<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> A trough of low pressure moving southeastward through the Pacific Northwest will bring increasing southwest winds and moisture to the fire area today. A cold front will move across the area late tonight and Sunday with more wind, moisture, and a chance for rain showers. The best chance of rain showers is early to mid-morning. The winds will decrease Sunday afternoon. Surface high will build east of the fire Sunday night through Monday night with increasing easterly winds. This could create critical fire weather conditions in Branch I with rapid drying and strong easterly winds.

Sky/weather......Partly cloudy with increasing clouds and wind through the day. Thick smoke haze in the morning...clearing

#### **FUELS:**

Fire areas include a range of conifer systems with Ponderosa, Jeffrey Pine, Incense Cedar, and manzanita in the lower elevations towards the west, transitioning up into an Upper Montane forest of Ponderosa, Lodgepole Pine and Red Fir closer to Lake Tahoe. Anticipate heavy fuel loading, drought stress, overstocked timber stands, and a lack of fire history to both the north and south of the current fire footprint. The El Dorado National Forest is currently classified as 'Extreme to Exceptional' drought by the US Drought Monitor, with Energy Release Components exceeding the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile, not far off all time high levels. Heavy dead and down fuels will likely burn completely, holding heat and actively consuming through all hours of the day. Fine dead fuel moisture is calculated at 4% or less.

General: Increased wind speeds will assist the fire in moving from the ground up into the crowns, especially on wind/slope aligned runs. The primary spread model is torching/spotting, so any fire that is able to elevate into the canopies has the potential to loft embers and create spot fires outside current containment lines.

#### **SPECIFIC**

**Branch 1** Division Gulf will likely see the gusty SW winds along the river corridor, threatening to loft holdover heat source embers to the north where slope, aspect, and wind will support rapid fire growth. Low probability due to all the good work from ground crews, but high consequence area for spotting.

#### **Branch 3**

<u>Divisions India and Mike</u> do have scattered heat with smoldering and smoke production interior as well as in rocked out areas along the northern perimeters. These areas may see some wind blockage and will not be in alignment, but looking out ahead could be impacted by strong winds from the east after the system passes early next week. Communities along the Highway 50 corridor are another low probability/high consequence area if stubborn heat sources are able to find a path into the crowns with increased winds in the river corridor.

Divisions Quebec and Romeo have widespread scattered heat along the fire edge, with potential for ground fire to elevate into the crowns with support from gusty SW winds today. Fire that does become established with group torching or crown runs will likely cause long range spotting downwind.

Divisions Oscar and Papa do have high severity fire areas in the interior, but the edges are more mosaic severity so reburning and flare ups are still possible. Areas closer to Christmas Valley may be more exposed to SW winds due to terrain enhancement.

**Night Operations:** Strong winds may support torching, spotting, and fire growth where fire has elevated from the ground up into the canopies across the entire fire area.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

Potential turbulent winds may limit ability for aircraft to support missions.

#### SAFETY:

Increased winds will do their best to bring quiet areas of the fire back to life, especially due to long term drought conditions in the fire area.

#### **Hazards & Risks**

Hazardous Materials: Working around burned out structures can expose you to smoke by-products often laced with chemical compounds not found in vegetation fires. Work up-wind and use water streams from a safe distance. Watch for propane tanks, gas lines, electrical wires, gas tanks and septic pits. Evaluate the structure for collapse potential. Review your IRPG.

<u>Tactical Pause:</u> Following a transition in leadership, it would be a good time to review some of the basic <u>safety</u> tenants of firefighting.

L. C.E. S:

- Are there a new set of Lookout eyes on the fire?
- Has the comm plan been changed? Is there Cell Coverage?
- Is the DIV/Branch you're assigned to the same or have things changed?
- Is that safety zone you had in your back pocket the last few shifts now miles away?
- Have hazards been scouted out?

Just a few thoughts to discuss with your crews.

**Public Interactions:** There may be an increase in public encounters between fire personnel and local residents within the fire area this coming weekend. Be aware of increased traffic flow on all the highways and forest roads. Area closures are in place but not everyone knows of them or chooses to abide by them. Be respectful of private property boundaries and make efforts to avoid confrontations. Remember that the local folks are dealing with us and this fire. Review some basic fire information and be ready to answer basic questions. **Do not guess or speculate. Tell only the FACTS!**

#### TAHOE BEAR SAFETY

Tahoe bears are American black bears; they can vary in color from tan, brown, black to blonde.

#### BEAR BEHAVIOR

- -Tahoe bears are not normally aggressive, but they may be bold in food acquisition.
- -Black bears will **generally avoid people.** Tahoe bears are often habituated— accustomed and indifferent to people. They may approach people and may not run from aversion actions.
- -Signs of agitation may include: **teeth clacking, jaw popping, or swatting the ground with their front paws**. Habituated bears may also **bluff charge**—rush quickly toward people, stopping just shy of making contact.

#### WHAT TO DO

- 1) If you are approached by a black bear, DO NOT RUN. Stand your ground, make noise and get big. If attacked, fight back.
- 2) Properly store and secure all food, drinks and trash. No food in tents. No coolers inside vehicles. All trash in dumpsters (not next to or on top of). Lock dumpsters.
- 3) If situation escalates, call **Eldorado County Sheriff** at **530-621-6600**. Only local LE should be engaged for aversion actions.
- 4) If you see an injured bear, report to the Wildlife Disaster Network at 1-800-942-6459.



#### **Incident Behavior**

Fireline Handbook, Chapter 6 - Common Responsibilities

#### Inappropriate Behavior:

It is important that inappropriate behavior be recognized and dealt with promptly. Inappropriate behavior is all forms of harassment including sexual and racial harassment. When you observe or hear of inappropriate behavior you should:

- Inform and educate subordinates of their rights and responsibilities
- Provide support to the victim.
- Develop appropriate corrective measures.
- Report the incident to your supervisor, if the behavior continues.
  - Document inappropriate behavior and report it to the employee's home agency.
  - While working in and around private property, recognize and respect all private property.

#### Drugs and Alcohol:

- Non-prescription unlawful drugs and alcohol are not permitted at the incident.
   Possession or use of these substances will result in disciplinary action.
- During off-incident Rest & Recuperation periods, personnel are responsible for proper conduct and maintenance of fitness for duty. Drug or alcohol abuse resulting in unfitness for duty will normally result in disciplinary action.
- Be a positive role model. Do not be involved with drug or alcohol abuse.
- · Report any observed drug or alcohol abuse to your supervisor.




