...Excessive Heat Warning in Effect Today...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A little further warming today as strong high pressure brings well above normal temperatures to the fire area. Relative humidity will remain low. Mostly sunny skies will prevail over the fire area but some isolated thunderstorms may form to the southeast in the afternoon. There is a small chance for an outflow boundary to affect the fire area in the afternoon or early evening. Winds will be lighter today but still becoming breezy in the afternoon. Upslope winds along the escarpment will see a wind reversal to west southwest, likely in the early afternoon. Diminishing winds after sunset with lighter terrain driven winds prevailing overnight. Tonight will be slightly warmer with continued poor to moderate humidity recovery.

WEATHER FORECAST for SATURDAY:

Weather around fire area

WEATHER: Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke. Pyrocumulus development likely.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 95-100° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 90-95°

HUMIDITY: 10-17%

HAINES INDEX: 6 (High potential for large fire growth)

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 8-12 mph. Gusts to around 20 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the morning, becoming west southwest 7-13 mph

with gusts to around 20 mph in the afternoon.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate stability in the morning, inversion around 6000', lifting late morning.

WEATHER FORECAST for SATURDAY NIGHT:

WEATHER: Areas of smoke, otherwise mostly clear.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 50-60° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 60-68°

(Warmest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

HUMIDITY: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 30-45% Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 20-30%

(Lowest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 6-12 mph with gusts to around 20 mph in the early evening, decreasing

after sunset to southwest 5-10 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - West southwest 7-13 mph with gusts around 20 mph in the early evening diminishing after sunset and transitioning to downslope/downvalley 1-5 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Becoming more stable overnight with inversion developing after midnight.

OUTLOOK for Sunday through Tuesday: An Excessive Heat Warning remains in effect for the fire area through Monday. Relative humidity remaining very low with poor to moderate overnight recovery. Southwest flow will continue with gusty afternoon and evening winds, followed by lighter terrain driven winds overnight.

EXCESSIVE HEAT WARNING IN EFFECT

WEATHER: Mostly sunny. Areas of smoke. Pyrocumulus development possible.

MAX TEMP: Mid Slope: 90-95° Valleys: 95-100°

Humidity 10-17%

20 FOOT WINDS: Valleys/Slope: upslope 4-8 mph becoming WSW 7-13mph G20 mph in the afternoon.

Ridge Top: SW 8-12 mph Gusts to near 20 mph.

LAL: 0 HAINES INDEX 5 CHANCE OF WETTING RAIN: 0%

FUELS: The major fuel types, found in and around the fire area are timber understory and brush. **Ignition Receptiveness:** ERC levels are below the 90th percentile. **Probability of Ignition** 100%

Dryness: Dead and down fuel moistures:1 hour -2 % 10 hour-5 %, 100 hour-6 %, and 1000 hour-10%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Anticipate extreme fire behavior with the potential for Pyrocumulus development (down drafts and erratic winds). Fire behavior will include surface running fire, group torching and long-range spotting. Plan for a transition of fuel from timber understory and grass to a tall grass and brush model east side of the escarpment. ROS in Tall grass 180-190 chains per hour, Flame length 15-19ft, Spotting distance 0.4 mile. ROS in brush 135-145 chains per hour, Flame length 25-30ft, Spotting distance 0.6 mile.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Branch I

Division B: Minimal fire behavior, interior smoldering and creeping near the line.

Division O: Very active wind driven fire behavior, long range spotting, group torching, potential for crown runs. Fuel model transition to annual grass and brush east of the escarpment. Expect an increase in ROS, FL and spotting distances.

Division P: Very active fire behavior due to SW wind influence. Concentrations of heavy fuels. Running surface fire, flanking, backing and slope reversal. Potential for long range spotting.

Division Q: Potential rollout and upslope movement. SW winds will test containment lines across the face of the slope. Light flashy fuels at the toe of the slope. Be aware of alignment.

Chilcoot Group: No fire activity.

Branch III

Division E/H/K: Rollout into Horton Canyon or Dotta Spur "C" has the potential to be affected by forecasted SW winds.

Division M: very active fire behavior and potential for large fire spread. Long range spotting, backing and flanking. Heavy fuel loading.

<u>Doyle Branch:</u> Potential for active fire behavior due to SW wind and alignment with the main fire. anticipate spot fires. Plan for strong down slope hot and dry wind off the escarpment.

Night Division

Cooler temperatures tonight. Moderate RH recovery on ridgetops. Diurnal downslope winds. A PIG of 40% (after midnight) will minimize fire behavior and keep spot fires manageable. Expect fire activity to diminish after 0300. Firing operations may be successful once the conditions moderate (early morning hours). Be mindful of wind shift in the escarpment area. Grass and brush fuel model east of the escarpment.


