### *...Red Flag Warning for Lightning & Outflow Winds from Midnight Tonight to 8 PM Monday...*

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Monsoon moisture will begin moving in from the south today with increasing clouds in the afternoon and evening. Dry weather will prevail through the day then there is a small chance for thunderstorms near the fire complex late tonight with a better chance developing through the day on Monday. Any storm could produce frequent lightning as well as strong and erratic outflow winds. Storms may be a mix of dry and wet with a small chance of rainfall across the complex. Temperatures will nudge a bit higher today unless cloud cover is thicker than expected. Relative humidity will remain low this afternoon then increase through Monday. The same general wind pattern will continue with breezy to gusty conditions in the afternoon and evening then lighter terrain winds overnight. However, outflow winds and the complex terrain can create very erratic wind speeds and direction. Low temperatures will be a little warmer tonight.

### **WEATHER FORECAST for SUNDAY:**

**WEATHER:** Partly cloudy and dry. Areas of smoke.

**TEMPERATURES:** Valleys/Lower Slopes: 88-98° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 84-91°

**HUMIDITY:** 9-19%      **HAINES INDEX:** 4

#### **20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** - Southwest 6-12 mph increasing to 10-15 mph by afternoon. Gusts to around 25 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - Upslope/upvalley 4-8 mph in the morning, becoming west southwest 7-14 mph with gusts around 25 mph in the afternoon.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Moderate stability in the morning, inversion around 5800', lifting late morning.

### **WEATHER FORECAST for SUNDAY NIGHT:**

**WEATHER:** Red Flag Warning for lightning and outflow winds beginning at Midnight...  
Mostly cloudy. Slight chance of thunderstorms after midnight. **LAL: 2**

**TEMPERATURES:** Valleys/Lower Slopes: 45-65° Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 60-70°  
(Warmest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

**HUMIDITY:** Valleys/Lower Slopes: 45-55% Mid-Slopes/Ridges: 30-45%  
(Lowest along mid-slopes in thermal belt)

#### **20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** - Southwest 10-15 mph with gusts to around 25 mph in the early evening, gradually decreasing after sunset to southwest 5-10 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - West southwest 7-14 mph with gusts to 25 mph in the evening becoming downslope/downvalley 1-6 mph. Strong, erratic outflow winds possible.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Becoming more stable overnight with inversion developing after midnight.

**OUTLOOK for Monday through Wednesday:** A chance of thunderstorms on Monday. Any storm would bring the threat of strong and erratic outflow winds as well as frequent lightning. Some storms may be wet with a low chance of rain across the complex. Thunderstorm chances decrease Tuesday and Wednesday.

### INPUTS

**WEATHER SUMMARY:** ...Red Flag Warning for Lightning & Outflow Winds...

Temperature: 84-98 daytime, 45-65 overnight with 60-70 in the Thermal Belts RH: 9-19% daytime, 30-55% overnight  
Ridge-top Winds: SW 6-12 increasing to 10-15 gusts to 25 mph by afternoon  
Valley/Slope Winds: Terrain Driven 4-8 mph, SW 7-14 by afternoon. Overnight WNW 7-14 mph decreasing to 1-6 mph in the night with possible thunderstorm outflow winds.

Outflow winds can be erratic and very strong. With mop-up incomplete, these winds pose the greatest threat to the line; watch for developing cumulus clouds as an early indicator of escape potential. Outflow winds at night can cause undetected spotting, as thermal belts will remain receptive.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL:

1000 hr fuel moisture is 7%. This is driving significant ERCs with frequent historic records. Live fuels are critical for most species and are available to burn. The fire has the potential to burn up to 3-4 miles in the direction of spread when aligned with wind. If it becomes plume dominated it will then spread through aggressive flanking from pyrocumulus outflow winds. Forecasted thunderstorms carry the same risks as outflow winds from pyrocumulus. Thunderstorms are expected to impact the fire area after midnight.

Probability of ignition will run about 80-100% depending on aspect and shading. As the weather develops and cloud cover forms, PIG will drop to 50% on shaded aspects late in the day.

##### SPECIFIC:

**Divisions I:** This division will experience potentially the most adverse winds. Where the line makes a dog-leg to the east just above Ramelli Creek will be a focal point of the SW wind pressure and spot potential. Incomplete burning, burned-through retardant, and on-going mop-up operations continue to have vulnerabilities at this location. Any outflow winds from thunderstorms will further challenge containment. Escape in this area will result in high flame lengths and substantial rates of spread with spotting up to ½ mile.

**All other Divisions:** These divisions will experience mostly favorable winds. Complete burns in most division have reduced threats to the line. Securing and moping up the rest of the perimeter has eliminated significant threats to the remainder of the fire area.

##### AIR OPERATIONS:

Air operations will have clear skies and no operational limits on timing of missions. Turbulence may affect operations late in the shift as weather develops with cumulus buildup.

### SAFETY

Watch for fire-weakened trees and the effect of gusty winds. Outflow winds may threaten lines and challenge containment. Plan and for watch for stump holes and other hazards during mop-up operations. Initiate lightning safety protocols if hazards develop.

- Take the time to understand the plan. Ensure all resources completely understand the assignment, the Communications Plan, and the Medical Plan.
- Supervisory positions have changed. Know who you are working for.
- Briefings: Required every shift, for all personnel, for new assignments, and for changing conditions.

### Make a Safety Difference

- As a supervisor, provide constant and relentless oversight.
- ***Stay focused on the task at hand, all the time!***
- Come up with a safer way to perform a risky assignment.
- Discuss situations that might cause a near miss.
- Never tolerate “Hey, watch this!”
- Discuss the effects of fatigue and how to mitigate the effects of fatigue.
- While in the fire zone, wear your hardhat when you leave the vehicle.
- Have a purpose in what you do.

FOR A **NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT**: WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A **MEDICAL EMERGENCY**: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE **"MEDICAL EMERGENCY"** TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

**1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH** (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

**2. INCIDENT STATUS:** Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.  
 Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree.  
 Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.)  
 "This will be the Trout Meadow Medical Incident, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
