### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL:

The Fires main influence has been fuel and topography dominated. They are primary being driven by dead and down fuels. Fuels burning consist of Grass, Shrubs and Heavy Down (FM 1, 4, 10). Large dense stands of mixed Conifer are dominant throughout. Live Fuel Moisture is estimated at 90%. 1000 hr fuels are @ 8%. Headfire has displayed ROS @ 7-12 chains/hr with flame lengths of 4-8 feet. Single/group tree torching has occurred on all fires sustained crown runs were observed on the Falkstein fire. Heavy fuels are holding heat under canopy.

ERC is predicted @ 70 today....Local threshold for large growth: 20' winds over 4 mph, RH less than 40%, Temps over 75\*, 1000 hr FM less than 13% (refer to Pocket Card in IAP).

Scattered Tree Mortality is under 5%.

Probability of Ignition (shaded) will be 50% into receptive fuels for the better part of the operational period.

### SPECIFIC

##### All Divisions:

The Fires will continue to display a moderate surface fire ROS and intensity. They will continue to back towards drainages and retain heat. Fires will make uphill runs as it establishes itself and slope/wind become into alignment. The potential for single/group tree torching will remain a threat due to ladder fuels being pre-heated by surface fire. Roll-out of burning material remains a high concern and has led to the growth of the Fires. Heavy fuels will continue to hold heat until extinguished or consumed. The forecasted weather will thread to a period of cooler temperatures and higher humidity...still, lighter fuels (1hr and 10hr) will continue to lose moisture and burn more readily. Increased fire activity will increase as solar heating and lifting of inversion becomes a factor. Direct attack along flanks with hose lines and hand crews are favorable. We could see spotting distance of up to 1/4-1/2 mile at the ridges.

**Frying Pan Fire:** will slowly back towards elk creek/china grade roads and move to the east along frying pan ridge...heads up for increase spotting as fire makes up hill runs that align with northerly winds. Watch out for fire establishing into horse/upper elk creeks and aligning with slope/wind.

**Falkstein Fire:** will continue to back and flank into grider creek towards the north...heads up on fire stacking up and moving towards the ridgeline west/south...fire will continue to work its way north along grinder creek and south into stones valley.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

Air support may be limited due to Inversion or diversion to new initial attack fire.

### SAFETY

- Identify your vulnerability on an advancing fire front when working hotspots
- Consider the potential for re-burning of available fuels
- Look for an increase in fire activity when winds shift in your division
- Evaluate the Fire's potential for upslope runs



- Review Downhill Checklist.
- Utilize Lookouts and be aware of rolling debris.
- Steep terrain and with loose footing requires increased safe work distances.
- Underslung line.
- Be aware of other potential holdovers from previous lightning event.

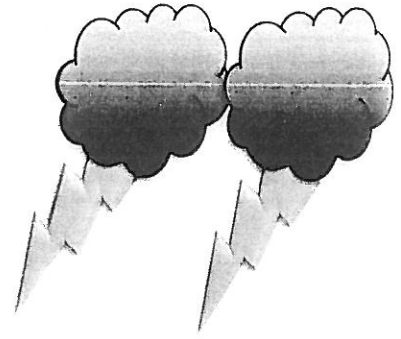
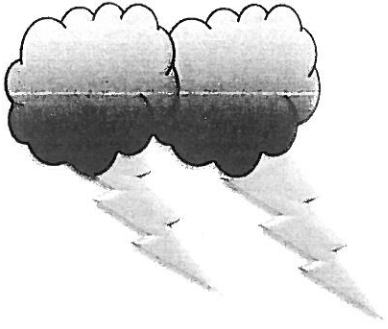
**ENVIRONMENTAL**

- Heat: Emphasis needs to be placed on hydration.
- Be aware of signs and symptoms of heat related illness.
- Monitor yourself and your fellow crewmembers.
- RECORD Low fuel moistures and RECORD drought conditions persist.

**OPERATIONS**

- Be alert when working under helicopters.
- Be aware of civilian traffic that may be in the area.
- Be constantly aware of changing road conditions due to downhill rollout.

## Thunderstorm Safety Message and Procedures for a **LIGHTNING SAFETY ALERT**

Approaching thunderstorms may be noted by a sudden reverse in wind direction, a noticeable rise in wind speed, and a sharp drop in temperature. Rain, hail and lightning occur only in the mature stage of a thunderstorm.

Cloud to ground based lightning strikes increase sharply within fire areas according to IMETs. There is always a potential under the right conditions for Pyro cumulous lightning events as well.

Exercise situational awareness by observing the 30/30 rule. Refer to the IRPG page related to Thunderstorm Safety (Page 21 in the 2014 version/Green cover).

IMET will be monitoring the current weather and based on preplanned Decision Points will have the authority to issue a ***Lightning Safety Alert***. An announcement will be made by communications to all personnel and divisions about any anticipated watches, warnings or events.

For in camp personnel, a siren from on hand vehicles will be sounded for a minimum of 15 seconds a total of 3 times with a break in between. Should you hear this siren warning, seek shelter within a structure is possible.

If a permanent structure is not available, utilize the closest vehicle available. Remain as centered in the vehicle as possible remaining clear from windows.

Stay clear of tall trees, wire fences and utility lines.

Seeking shelter in a Tent is **NOT AN ACCEPTABLE** level of cover!!!

Once the event has been cleared by the IMET, an all clear shall be issued to commence normal operations via communications.

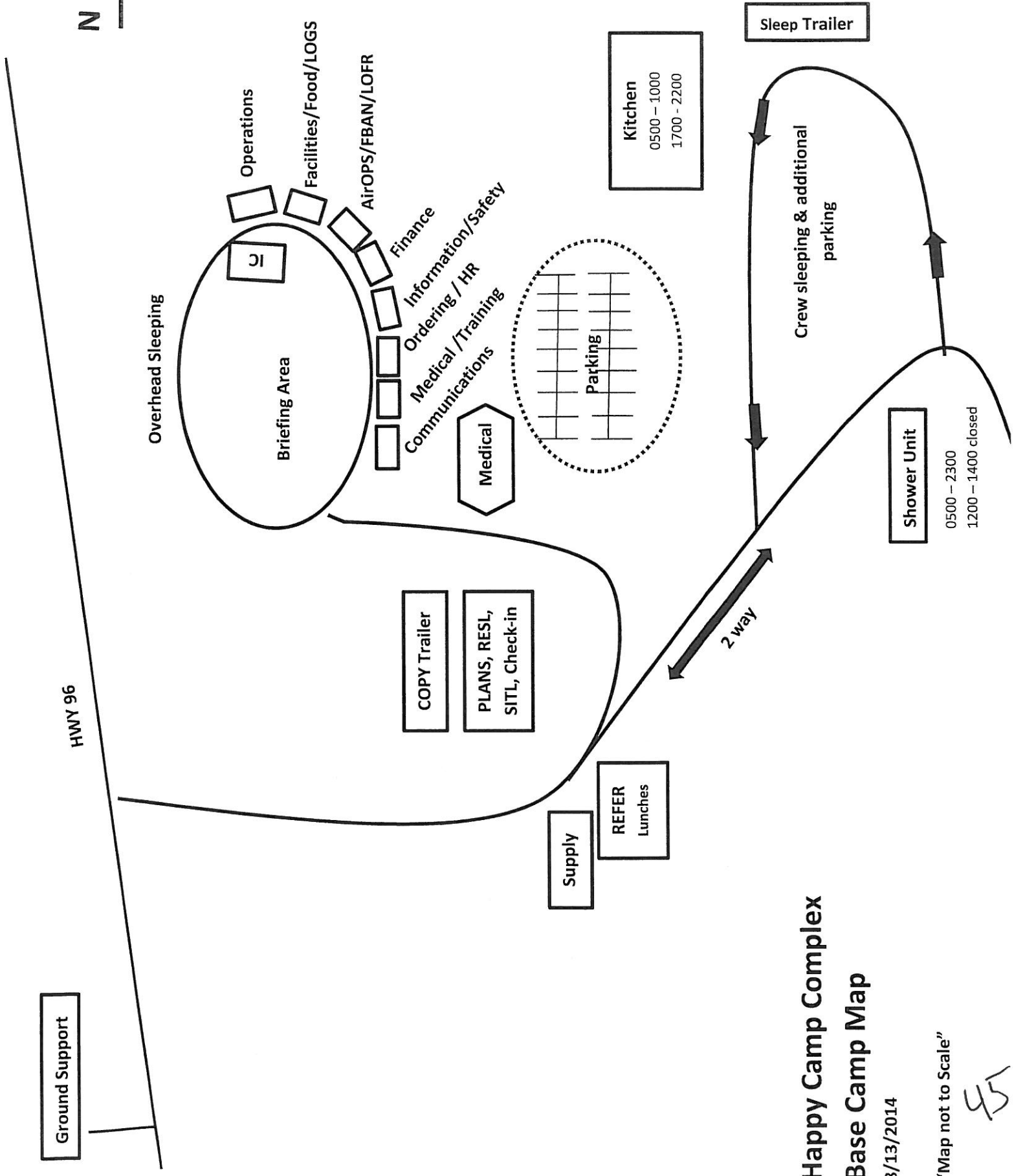
