### ...Continued Dry and Gusty...

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Temperatures will be a little lower today but still top out several degrees above normal. Light winds will increase through late morning with gusty conditions in the afternoon and evening then tapering off after sunset with lighter terrain influenced winds prevailing overnight. Very dry conditions will continue with afternoon humidity falling into the single digits in some areas, followed by poor to moderate overnight recovery. Ridge winds may be slightly higher than previous nights. Slightly lower overnight temps.

### WEATHER FORECAST for WEDNESDAY:

Weather obs around fire area



**WEATHER:** Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke.

**TEMPERATURES:** Valleys/Lower Slopes: 91-99° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 85-92°

**HUMIDITY:** 7-17% **HAINES INDEX:** 5 (Moderate potential for large fire growth)

#### **20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** - Southwest 5-10 mph increasing to 10-20 mph by afternoon. Gusts to around 28 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the morning, becoming west southwest 9-18 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the afternoon.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Moderate stability in the morning, inversion around 5800', lifting late morning.

### WEATHER FORECAST for WEDNESDAY NIGHT:

**WEATHER:** Areas of smoke, otherwise clear.

**TEMPERATURES:** Valleys/Lower Slopes: 52-62° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 58-68°  
(Warmest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

**HUMIDITY:** Valleys/Lower Slopes: 30-45% Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 20-30%  
(Lowest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

#### **20 FT WINDS:**


**RIDGETOP** - Southwest 10-20 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the early evening, decreasing after sunset to southwest 7-13 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - West southwest 8-18 mph with gusts around 28 mph in the early evening diminishing after sunset and transitioning to downslope/downvalley 1-6 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Becoming more stable overnight with inversion developing after midnight.

**OUTLOOK for Thursday through Saturday:** Temperatures will continue to trend lower through Friday resulting in temperatures closer to normal. A very dry air mass will persist with low afternoon humidity but cooler nights will allow for a little better overnight humidity recovery. The daily wind cycle will continue with gusty southwest to west winds in the afternoons and evenings, followed by lighter terrain winds overnight.

**WEATHER:** Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke.

**MAX TEMP:** Mid Slope: 85-92° Valleys: 91-99°

**Humidity** 7-15%

**20 FOOT WINDS:** Valleys/Slope: upslope 4-8 mph becoming **WSW 9-18mph G28 mph** in the afternoon.  
Ridge Top: **SW 5-10 mph** increasing **10-20mph** by afternoon **Gusts to near 28 mph.**

**LAL: 0 HAINES INDEX 5 CHANCE OF WETTING RAIN:** 0%

**FUELS:** The major fuel types, found in and around the fire area are timber understory and brush.

**Ignition Receptiveness:** ERC levels are above the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile. **Probability of Ignition** 100%

**Dryness:** Dead and down fuel moistures: 1 hour -4 % **10 hour-** 4%, 100 hour- 5%, and 1000 hour-9%.

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

The fire environment will remain conducive to fire spread and growth. Fire behavior has shown to intensify starting around 1400 in clear air and will continue through the morning hours. Watch for alignment of wind and topography in all areas of the incident. Fire behavior will vary in intensity based on your location. Be mindful of the potential for ember cast off the escarpment from strong down slope wind.

### SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

#### Branch I

**Division A:** Minimal fire behavior, interior smoldering. SW wind should help keep fire in its current footprint.

**Division C/E/G:** Active fire behavior, fuel and terrain driven. ROS approx. 80 chains a day (in the area of Dixie Mountain). Heavy concentration of fuels.

**Division I:** Expect group torching, spotting and slope reversal. Topographical features will affect wind speeds and direction. Heavy concentration of fuels.

#### Branch IV

**Division N:** Interior smoldering islands will be susceptible to torching and spotting. Potential for turbulent winds east of the escarpment.

**Division R/T:** Smoldering heavy fuels and islands under windy conditions can spread embers into receptive fuel beds (grass and sage) near Hwy 395. Potential for spotting under strong downslope winds.

#### Branch VII

**Division V:** Minimal activity. Interior smoldering and creeping.

**Division X/Z:** Minimal activity, interior smoldering and creeping.

#### Night Divisions

High temperatures and low RH in the beginning of the shift. Poor to moderate RH recovery on ridge tops. Be mindful of wind shifts and speeds due to topographical features. The shift will start with a Pig of 70-80% diminishing after midnight. Expect fire activity to diminish after 0300. Potential for strong down slope winds and erratic fire behavior east of the escarpment.

## RISK MANAGEMENT

Use the following process to quickly assess risk for the situations you face throughout the day.

**Step 1** - Identify the hazards. Make this an ongoing, continuous process in your daily decision making routine. Gather as much information as possible.

**Step 2** - Assess the risk levels. The probability and severity of an undesirable outcome linked to identified hazards = **RISK**.

**Step 3** - Analyze and select control or mitigation measures. **Limiting exposure is almost always an option.**

**Step 4** - Reassess risk level with controls in place (residual risk).

**Step 5** - Make your informed decision based on the residual risk. Ask the **risk vs. gain** question: is the benefit of the action I'm considering worth the risk?

**Step 6** - Monitor the situation

## RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS OF FATIGUE

The effects of fatigue can directly hinder our abilities to:

- Perform various tasks, maintain a positive and supportive attitude
- Maintain situational awareness and a high degree of alertness
- React appropriately in a timely manner and fashion
- Retain a sharp memory and recollection of information




