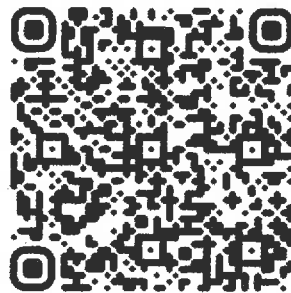



WEATHER DISCUSSION: Gusty winds will again develop in the afternoon through the evening with a general west southwest flow. However, complex terrain channeling and inflow to the fire can alter the wind pattern. The fire has been creating its own weather at times and that threat will continue with additional fire whirls with strong erratic winds possible. Downsloping winds from the escarpment also could bring a period of increased westerly wind gusts in Branch IV from the late afternoon into the evening. Temperatures will change little today while the air mass remains dry with low afternoon humidity followed by poor to moderate overnight recovery. The dry air also will create a wide range in low temperatures with localized areas falling into the 30s due to cold air pooling. Most areas will be in the 40s and 50s with some mid-slopes in the 60s.

WEATHER: Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 86-94° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 80-86°

HUMIDITY: 7-17% **HAINES INDEX:** 5 (Moderate potential for large fire growth)

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 7-13 mph increasing to 10-18 mph by afternoon. Gusts to around 28 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the morning, becoming west southwest 8-16 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the afternoon. Local effects can alter wind flow.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate stability in the morning, inversion around 5800', lifting late morning.

WEATHER: Areas of smoke, otherwise clear and cooler.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 35-55° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 55-65°
(Warmest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

HUMIDITY: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 30-50% Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 25-35%
(Lowest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

20 FT WINDS:


RIDGETOP - Southwest 10-18 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the early evening, gradually decreasing after sunset to southwest 6-12 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - West southwest 8-16 mph with gusts around 28 mph in the early evening diminishing after sunset and transitioning to downslope/downvalley 1-6 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Becoming more stable overnight with inversion developing after midnight.

OUTLOOK for Saturday through Monday: Slight warming will occur over the weekend. Dry conditions will persist through Sunday then a return of monsoon moisture is expected by Monday bringing the potential of thunderstorms. The same general wind pattern will continue with west southwest gusts during the afternoon and evening but complex terrain and fire behavior can result in very erratic wind speeds and direction.

WEATHER: Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke.

MAX TEMP: Mid Slope: 80-86° Valleys: 86-94°

FUELS: The major fuel types, found in and around the fire area are timber understory and brush.

Ignition Receptiveness: ERC levels are just below the 97th percentile. **Probability of Ignition 100%**

Dryness: Dead and down fuel moistures: 1 hour – 1% **10 hour–5%**, 100 hour– 6%, and 1000 hour–9%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

The weather may have moderated slightly but the fuels remain dry and receptive. The potential for large fire spread and very active fire behavior remains. Be aware of subtle changes that can increase fire behavior. SW winds continue to be a significant driver of fire spread and intensity. Be mindful of the potential for strong downslope winds, fire whirls and ember cast out of Division November.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Branch I

Division A: Minimal fire behavior, interior smoldering.

Division C/E/G: Fuel and terrain driven fire in Division C. Potential for flare-ups from the firing operation in the Dixie Mountain Range area due to strong SW winds. Alignment potential from rollout. Be mindful of intersecting drainages. Heavy concentration of fuels.

Division I: Frenchman Blvd. is a wind prone area. Low intensity fire activity can become very active quickly. Topographical features will affect wind speeds and direction.

Branch IV

Division N: Interior smoldering islands will be susceptible to torching and spotting. Watch for alignment in the Meadow View area.

Division R/T: Smoldering heavy fuels and islands under windy conditions can spread embers into receptive fuel beds.

Branch VII

Division V: Minimal activity. Interior smoldering and creeping.

Division X/Z: Minimal activity, interior smoldering and creeping.

Night Divisions

Mild temperatures and low RH in the beginning of the shift. Moderate RH recovery on ridge tops and up to 50% in the valleys. Be mindful of wind shifts and speeds due to topographical features. The shift will start with a Pig of 70-80% diminishing after sunset. Expect fire activity to diminish after 0300. Potential for large fire growth and intensity continues to exist at night.

- Do you have the buddy system set in place on the fireline.
- Inform Division or your Supervisor of changing locations.
- Do you know how to use your radio and is it cloned?
- Check **IN** with the Division Supervisor on site if not assigned there
- Check **OUT** with your supervisor (Or Division) at the end of shift.

Watch Out Situation #4

Unfamiliar with weather and local factors influencing fire behavior

- Recognize and communicate any change in fire behavior
- Monitor weather conditions throughout the shift and broadcast them to all resources on the division

Look Up, Look Down, Look Around

- Look Up: Check the sky for any weather changes such as building or approaching thunderstorms, wind shifts or increases in speed. Watch for air operations and water drops. Look for snags.
- Look Down: Watch your footing. Keep an eye out for snakes, bees nests and observe fine fuels on the ground.
- Look Around Check fuel loading in the area, general terrain, current fire behavior and ladder fuels. Keep an eye on fellow firefighters for signs of heat stress and smoke inhalation.

Safety is No Accident!

- Situational Awareness: gathering information about your surroundings.
- Hazard Assessment: identify the tactical hazard.
- Hazard Control: develop mitigations to reduce or eliminate risk.
- Decision Point: are mitigations in place and timely?
- Evaluate: What is changing? Are strategy and tactics working? Is fatigue becoming a bigger factor?




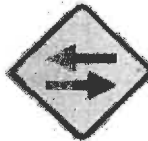

Whatever it is, clear the communication lines in a respectful manner and make it a smooth safe flowing two way street!

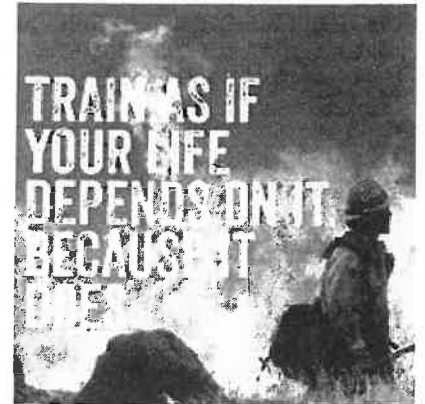

Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist

- Current Forest Service policy is that fully vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a mask or physically distance in federal buildings or on Federal lands, except where called for by Federal, State, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations.

- Any person that has COVID like symptoms listed below are required to contact their supervisor, supervisor should immediately separate the individual from others and contact the Medical Unit and/or COVID advisors.

Self-Awareness / Screening

- Notify supervisor if you or others experience:
 - o Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - o New loss of taste or smell
 - o Fever
 - o Chills
 - o Sore throat
 - o Muscle pain
- Review and follow crew and division plans to isolate, triage, and transport symptomatic personnel.

SUPERVISOR:

Notify Medical Unit as soon as possible of any individual that show symptom and to arrange for a testing.

Send the employee needs to the Frontline Medical Unit for evaluation and testing.

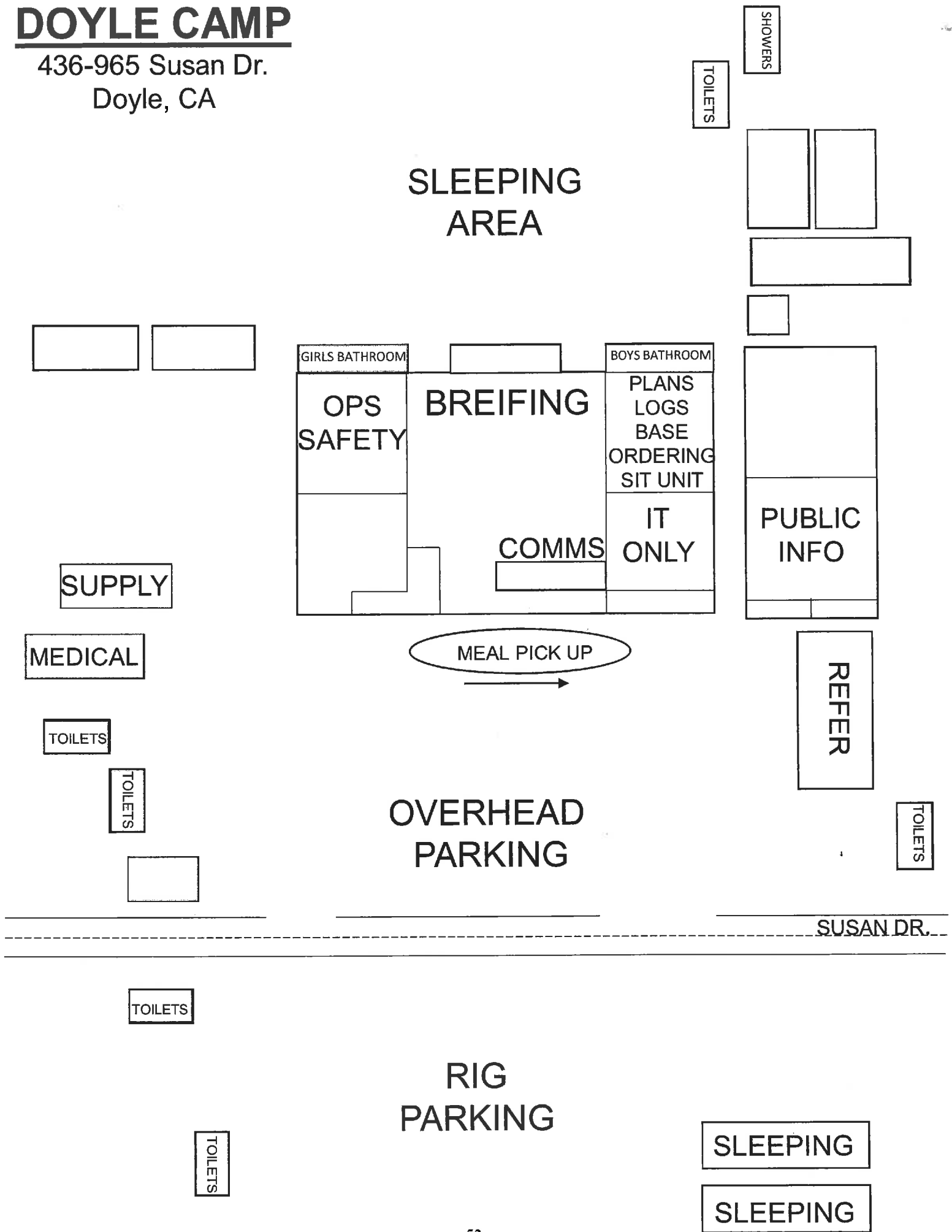
