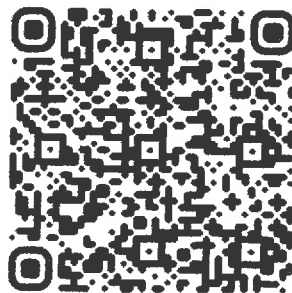



WEATHER DISCUSSION: Winds will continue to become gusty in the afternoon through the evening with a west southwest prevailing flow. However, terrain channeling and inflow to the fire can alter the wind pattern. The fire has been creating its own weather at times and that threat will continue with additional fire whirls with strong erratic winds possible. Downsloping winds from the escarpment also could bring a period of increased westerly wind gusts in Branch IV in the late afternoon and evening. A cooling trend will continue with temperatures only slightly above normal today. The air mass remains dry with low afternoon humidity followed by poor to moderate overnight recovery. The dry air mass also will allow for a wide range in low temperatures with localized areas dropping into the 30s due to cold air pooling. Most areas will fall into the 40s and 50s while mid slopes may stay in the 60s.

WEATHER FORECAST for THURSDAY:

WEATHER: Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 86-94° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 80-86°

HUMIDITY: 7-17% **HAINES INDEX: 5 (Moderate potential for large fire growth)**

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 7-14 mph increasing to 10-18 mph by afternoon. Gusts to around 28 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the morning, becoming west southwest 8-16 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the afternoon. Local effects can alter wind flow.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate stability in the morning, inversion around 5800', lifting late morning.

WEATHER FORECAST for THURSDAY NIGHT:

WEATHER: Areas of smoke, otherwise clear and cooler.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 35-55° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 55-65°
(Warmest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

HUMIDITY: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 30-50% Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 25-35%
(Lowest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

20 FT WINDS:


RIDGETOP - Southwest 10-18 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the early evening, gradually decreasing after sunset to southwest 6-12 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - West southwest 8-16 mph with gusts around 28 mph in the early evening diminishing after sunset and transitioning to downslope/downvalley 1-6 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Becoming more stable overnight with inversion developing after midnight.

OUTLOOK for Friday through Sunday: Temperatures will nudge down a bit more on Friday to near normal then a slight warming trend will occur over the weekend. Dry conditions will persist through at least Saturday then monsoon moisture could begin to arrive by Sunday for the potential of thunderstorms, likely dry initially. The same general pattern will continue with gusty southwesterly winds in the afternoon and evening but complex terrain and fire behavior can result in locally turbulent conditions including strong fire whirls.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

Anticipate similar environmental conditions as yesterday, hot, dry and gusty. The potential for large fire spread and very active fire behavior remains. 1400-1600 is the turning point for fire behavior to go from moderate to very active and potentially extreme. Watch for alignment of wind and topography in all areas of the incident. Fire behavior will vary in intensity based on your location. Be mindful of the potential for strong downslope winds, fire whirls and ember cast off the escarpment.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Branch I

Division A: Minimal fire behavior, interior smoldering.

Division C/E/G: Active fire behavior, fuel and terrain driven. ROS approx. 80 chains a day (in the area of Dixie Mountain). Heavy concentration of fuels.

Division I: Anticipate very active fire behavior. Expect group torching, spotting and slope reversal. Topographical features will affect wind speeds and direction. Heavy concentration of fuels.

Branch IV

Division N: Prepare for active fire behavior. Interior smoldering islands will be susceptible to torching and spotting. Potential for turbulent winds east of the escarpment.

Division R/T: Smoldering heavy fuels and islands under windy conditions can spread embers into receptive fuel beds.

Branch VII

Division V: Minimal activity. Interior smoldering and creeping.

Division X/Z: Minimal activity, interior smoldering and creeping.

Night Divisions

Mild temperatures and low RH in the beginning of the shift. Poor to moderate RH recovery on ridge tops. Be mindful of wind shifts and speeds due to topographical features. The shift will start with a Pig of 70-80% diminishing after midnight. Expect fire activity to diminish after 0300. Potential for strong down slope winds and erratic fire behavior east of the escarpment.

AIR OPERATIONS

All passengers must receive a safety briefing prior to a flight.

Lead with Respect

Fireline leaders respect their co-workers and subordinates. This attitude creates an atmosphere of professionalism and effectiveness in line resources. As an additional benefit, safety is enhanced. Employ your people in accordance with their qualifications and capabilities.

- Know your people and look out for their well-being.
- Keep your people informed.
- Build the team.

Hazard Tree Indicators

Trees have been burning for an extended period of time. High risk tree species (rot and shallow root system). Numerous down trees. Dead or broken tops and limbs overhead. Accumulation of down limbs. Absence of needles, bark or limbs. Leaning or hung-up trees. Water or retardant drops in the area have broken or weakened limbs in the canopy

Working with Heavy Equipment

- Don't approach until you have eye contact with the operator and all implements have been lowered.
- Avoid working downhill from equipment.
- Communicate all hazards to the operator.
- During night shift or low visibility, use a headlamp or glow sticks so the operator can see you.
- Equipment operators can have a difficult time see you ground personnel; take responsibility for your safety and all of those around you.

Back to the Basics

- Size-Up; when does it start and when does it end?
- You can size up the weather, fuels, topography and the condition of crews enroute to a fire.
- Once on the incident, size-up should be occurring constantly to keep up situational awareness.
- Size-up does not end at demob. It ends when you are back at home, after your gear is repacked and reset for the next assignment

Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist

- Current Forest Service policy is that fully vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a mask or physically distance in federal buildings or on Federal lands, except where called for by Federal, State, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations.
