<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> Slightly warmer today but otherwise little change in relative humidity and wind. The typical afternoon breezy to gusty pattern continues with generally light winds through the morning then picking up after the inversion lifts by late morning. While the prevailing flow will remain west southwest, the influences of complex terrain channeling and fire induced in-drafts can create more variable wind directions and speed. The fire is capable of creating its own weather at times and that threat continues with additional fire whirls with strong erratic winds possible. Downsloping flow along the escarpment could bring a period of increased westerly gusts in Branch IV from the late afternoon into the evening. Low temperatures will nudge up from last night but still becoming cool by morning in most areas while thermal belts remain warm and dry.

WEATHER: Sunny and dry. Areas of smoke.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 87-97° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 83-89°

HUMIDITY: 7-17% HAINES INDEX: 5 (Moderate potential for large fire growth)

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 6-12 mph increasing to 10-18 mph by afternoon. Gusts to around 28 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the morning, becoming west southwest 8-16 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the afternoon. Local effects can alter wind flow.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate stability in the morning, inversion around 5800', lifting late morning.

WEATHER FORECAST for SATURDAY NIGHT:

WEATHER: Areas of smoke, otherwise clear and cool.

TEMPERATURES: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 40-60° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 57-67°

(Warmest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

HUMIDITY: Valleys/Lower Slopes: 40-55% Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 25-40%

(Lowest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 10-18 mph with gusts to around 28 mph in the early evening, gradually

decreasing after sunset to southwest 6-12 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - West southwest 8-16 mph with gusts around 28 mph in the early evening

diminishing after sunset and transitioning to downslope/downvalley 1-6 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Becoming more stable overnight with inversion developing after midnight.

OUTLOOK for Sunday through Tuesday: Slightly warmer Sunday but clouds will begin moving in during the day as monsoon moisture moves up from the south. There is slight chance of thunderstorms late in the day or evening then the chances increase overnight into Monday. Storms may be dry initially then transition to wet. A lower chance of thunderstorms will remain on Tuesday. Winds will continue to be west southwest with gusty conditions in the afternoon and evening, but complex terrain and fire behavior can result in highly variable wind speeds and direction. Also, any thunderstorm can produce strong and erratic outflow winds.

WEATHER SUMMARY

WEATHER: Sunny and hot. Areas of smoke. **MAX TEMP:** Mid Slope: **83-89°** Valleys: **87-97°**

Humidity 7-17%

20 FOOT WINDS: Valleys/Slope: upslope 4-8 mph becoming WSW 8-16 mph G28 mph in the afternoon.

Ridge Top: SW 6-12 mph increasing 10-18 mph by afternoon Gusts to near 28 mph.

LAL: 1 HAINES INDEX 5 CHANCE OF WETTING RAIN: 0%

FUELS: The major fuel types, found in and around the fire area are timber understory and brush. **Ignition Receptiveness: ERC** levels are just below the 97th percentile. **Probability of Ignition** 100% **Dryness:** Dead and down fuel moistures:1 hour – 2% **10 hour–4%**, 100 hour–6%, and 1000 hour–9%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

The fire environment remains primed for large fire growth. Even with cooler temps, fuels will not recover. Smoldering interior islands are a potential source of ember cast. Be mindful of rollout in steep terrain (Branch I). Areas with minimal fire activity can increase suddenly with the introduction of strong winds. Watch for reburn potential.

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

Branch I

Division A: Minimal fire behavior, interior smoldering.

Division C/E/G: Active fire behavior, flanking fire with potential for uphill movement, in the Ramelli Creek area.

Division I: Minimal activity interior smoldering. SW winds can become compressed and change direction through Frenchman Blvd. Spotting potential.

Branch IV

Division N: Interior smoldering. Meadow view is a wind prone area. Be mindful of increased wind speed. Spotting potential.

Division R/T: Smoldering heavy fuels and islands under windy conditions can spread embers into receptive fuel beds.

Branch VII

Division V: Minimal activity, interior smoldering. **Division X/Z:** Minimal activity, interior smoldering.

Night Divisions

Cooler temperatures and low RH in the beginning of the shift. Moderate RH recovery on ridge tops and up to 55% in the valleys. Be mindful of wind shifts and speeds due to topographical features. The shift will start with a Pig of 70-80% diminishing after sunset. Expect fire activity to diminish after 0300. Potential for large fire growth and intensity continues to exist at night.

Foot Travel in Steep Terrain

- When walking through steep and rocky terrain, watch footing and maintain proper spacing.
- · Identify safe routes and local conditions.
- Test and use secure footing.
- Watch for over-head hazards, carry tools on downhill side, and wear gloves.

Treat "hot spots" on feet before they become blisters.

General Safety Concerns

- **Driving-** Pedictable is preventable. Speeding=Accident. Slow down and keep an eye out for wildlife and civilians.
- **Wildlife-** Bees are becomming an issue. Avoid when possible and know the Medical Plan (ICS 206) in the event of an incident. Know your people, are any of them alergic?
- Stump Holes- Lots of stump holes are out there. Use your tools to probe in front as you walk.
- **Dehydration** It can take it's toll. So drink lots of **WATER**. Strive to drink 2 quarts per hour during heavy exertion.

ALL	TRAFFIC HAZARDS AND DRIVING	 Travelers on Highway 395 often exceed the posted speed limit. Take extra precaution when entering or exiting the Highway. During high fire activity, expect drivers to pull over or drive through the area slower. Practice "Defensive Driving" techniques. Maintain high visibility when in the operational area, use warning lights when working on roads or traveling in smoke. Best practice is to follow California DOT standard with high vis vest where appropriate Many roads are narrow and mid-slope, with soft shoulders. Allow heavy vehicles to pass on uphill side. Use spotters when backing or turning around 5mph speed limit in and around ICP, keep your speed down in all areas. Drive at or below posted speed limits Use warning lights when working on roads or traveling in smoke. Use chock blocks, turn wheels into hill. Be alert for wildlife. Dusk to Dawn pose the greatest potential for accidents.

ALL	AIR OPERATIONS	 Follow "Aviation Watch-Out Situations" on page 46, IRPG. Do not plan on air resources for tactical support or medical transportation. Refer to page 58, IRPG for directing bucket drops. Ensure positive communication with all air resources.
ALL	FIRE BEHAVIOR	 Are you seeing what we have predicted? Conduct thorough assessments before starting work. Ensure LCES is in place. Plan & communicate your exit strategy with your crew and adjacent resources.
ALL	NIGHT OPERATIONS	 Provide additional briefing for new resources and maintain communications. Have a purpose for where you drive and what you do. Don't rush into assignments. Use caution where you park or stage, especially in steep timbered areas. Use available time for briefings on roads, terrain, and potential rolling material, especially if the resources are new to the area. Increase SA by trying to see the work area during daylight hours. Use glow sticks to mark hazards, and ensure personnel have headlamps.
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	Share your Situational Awareness (hazards, changes, etc.) to those who also have a need. Answer questions when asked by others. Ask for intel when you do not know the plan. Ensure all personnel are familiar with the incident and IA communications plans.
ALL	HEAT RELATED ILLNESS	 Drink 2 to 1 water to sports drinks. Take frequent breaks, minimum of 10 minutes every hour. Recognize symptoms of HEAT RELATED ILLNESS which include low energy, cramping, headaches, dizziness, poor rest, poor eating habits, hot skin, and lack of sweating.




