WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Southwest winds will continue to increase over the fire today as an upper trough moves onshore, breaking down the upper ridge. While temperatures will be a little cooler and RH a little higher, strong southwest winds are expected, leading to critical fire weather conditions. The strong southwest winds will continue tonight. A cold front will move through the fire area between 0400-0700 PDT Tuesday, bringing the possibility of a few rain showers along with cooler conditions. Expect winds to decrease quickly behind the front for Tuesday,

FUELS:

Needles and leaves from dry and underburned trees is creating a fresh fuel bed. Fire will move easily through these fuels, often undetected, until reaching heavy fuels. The Eldorado National Forest is currently classified as 'Extreme to Exceptional' drought by the US Drought Monitor, with Energy Release Components exceeding the 90th percentile, not far off all time high levels. Heavy dead and down fuels will likely burn completely, holding heat and actively consuming through all hours of the day. Fine dead fuel moisture is calculated at 3% or less.

General: Increase spread potential with front passage, increased winds, and fresh fuel bed. Relief from very dry conditions will also accompany frontal passage but not before containment lines are wind tested. Drainage and wind alignment will amplify rates of spread.

Timber litter (TL6-closed canopy,

ground fuels)

SPECIFIC

Branch 1 - Line locations along ridge top will see strong winds with unfavorable wind directions. Special care should be taken to verify continuous fuel beds have not been created across control lines with forecast stronger winds.

Branch 3 – Higher elevation locations will see the highest winds speeds of this incident. Fire transitioning to crowns will produce moderate to long range spotting.

Divisions India and Mike could see increased surface fire activity as exposed areas will experience increase wind impacts. Pockets of heat well interior could produce fire movement to green inlands as fire finds fresh fuels to move through. Repopulation in the Highway 50 corridor may bring an increase in service calls; potential for reburn remains in the green islands.

Divisions Quebec and Romeo These areas will experience the strongest winds with the passing front. Broken fuels and rocky areas have left stringers of unburned fuel. Fire moving across ridges will see some shelter on the east aspects but will continue to move with the wind.

Divisions Oscar and Papa are favorably aligned with forecast winds. Containment lines are experienced lower severity impacts and reburning and flare ups could threaten to containment lines. High winds will likely have heavies and root wads burning again, producing smoke visible to residents.

Night Operations: Winds will increase into the evening hours before increasing relative humidity and reduced winds provided relief from red flag conditions.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Winds speeds will approach maximin levels aviation operations.

SAFETY:

Introduction of fresh fuel bed from needle cast will allow fire to move across the landscape in previously burned areas. Fire can rapidly transition from surface fire to group touching and crowning.

Hazards & Risks

Fuel Geysers: Cases of "Fuel Geysers" involving leakage of chainsaw fuel, vapor lock/tank pressurization, and fuel spray have resulted in serious burns to firefighters. Firefighters should remember that fuel leakage, vapor lock/tank pressurization and potential fuel spray can occur at any time when using chainsaws. Fuel can become pressurized in any container that does not automatically vent and can spray out when pressure is released rapidly. For firefighters working near ignition sources, having fuel on your clothing or skin presents a significant hazard. Personal Protective Equipment, even flame resistant clothing does not provide protection when fuel-soaked PPE ignites.

Fire Camp Safety: We usually don't think of Fire Camp as a dangerous place but camp has a few hazards to look out for:

- Trip hazards such as stairs, tent stakes, cables and wires are abundant.
- Vehicle traffic in and around parking areas and driving through camp.
- Electrical shock from all the power cords and power strips plugged in our tents, kitchen area, hand wash stations and shower unit.
- Wildlife and insects.
- Walking and talking or texting on our cell phones.
- Sharp objects such as scissors, tacks, saws and nails.
- Adverse weather; to name just a few Fire Camp Watch Outs.
 So, pay attention to your surroundings and avoid distractions!

Travel Home: You've survived the fire, now survive the drive home. If you are demobing, get plenty of rest time prior to your departure, especially those of you with long drives. Take rest stops as needed and don't sacrifice your safety in a rush to get back. Use seat belts and ARRIVE ALIVE!





- Oct. 11: First dose deadline (Moderna COVID-19 vaccine)
- Oct. 18: First dose deadline (Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine)

- Nov. 8: First (only) dose deadline (Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine)

Hotel Acquisition Process

The Caldor incident has authorized the individual procurement of hotel accommodations. This is for lodging only. The process below discusses financial procedure and documentation:

If you are a **local agency dispatched through CFAA**, you will need to acquire an S# prior to demob. This number will also be entered on your F42 form.

Federal resources with a travel card will be processed through your agency's travel reimbursement process. Finance will provide a 213 with approval statement upon demob, if required by your agency.

All other non-federal resources, or federal resources that do not have purchasing capability, complete the following:

AD's who are able to pay and get reimbursed for travel will need to pay lodging and get reimbursed through your normal reimbursement process. You will be given a 213 with authorization statement from the finance section during demob.

For AD's and Seasonal Federal Employees who are unable to pay for lodging, the buying team may be able to assist with purchasing your accommodations. Inquire with the incident Finance Section. Federal resources who have the crew boss card option should use this as a first option.

In accordance with each individual contract, **contractors** shall pay for lodging and submit receipts for additions to your invoice (OF-286). Itemized receipts ARE required by the finance section during demob. Also, please note that double occupancy may be required on many contracts.

The finance section will provide S#'s during your demob or sooner.

West side, Branch 1: Accommodations

Resources working the *west* side of the incident and briefing at the El Dorado Fairgrounds are expected to be self-sufficient for dinners and hotel accommodations. Breakfast, sack lunches, and hydration products will be provided at briefing. There is no need to return to the fairgrounds until the next briefing unless you need additional support services.

East side, Branch 3: All meals provided by the incident. To Acquire lodging:

Harvey's hotel is associated with Harrah's. They are across the street from each other and are joined by a tunnel under Hwy 50 on the Nevada side at the state line. They have opened the Harvey's hotel specifically for firefighters battling the Caldor fire. No public is staying at that property. Hotel support and check in for Harvey's Hotel, including front desk services is located at the Harrah's property. This includes check-in and any maintenance service. Large vehicle parking is at the large parking lot at Harrah's accessible off Lake Parkway. Small vehicles can access the parking structure at Harvey's. At both locations, collect the parking stub to go through the gate. There is no charge for parking. Exit gates will open from 0500 to 0700. You may still use your hotel card or ring for attendant to open the exit gate if needed.

To reserve a room, scan this code to make your reservation. Be sure to have your purchase card and crew manifest ready to enter the names of the personnel for each room configuration purchased with that card:



After reserving, go to the Harrah's front desk and complete registration. They are very understaffed, so please make every attempt to use the web link above to reserve, though you may also call the hotel desk at 775-691-0416 to reserve your room under "Caldor Fire".

Once you check in to the hotel on the Harrah's side, you will then proceed to Harvey's either through the underground tunnel or drive to the Harvey's parking structure. Note: the elevator bank closest to the (currently closed) Harvey's front desk is not in service for ascending (Descending works). You will need to use the Mountain Tower elevator bank by the arcade.

The hotel asks that if you would like trash pickup, please place your trash bags in the hallway and call the front desk to let them know where it is. They don't have enough staff to patrol the halls. They are also available to clean rooms and deliver towels and other items, but you will need to call the front desk for that as well.
