



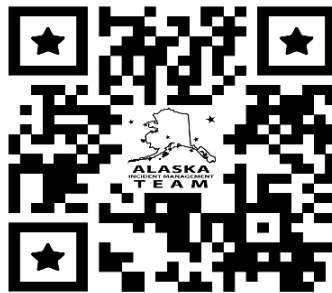




Smoke cover persist throughout burn period due to weak variable winds which will be primarily terrain driven.

TEMP: Max 78-90, Min 50-60 **RH:** Min 15-28%, Max 40-60% **Wind:** Upslope/Upvalley 7-10 G15

Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory in effect for Northern California Geographic Area

- Smoke cap remains over the burn area, severely limiting ventilation over fire.
- Terrain driven winds will develop later in the afternoon, especially in deeper sheltered drainages.
- Slight warming and drying from previous burn period.
- Moderate stability over fire area limiting upslope/updrainage convective air movement.
- At all elevations, fuels are **critically dry** in all size classes, both live and dead.
- Fuels driven spread is possible when terrain is favorable even during times of limited ventilation.
- Fine Fuels: 6%-exposed and 9%-shaded; 1000-hr 8%; ERC-G 73 (89th percentile)

OUTPUTS - FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Poor ventilation will dominate the fire area over next 24-48 hours. Fire growth and spread will be limited by fuel availability and slope, supporting low flame lengths and rates of spread under expected conditions. Single tree and group torching will be limited to periods of peak wind and low RH mainly in late afternoon. Peak flame lengths and rates of spread will likely be seen towards the late afternoon in drainages that clear and develop relatively strong upslope winds.

Fire behavior predictions are for surface fire during the hottest and driest period of the day.

SPECIFIC:

ALL BRANCHES – Fire behavior is expected to exhibit lower predicted rates of spread and flame lengths with minimal opportunity for torching. Critically dry fuels will support fire spread even under smoke capped conditions. If clearing occurs especially in lower elevation DIV, peak fire behavior can occur in late afternoon.

BRANCH 1 and 40 – Diurnal winds can set up under W/SW winds conditions and have sufficient ventilation to reach peak fire behavior even if smoke generally remains in the area.

Night Operations – Good overnight recovery should continue, and thermal belts will again set up in all branches and divisions but should be short lived as humidity increase overnight. Fire behavior should stay low after sunset.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0634 Sunset 2001. Smoke is likely to persist over the entire fire area except of possible clearing in DIV E in late afternoon.

SAFETY: Fuels are still critically dry, near the lowest 3rd percentile for 1000 and 100 hour dead fuels. Fire will readily burn once peak conditions are reached regardless of smoke conditions and ventilation.

SAFETY NOTIFICATION

Nomex IS NOT flame-proof. It burns when you hold a flame to it, but stops burning once the heat source is removed. The thick woven structure of synthetic fibers is a very poor conductor of heat. When exposed to heat, the fibers expand closing the spaces between them insulating the wearer. But to work correctly, Nomex needs care.

Dirty Nomex

- Wash Nomex like normal laundry, but always include a rinse cycle that adequately removes soaps and detergents.
- Nomex garments should never be subjected to strong oxidizing agents such as peroxides or bleaches. These harm the physical strength of the fabric.
- Tumble-dry and remove while slightly damp. Over-drying damages the fabric.

Poison Oak/Ivy/Sumac on Nomex - MTDC researched the laundering of Nomex firefighting clothing that has been contaminated with urushiol oil (what causes the rash) from poison oak/ivy/sumac exposure.

- MTDC recommends that fire clothing contaminated with urushiol oil be cleaned following normal Nomex laundering procedures, with a degreaser such as a detergent or laundry soap, and as soon as possible.
- Extra care should be exercised when handling the contaminated clothing and should be kept separate from unaffected clothing and equipment.
- Put the affected clothing in a marked bag if you are giving it to someone else to wash. Before handling the affected clothing, apply a skin-barrier product such as Ivy Block or Technu.

Fuel Soaked Nomex - Flammable contaminants will reduce the thermal performance of any flame-resistant garment including Nomex.

- **Proper and periodic cleaning is essential to maintain thermal protective performance.**

Action Item - Nomex is not effective if it is excessively dirty, fuel-soaked, or has holes. Does your Nomex need to be washed, repaired, or replaced?

Safety Message Monument North Fire August 24-25, 2021

Driving is one of the most hazardous things we do. Vehicle accidents are the source of more deaths and serious injuries to wildland firefighters than any other single cause.

A few simple things can buy you a whole bunch of safety and help ensure that you and others will have a good day!

- Do a walk around your vehicle to check for possible issues like... people standing or walking too close, vehicles or other obstacles too close or in your path of movement.
 - Clean your windshield, headlights, and mirrors. The late afternoon sun will angle down and cause issues for your visibility through the dirty glass, the dirt is difficult to see through during low light and smokey conditions.
 - Turn your headlights on, even during daylight hours to increase visibility of your vehicle.
 - Check the inside of your vehicle for possible distractions that will occur and distract your focus from driving, like lose items on your dash or seat, avoid eating while driving.
 - Fasten your seatbelt, most serious injuries or fatalities from vehicle accidents are from being ejected out of the vehicle.
 - Keep your eyes on the road and firm grip on the wheel.
 - Have someone else do the navigating and talking on the radio or mobile phone, pull off to a safe location if you are alone in the vehicle.

- ✓ Drive only when you are well rested and alert and avoid driving during the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Take a 10-to-15-minute break after every 2 hours.
 - ✓ Never drive when taking medications that make you drowsy.
 - ✓ By constantly moving your vision, checking mirrors and distant road conditions, you can avoid highway hypnosis and daydreaming.
 - ✓ Do not be in a hurry, be patient. It is ok to show up late and in good shape, think about the potential bad outcomes from speeding and passing in tight situations.

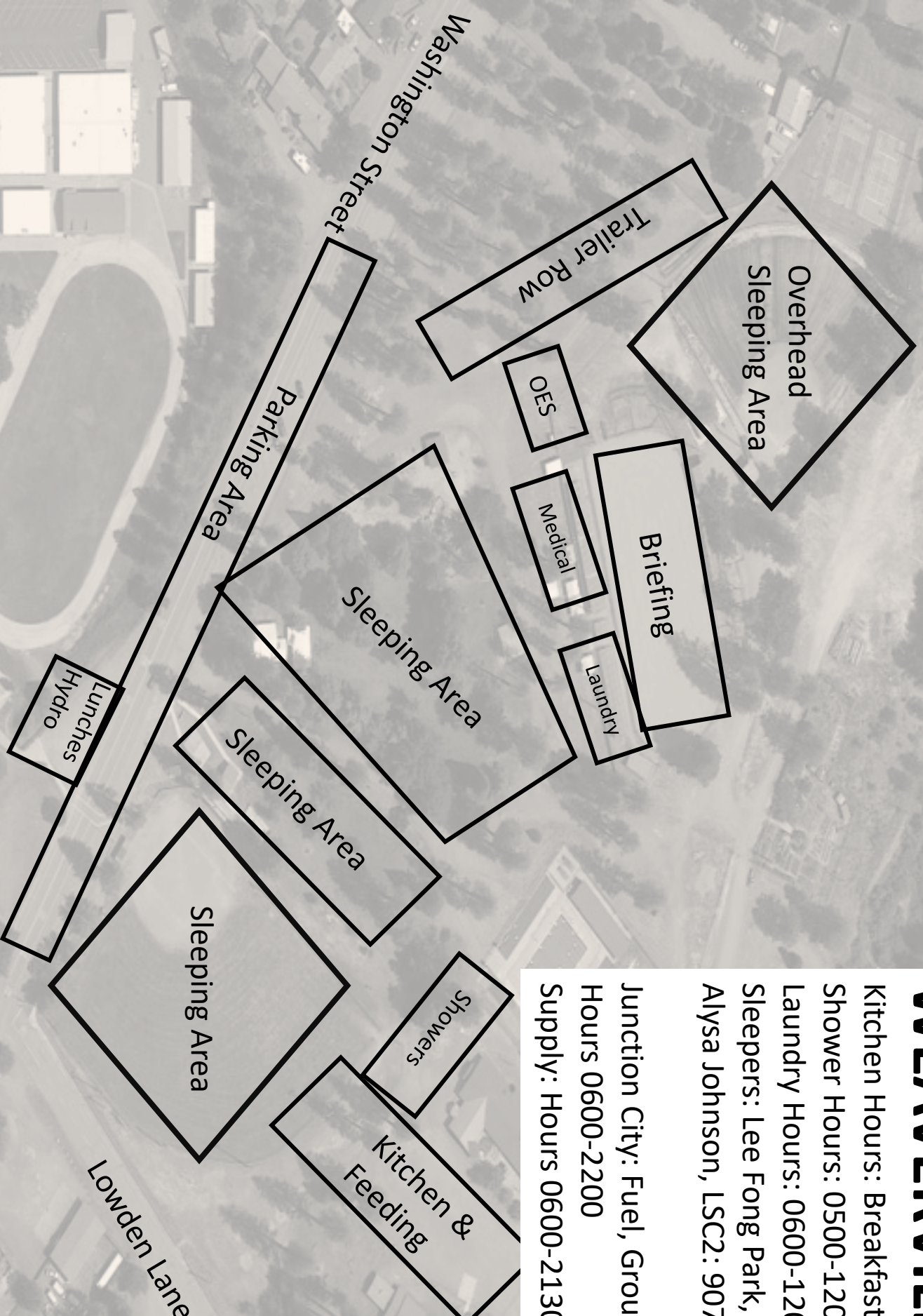

Green - Provide immediate patient care, Notify Division Medic or EMT on Tac. Medic or EMT will contact MEDL by phone at earliest convenience. Minimize, non-critical, operational radio traffic on Command and maintain situational awareness.

Yellow/Red- Contact Communications on Command with a Medical Incident Report

ICP/ In town travel- Dial 911 and notify MEDL at ICP as soon as possible for assistance.

Covid- 19 and Firefighter Health Tip of the day:

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT, WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM IMT COMMUNICATIONS/DISPATCH.

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (**Verify correct frequency prior to starting report**)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: *Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.*

Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) This will be the Trout Meadow Medical, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
