#### WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Lightning activity and wetting rain potential are maximized today into tonight. Showers and thunderstorms are likely beginning as early as before sunrise this morning with the threat continuing through the day. There is about a 5 percent chance of quarter-size hail and gusty winds to 40 mph in the strongest storms in the vicinity of the fire. Temperatures will be much cooler with minimum RHs above 40 percent everywhere. Best chances for measurable rainfall will occur through the afternoon hours with one-tenth to one-quarter of an inch possible.

#### Discussion:

Lightning activity potential is maximized today. Showers and thunderstorms are likely with potential for gusty and erratic winds. Temperatures (worst case) will generally be at least 2-3° cooler than Thursday with minimum humidities at least 5% higher.

Weather: Mostly cloudy. 60% chance of thunderstorms all day.

**Max Temp:** 1000' elev: 73-77° 2500' elev: 68-73° 4000' elev: 64-78° **Min RH:** 1000' elev: 40-50% 2500' elev: 50-60% 4000' elev: 60-75%

Winds: GUSTY NEAR THUNDERSTORMS

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

#### GENERAL: ERC of 62 is above the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile.

Fire behavior predicted to be mostly low due to cool temperatures and high humidities. Surface fire flame lengths of 1-3' and rates of spread 1-2 ch/hr are expected. For all divisions, under worst case conditions with no cloud cover, no inversion and strong winds, flame lengths could reach 3-6' with a maximum rate of spread of 10 chains per hour. Torching and spots could reach ¼ mile with a probability of ignition of 40-50%.

Division A: Expect smoldering, creeping and 1-2' flame backing fire from the spotfire in the Knudsen Flat area.

**Divisions B - H:** Fire not anticipated to reach firelines in these Divisions.

**Divisions K, W:** Fire across Butler Ck. could spread slowly toward Divisions K and W with 1-2' flame lengths and 2-4 ch/hr ROS.

**Division Z:** It is unlikely that fire will cross Butler Ck. near Butler Flat due to cool weather and riparian zone around creek. If it crosses, low intensity and spread toward the Z/W break would ensue. Isolated heat pockets still exists along the Salmon River Road but slops/spots are very unlikely.
