

...RED FLAG WARNING FOR GUSTY NORTHEAST WINDS, LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITIES, AND UNSTABLE CONDITIONS THROUGH 11PM TONIGHT...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Very dry and unstable conditions with gusty northeast winds will affect the fire today. Haines 6 suggests plume dominated fire potential this afternoon if the fire breaks the inversion. Some northeast ridge winds will surface in drainages today, especially those that are oriented north to south or northeast to southwest. Gusty easterly ridgewinds are expected tonight with poor to moderate humidity recoveries.

WEATHER FORECAST FORTODAY (WEDNESDAYDAY SHIFT):

WEATHER: Very dry with gusty winds. Areas of smoke.

MAX TEMPERATURES: With Smoke: Valleys (1,200 ft) 80 - 85 F, Ridges (4,000 ft) 70 - 77 F

No Smoke: Valleys (1,200 ft) 85 – 91 F, Ridges (4,000 ft) 75 – 82 F

MIN HUMIDITY: With Smoke: Valleys (1,200 ft) 13–20%, Ridges (4,000 ft) 15 – 22%

Valleys (1,200 ft) 8 - 13%, Ridges (4,000 ft) 10 - 15% No Smoke:

WINDS (EYE LEVEL):

Lower Slopes / Drainages = Downslope/downcanyon then afternoon upslope /upcanyon 2 – 5 mph. Northeast to Southwest oriented drainages 4-8 mph with gusts to 12 mph.

Ridges – Northeast 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph.

LAL: 1 CWR: 0% HAINES:6 (unstable and favorable for plume dominated fire when inversion breaks)

STABILITY / INVERSION: Inversion could mix out as early as 1100.

SMOKE TRANSPORT: Northerly 10-15 mph.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT (WEDNESDAY NIGHT SHIFT):

WEATHER: Abundant smoke...otherwise mostly clear.

MIN TEMPERATURES: 55 to 65 F... upper slopes and ridges warmest. **MAX HUMIDITY:** Valleys (1,200 ft) 45 – 55%F, Ridges (4,000 ft) 30 – 40%.

Red Flag Warning for Gusty Northeast Winds, Low Relative Humidity's, and Unstable Conditions Through 11:00 PM Tonight.

High Temperature: 70-92° Minimum RH: 10-22%

Winds (eye level): Valleys becoming upslope/upcanyon 2-5 mph. Northeast to southwest oriented drainages 4-8 with

gusts to 12

Ridgetop winds 5-10 mph with gusts to 15 mph

Tonight:

Minimum temperature: 55-65°

Maximum RH: 30-55%

Winds (eye level): Valleys becoming downslope/ downvalley 3-6 mph, Strongest winds in east-west oriented

GENERAL:

POI: 60-80% on afternoon southerly aspects ERC: 90th percentile Live Fuel Moisture Brush: 80%

As inversion lifts out today dry unstable fire weather conditions could lead to plume dominated fire today with long range spotting (up to 2 miles). Westerly slopes and fuels aligned with the wind have potential for passive and active crown runs. The remainder of the fire will be fuels and topography driven. At present primary fire spread is from spot fires caused by rolling material and torching.

Night Shift Personnel: Fire behavior could be active on the slopes as the shift begins. Fire on ridgetops aligned with the east winds could be active throughout the evening and early morning hours. Fire behavior on the slopes backing into the drainages should decrease by early morning as the RH rises.

SPECIFIC:

Division O, Q, T, Z, D, F and I: These Divisions are still indicating scattered and isolated heat on the IR, however minimal fire activity is anticipated.

Division G and H: Isolated heat sources are still present; however minimal fire activity is anticipated.

Division J: Ridgetops Near Tom Martin Pk. And Browns Knob. Fire may become established in Kuntz Ck, Mill Ck, Mitchell Ck, and Macks Ck Drainages.

AIR OPERATIONS

Smoke cover in the morning could limit air operations.

SAFETY

Due to the dynamic nature of fire behavior, intensity estimates are often times difficult to make with absolute certainty. It is imperative firefighters consider the worst case fire potential and build their actions into their plan to compensate for the unexpected.

... RED FLAG WARNING IN EFFECT FROM 10 PM THIS EVENING (Tuesday) TO 11 PM PDT WEDNESDAY FOR THE COMBINATION OF STRONG WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITIES..

Concerns to Firefighters:

Expect fires to ignite easier and spread faster due to low live and dead fuel moistures. Recent fires have shown almost complete consumption of large dead fuels. Expect higher probability of ignition and increased spotting due to increased amount of receptive and available surface and aerial fuels.

Mitigation Measures

Firefighters should acknowledge and prepare for fire growth and fire behavior that may exceed anything they have experienced before due to the extreme drought. Normal strategies and tactics may need to be adjusted to account for the drought factor. Suppression actions need to be based on good anchor points, lookouts, communications, escape routes, and safety zones

✓ <u>Mountain Driving -- HWY 96</u> & Elk Creek-Driving involves the one of the greatest risk we face in an average day on this incident — it requires your full attention. Watch for deer on the roadway at early morning and night, especially down along Hwy 96; lots of deer versus vehicle accidents. Watch Out for firefighters working along roads.

All	Extreme Drought Conditions	 Local and inbound fire personnel need to be aware that fire behavior is exceeding normal expectations for this time of the year. Local briefings need to be thorough and highlight specific fire environment conditions. These include but are not limited to local weather forecasts, Pocket Cards, ERC's, live and dead fuel moistures, and special fuel conditions such as mortality, and frost killed brush, etc. Suppression actions need to be based on good anchor points, escape routes, and safety zones. Remember LCES. Experienced lookouts are essential under these conditions. Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire. Augment initial attack resources as incident activity dictates.
