... Excessive Heat Warning remains in effect today...

<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> The Excessive Heat Warning remains in effect today with little to no decrease in temperatures. Light winds will increase beginning late morning with gusty conditions through the afternoon and evening then tapering off after sunset with lighter terrain influenced winds prevailing overnight. Very dry conditions will continue with afternoon humidity falling into the single digits in some areas, followed by poor to moderate overnight recovery. Overnight temperatures will be a little cooler than last night.

WEATHER FORECAST for TUESDAY:

Weather obs around fire area

WEATHER: Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 94-102° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 88-95°

HUMIDITY: 6-14% HAINES INDEX: 6 (High potential for large fire growth)

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 5-10 mph increasing to 10-20 mph by afternoon. Gusts to around 28 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the morning, becoming west southwest 9-18 mph

with gusts to around 28 mph in the afternoon.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate stability in the morning, inversion around 5500', lifting late morning.

WEATHER FORECAST for TUESDAY NIGHT:

WEATHER: Areas of smoke, otherwise clear.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 55-65° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 60-70°

(Warmest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

HUMIDITY: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 30-45% Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 20-30%

(Lowest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 10-20 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the early evening, decreasing after sunset to southwest 5-10 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - West southwest 8-18 mph with gusts around 28 mph in the early evening diminishing after sunset and transitioning to downslope/downvalley 1-6 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Becoming more stable overnight with inversion developing after midnight.

<u>OUTLOOK for Wednesday through Friday:</u> Temperatures will trend lower through Friday, resulting in highs only slightly above normal by the end of the week. A very dry air mass will persist with little change in relative humidity. The same daily wind cycle will continue with gusty west to southwest winds each afternoon and evening, followed by lighter terrain driven winds overnight.

WEATHER SUMMARY ***EXCESSIVE HEAT WARNING IN EFFECT***

WEATHER: Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke.

MAX TEMP: Mid Slope: 88-95° Valleys: 94-102°

Humidity 6-14%

20 FOOT WINDS: Valleys/Slope: upslope 4-8 mph becoming WSW 9-18mph G28 mph in the afternoon.

Ridge Top: SW 5-10 mph increasing 10-20mph by afternoon Gusts to near 28 mph.

FUELS: The major fuel types, found in and around the fire area are timber understory and brush. **Ignition Receptiveness: ERC** levels are above the 90th percentile. **Probability of Ignition** 100% **Dryness:** Dead and down fuel moistures:1 hour – % **10 hour – 3%**, 100 hour – 4%, and 1000 hour –6%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Plan for an exceptionally hot and dry shift. The potential for large fire growth continues to exist. Fire behavior has shown to intensify starting around 1400 in clear air and will continue through the morning hours. Watch for alignment of wind and topography in the NE areas of Branch I & IV. Don't be lured into a false sense of security, a seemingly cold piece of line can become active with strong winds.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Branch I

Division A: Minimal fire behavior, interior smoldering. SW wind should help keep fire in its current footprint.

Division C/E/G: Active fire behavior, fuel and terrain driven. ROS approx. 80 chains a day (in the area of Dixie Mountain). Heavy concentration of fuels.

Division I: Fuel and topography driven fire will continue to consume fuels and move to the North. Under windy conditions potential for alignment exist. Expect group torching, spotting and slope reversal. Heavy concentration of fuels.

Branch IV

Division N: Interior smoldering islands will be susceptible to torching and spotting. Potential for turbulent winds east of the escarpment.

Division R & Division T: Smoldering heavy fuels and islands under windy conditions can spread embers into receptive fuel beds (grass and sage) near Hwy 395. Potential for spotting under strong downslope winds.

Branch VII

Division V: Minimal activity. Smoldering and creeping. Under windy conditions fire activity can increase. **Division X/Z:** Minimal activity, interior smoldering. Potential for increased activity due to SW winds. **Night Divisions**

High temperatures and low RH in the beginning of the shift. Poor to moderate RH recovery on ridge tops. Be mindful of wind shifts and speeds due to topographical features. The shift will start with a Pig of 80-90% diminishing after midnight. Expect fire activity to diminish after 0100. Anticipate strong down slope winds and erratic fire behavior east of the escarpment.

- Drought conditions: Use all of the assessment tools; Heads up for fire behavior; Ensure LCES
 is in place; Take extra time to ensure it is safe to engage! Use extra caution all the time.
- All trees can be dangerous. They don't have to be leaning, dead, burned, or gnarly. Perform
 adequate assessments, minimize exposure and risk around all trees.
- Line Construction: Use all of the safety protocols concerning line construction. Watch the spacing, footing, and other firefighters below.

"SEE SOMETHING......SAY SOMETHING!"

If you see a hazard or a dangerous situation developing, tell your supervisor and those around you.

Leaders set the Example

All leaders of firefighters have the responsibility to provide a model their subordinates will emulate and follow. You should:

- Share the hazards and hardships with subordinates
- A positive attitude is infectious
- Don't show discouragement when facing setbacks
- Choose the difficult right over the easy wrong
- Provide Leader's Intent:
 - Task
 - Purpose
 - End State

Night Shift: Patrol with a Purpose!

- Obtain a clear briefing to understand the purpose and intent of the patrol.
- Coordinate all patrol activities with adjoining patrol resources.
- Maintain strict accountability of all resources.
- Always keep the purpose of the patrol in mind before engaging.
- Always assess risk versus gain when considering taking action during patrol activities.

ALL	TRAFFIC HAZARDS AND DRIVING	 Travelers on Highway 395 often exceed the posted speed limit. Take extra precaution when entering or exiting the Highway. During high fire activity, expect drivers to pull over or drive through the area slower. Practice "Defensive Driving" techniques. Maintain high visibility when in the operational area, use warning lights whe working on roads or traveling in smoke. Best practice is to follow California DOT standard with high vis vest where appropriate Many roads are narrow and mid-slope, with soft shoulders. Allow heavy vehicles to pass on uphill side. Use spotters when backing or turning around 5mph speed limit in and around ICP, keep your speed down in all areas. ALL	INDIRECT LINE CONSTRUCTION	 Establish and maintain LCES. Utilize favorable locations when constructing control features; IE lighter fuel natural or existing barriers and ridgelines
ALL	AIR OPERATIONS	 Follow "Aviation Watch-Out Situations" on page 46, IRPG. Do not plan on air resources for tactical support or medical transportation. Refer to page 58, IRPG for directing bucket drops. Ensure positive communication with all air resources.
ALL	FIRE BEHAVIOR	 Are you seeing what we have predicted? Conduct thorough assessments before starting work. Ensure LCES is in place. Plan & communicate your exit strategy with your crew and adjacent resources. Provide additional briefing for new resources and maintain communications.
ALL	NIGHT OPERATIONS	Have a purpose for where you drive and what you do. Don't rush into assignments. Use caution where you park or stage, especially in steep timbered areas. Use available time for briefings on roads, terrain, and potential rolling material, especially if the resources are new to the area. Increase SA by trying to see the work area during daylight hours. Use glow sticks to mark hazards, and ensure personnel have headlamps.
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	Share your Situational Awareness (hazards, changes, etc.) to those who also have a need. Answer questions when asked by others. Ask for intel when you do not know the plan. Ensure all personnel are familiar with the incident and IA communications plans.
ALL	HEAT RELATED ILLNESS	 Drink 2 to 1 water to sports drinks. Take frequent breaks, minimum of 10 minutes every hour. Recognize symptoms of HEAT RELATED ILLNESS which include low energy, cramping, headaches, dizziness, poor rest, poor eating habits, hot skin, and lack of sweating.
ALL	HAZARD / DANGER TREES	 Follow Hazard Tree Safety Guidelines (IRPG p.22.) Limit number of personnel around snags and their exposure time. Fallers mustbe qualified for the trees being felled. Be alert around hazard trees during wind events, even green trees. The hazard zone extends a minimum of 2½ tree lengths. Avoid parking vehicles or taking breaks under or near hazard trees.
ALL	WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE OPERATIONS	 Maintain continuous Situational Awareness based upon the fire environment observed fire behavior, hazards and incident objectives. Key to success in the WUI is preparation and preplanning. Be active and engage in defense preparations & do not wait for the fire to arrive. Be decisive in tactical engagement. Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist

Fully vaccinated people:

- Do not need to wear a mask or physically distance in federal buildings or on Federal lands, except where called for by Federal, State, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations


