FIRE BEHAVIOR

Division P: Concentrations of heavy fuels. Backing, flanking, rollout and upslope movement. Expect spotting.

Division Q: Potential rollout and upslope movement. SW winds will test containment lines across the face of the slope. Be aware of alignment.

Branch III (Dotta)

Division E/H: Rollout into Horton Canyon or Dotta Spur "C" has the potential to be affected by forecasted SW winds.

Division K: Horton Ridge has the potential for active fire behavior due to alignment with fuel, weather and topography.

Night Division

Cooler temperatures tonight. Moderate RH recovery on ridgetops. Diurnal downslope winds. A PIG of 30% will minimize fire behavior and keep spot fires manageable. Firing operations may be successful once the conditions moderate (early morning hours).

OPERATIONAL TEMPO

Maintaining operational tempo is not solely about speeding up to match or exceed the pace of the environment. It is also about knowing when operations should slow down and why.

We are most vulnerable to accidents and errors when operational tempo changes, especially when it changes quickly.

Maintaining good situation awareness despite change in operational tempo represents a considerable challenge.

The key to managing operational tempo successfully is monitoring the changing environment and capabilities of the team, and then applying good judgment to determine whether to push forward or pull back while making necessary adjustments.

Be sure all elements of your safety plan are in place prior to Engagement!!

This policy applies to all Forest Service employees in their working relationship with other Federal employees, non-Federal employees, and the public. The policy also applies to persons working under contract or other formal agreements with the Forest Service, such as Administratively Determined (AD) and volunteers.

The Agency prohibits the following conduct, as further defined in FSM 8100 section 8110.5:

- 1. Sexual Assault/Violence;
- 2. Sexual Harassment;
- 3. EEO-Based Harassment;
- 4. Other Workplace Harassment (non-EEO, including bullying); and
- 5. Retaliation against employees who report or oppose harassment.

Reports of harassment will be handled in a confidential manner, to the extent allowed by applicable law.

Employees who believe they have experienced harassment are encouraged to voice their objections concerning this behavior to the offending person and/or report such incidents.

There will be zero tolerance of harassment, bullying, intimidation, or any resemblance of such on this incident period.


