and Div R in the vicinity of Kelsey Creek as westerly flow increases during the peak burn period through 8 pm.

7. Resource Protection Guidelines

-Use MIST to minimize impacts to wilderness characteristics.

- Avoid aerial retardant within 300 feet of wet areas and in areas with threatened, endangered, proposed, candidate or sensitive species.

-Use screens on all drafting equipment.

-Track and map daily all tactical burning operations and turn into DIVS/ SIT unit.

NAME OF FIRE: Happy Camp Complex

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Compared to previous days, conditions will moderate slightly on Zone 2 of the Happy Complex. The thermal trough is now over the region which will lead to light southerly flow in the morning that will gradually turn westerly in the afternoon. The airmass is still dry and somewhat unstable but Haines of 4 is forecast. Afternoon temperatures will be similar but heavy smoke in the drainages will limit heating along many of the Divisions in Zone 2. Humidity values will still be critically low but in comparison to previous days will trend higher. Afternoon up-canyons will be strongest and adverse to the line in Div K and Div R in the vicinity of Kelsey Creek as westerly flow increases during the peak burn period through 8 pm. The night shift should expect light down-canyon winds after 9 or 10 pm with noticeably better humidity recovery compared to the last several days.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY (SUNDAY DAY SHIFT):

WEATHER: Heavy smoke in the drainages. Slight moderation of temp and humidity.

MAX TEMPERATURES: With Smoke: Valleys (2,500 ft) 79 - 84 F, Ridges (4,500 ft) 72 - 76 F

No Smoke: Valleys (2,500 ft) 84 – 89 F, Ridges (4,500 ft) 77 – 84 F

MIN HUMIDITY: With Smoke: Valleys (2500 ft) 15 - 19%, Ridges (4,500 ft) 18 - 23%

No Smoke: Valleys (2,500 ft) 13 – 18%, Ridges (4,500 ft) 15 – 20%

WINDS (20 Foot):

Lower Slopes / Scott River Rd: Afternoon upslope 3-6 mph gust 12 mph. Erratic after 4 pm near confluence of drainages along Scott River Rd and near DivJ/K break Div R/S.

Ridges - South 3-6 mph turning West/Southwest 4-8 gusts 12-15 mph afternoon.

LAL: 1 CWR: 0% HAINES: 4 (moderate potential for plume dominated fire)

STABILITY / INVERSION: Stronger inversion in place along Scott River Rd due to smoke...lifting 1400.

SMOKE TRANSPORT: Southerly 4-8 mph turning West/Southwest afternoon.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT (SUNDAY NIGHT SHIFT):

WEATHER: Heavy smoke settling into the drainages otherwise clear.

MIN TEMPERATURES: 53 to 63 F...mid slopes to ridges. (40s in the Ft Jones base camp)

MAX HUMIDITY: Valleys (2,500 ft) 45 - 55%F, Ridges (4,000 ft) 35 - 45%.

Valleys - Downslope / downvalley 1 - 4 mph after 9 pm. WINDS (20 Feet):

Ridges - West/Northwest 4-8 mph til 9 pm turning Easterly 3-6 mph overnight.

LAL: 1 CWR: 0% HAINES: 3

STABILITY / INVERSION: Inversion developing after 2100 around 4000 feet.

SMOKE TRANSPORT: East 3-6 mph.

OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY (4500 FT): No significant changes. Areas of smoke. Otherwise, sunny. A few degrees cooler with slightly higher RH readings. Light East winds in the morning turning West in the afternoon. Max Temps: 75 to 85.

Min RH: 19 - 29%.

Ridge Wind: Westerly 4-8 mph afternoon gusts 10-12 mph.

WEATHER SUMMARY: West Winds Slightly Higher Humidity

Winds: Day, Ridges West 3-6mph, Night, Downslope down valley 3-6mph.

Night: Downslope/down valley 3-6mph. Min. RH: 18-25% Max. RH 35-45% Temperatures: Day 78-88. Night: 53-58

FIRE BEHAVIOR FORECAST GENERAL FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Even though the west winds will be light the potential for spotting over Scott River is significant. Our fire continues to be fuels and topography driven with a moderate potential for large fire growth. Primary fire spread is from spot fires caused by rolling material and torching, most of the fire is in a backing alignment. Drainages with continuous fuels have a high potential for sustained runs once the inversion breaks. Falling snags and rolling material will challenge containment lines and will increase the potential for fire spread over barriers that would normally hold the fire. If a large column develops expect spot fires out to 1+miles.

Expect rapid acceleration of fire behavior when the inversion lifts. The fire will go from smoldering and creeping to torching as soon as the sun hits the fuels.

Fire will remain active into the night until the RH recovers to 40%.

SPECIFIC:

- Any fire established in the base of Kelsey Creek has the potential to run out the drainage below Cayenne Ridge.
- Firing in M,N,&S should continue to back into Kelsey Creek. With the wind switching west spots over the line are likely. Any spots should stay in a backing alignment.
- East/west aligned drainages have high potential for sustained runs.
- The fire will continue to back down to Scott River Rd. If a plume develops expect spotting out to 1.5 miles.
- As the fire approaches the Hwy 96 Scott River Rd intersection battling drainage winds can lead to fire whirl development.
- Mid range spotting has the potential to impact Branch V and VI, spots will grow rapidly with flanking slope runs.

Air Operations: Poor visibility has a high potential to limit air operations.

SAFETY:

As the inversion lifts, expect a rapid increase of fire behavior. Steep country means rolling material, watch for spot fires below you!



Happy Camp Complex Safety Message

September 7-8, 2014

Hazards we face:

- Changing Fire Behavior
- Air Resources
- Radio Use Communication Responsibilities
- Steep Terrain
- Weakened Trees
- Shift Change
- Heavy Smoke
- Power Lines

Some possible mitigation could include:

- Have lookouts in place to detect changing fire behavior, they should be located in a smoke free area. Prompt them to look developing spots and for well-developed columns or changing columns.
- Air attack is our friend; they can identify changing fire conditions. Watch for aerial hazards and notify air resources; i.e. wires, towers, power poles and let them be known.
- Use correct terminology on the radio; example: spot fire is a fire across the line, slop over is connected to the fireline, active fire along the fireline and or flare up.
- Plan on rolling material compromising fireline safety and impacting the Scott River Road.
 Post a lookout just in case.
- Fire may have weakened trees and surrounding ground; look for signs of fire damage.
 Use professional cutters whenever possible.
- Make sure resources are not blocking roadway: shift changes have been problems, have a traffic plan in place to avoid narrow bridges being clogged up
- Know the symptoms of smoke exposure. Go to the medical unit if you have any question.
- Always treat power lines as energized; a dead power line is de-energized and grounded, ask that question when checking.


