







<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide for firefighter and public safety by developing and implementing sound strategies and tactics that take into account values, risk, resource availability, and probability of success. • Protect businesses, homes, and property in and around the communities of Del Loma, Big Bar, Big Flat, Burnt Ranch, Cedar Flat, Helena, Junction City, Douglas City, Weaverville, Hayfork, and Hyampom, and elsewhere within the planning area. Where possible, take actions to reduce the amount of time that residents must remain evacuated from their homes. • Protect Highway 299 and Highway 3 corridor infrastructure, PG&E and TPUD electrical infrastructure, communications sites, and other public and private infrastructure within the planning area. • Protect values within the Trinity Alps Wilderness, the Trinity Wild and Scenic River corridor, and the Pattison Proposed Wilderness, including habitat for anadromous fish and other endangered and sensitive species. • Protect private and public timber values including a progeny-plantation site south of the fire. • Protect cultural and historic values near Hayden Flat Campground, Ironside Lookout, and elsewhere in the planning area. • Provide initial attack air support for new starts within the incident TFR. Coordinate response with the local unit. • Maintain and enhance relationships with agency partners, cooperators, stakeholders, and the public through timely and accurate information exchange. Ensure long-term strategies are communicated. • Coordinate with CAL FIRE Team 5 to provide a unified strategy and consistent public messaging for the North and South Zones. • Follow CDC, local, state, and federal COVID-19 mitigation guidance and protocols to reduce exposure and protect firefighters and the public from virus spread.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:	
The next several days are forecasted to be hotter, drier and include a change in wind direction. Ensure daily operation includes tactics based on current and forecasted fire behavior that have the highest probability of success.	
5. General Situational Awareness:	
Build your plan based on the weather and fire behavior information from your briefings and your IAP. Observe the fire carefully throughout your shift and pay attention to any signs of change. Adjust your plan as needed to remain on top of your safety game!

INPUTS

Drying and warming continue as winds pick up from the west/northwest and steadily increase throughout the day.

TEMP: Max 80-92, Min 50-60	RH: Min 16-26%, Max 40-60%	Wind: W/NW 10-15 Gust 25-30
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Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory in effect for Northern California Geographic Area

- Steady W/NW flow will continue and strengthen, bringing in clear, smoke free air over the fire throughout the day. Strong ridgeline gust likely after 1600.
- Smoke cap will likely be pushed off the majority of the fire by midafternoon.
- Wind stays steady through 2400 and eases to allow moderate overnight RH recovery to set in.
- At all elevations, fuels are **critically dry** in all size classes, both live and dead and trending drier.
- Fuels driven spread is possible when terrain is favorable even during times of limited ventilation.
- Fine Fuels: 6%-exposed and 8%-shaded; 1000-hr 7%; ERC-G 77 (92th percentile)

OUTPUTS - FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Relatively steady and at times breezy N/NW winds over the fire area will allow established fire to intensify in fire behavior starting by early-afternoon and continue until midnight. Fire will reach moderate fire behavior early in the burn period and intensify until sunset. Torching is likely throughout the burn period and spotting could occur in areas with green unburned fuels updrainage or to the east.

Fire behavior predictions are for surface fire during the hottest and driest period of the day.

SPECIFIC:

BRANCH 1 – Fire is expected to burn readily along all active flame fronts. Clear air should set in by late morning or early afternoon allowing for peak rates of spread in backing and flanking fire in **DIV E** as the fire burns back toward the Trinity River in the New River. Any established fire near Bell Flats will have high fire behavior after 1400.

BRANCH 10 – Established fire in the Manzanita Ridge and Big French Creek drainage will continue to strengthen and make active runs throughout the day, which could lead to head fire conditions and strong very active flanking fire. Torching and spotting will be problematic once peak predicted winds are reached and long-range spotting may occur.

BRANCH 40 – DIV W could see active backing and flanking with moderate to high fire behavior in the Knowles Gulch and Bear Creek area. Very active conditions exist in SOUTH ZONE DIV RR and rapid rates of spread and flame lengths are likely developing by 1300 and will exist through 2200-2400.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise 0637, Sunset 2002. Clearing in Branch1 and 40 by 1100-1200. Potential clearing in Branch 10 after 1500, later in deeper drainages.

SAFETY: Ridgeline fire activity likely will produce spot fires in any adjacent green unburned fuels. Expect very high flame lengths in vertical fuels even during backing conditions.

Proper Use of Trigger Points

Accurate situational awareness (SA) requires constant reassessment of conditions (existing or potential) that may impact the safety and effectiveness of tactics. Monitoring for the 18 Watchout Situations and establishing operational / environmental limits (“trigger points”) ahead of time can help to focus SA, prompt reassessment, and help you re-evaluate the risk of current actions. The following items are things to consider in your planning and discussion. Remember, trigger points are NOT decision makers, but serve as predetermined cues to prompt you to re-evaluate the current and potential situation and associated risks and help you to determine and implement the proper course of action.

- Preplan! Don’t wait until you’re in the wrong place at the wrong time---with no time. Trigger points
- should be based on measurable factors such as:
 - RH
 - Winds
 - Fire Behavior
 - Topographical boundaries
 - Time constraints/Time of day
 - Time/distance to safety zones
 - Loss of suppression resources
 - Other operational considerations (e.g., firefighter fatigue, loss of lookouts or communication, weather change)
- As you approach predetermined trigger points, go through the Risk Management Process to help you decide if a change in tactics is required. (See the Incident Response Pocket Guide)
 - Gather information to assure good Situational Awareness
 - Assess hazards to anticipate serious risks
 - Establish hazard controls to mitigate serious risks
 - Make decisions based on your ability to mitigate those serious risks
 - Evaluate effectiveness of current actions
- Command/Leadership responsibilities when changing tactics
 - Communicate the changes to your subordinates, as well as to adjacent forces and up the chain of command
 - Account for all your people
 - Make sure everyone knows and follows the new plan

WEATHER

- Your safety & mission objectives are impacted by the fire environment, and the most variable elements of the fire environment is **WEATHER**
- Daily Weather To Do: Review the fire weather forecast in your IAP - know that weather will vary across the fire given your elevation, aspect & time of day
- If IAP forecast conditions are not ball-park, take weather observations, share with the IMET & request a SPOT weather forecast
- Weather will dry and warm significantly Friday & Saturday as winds veer from NNW to NNE - your body & fire will respond to these changes!

--

FIRE BEHAVIOR

The combination of critically dry fuels and recent mid-day ventilation and clearing have increased baseline fuels conditions. Projected weather indicates that a hotter and drier pattern will set up for several days and strong local winds may develop. Fire behavior will increase substantially under these conditions, and it is important to remain aware of current and expected conditions and base actions on that situational awareness.

FIRE ORDER:

3. Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire.

WATCH OUT SITUATION:

14. Weather becoming hotter and drier.
15. Wind increases and/or changes direction.

Heat Related Illness and Hydration

- You need at least 1 liter of fluid per hour during hard work. This amounts to TWO gallons a day! Do this by drinking a small amount of fluid every 15 to 20 minutes.
- Of the fluids you drink, a 2 to 1 ratio of water to sports drink is recommended to keep your electrolytes up.
- It is recommended that you start drinking water the moment you wake up. It is also recommended that you keep a water bottle by your sleeping bag, and resolve to drink it the second you wake up in the morning. This will help prevent you from becoming dehydrated during your shift.
- After work, keep on drinking! Drink more than you think you need because it's essential to replace lost fluids.
- It doesn't matter if you choose to use a water bottle or a sipping hydration system such as a CamelBak (or a combo of both). Studies showed no differences in hydration status, so use whatever suits your fancy.

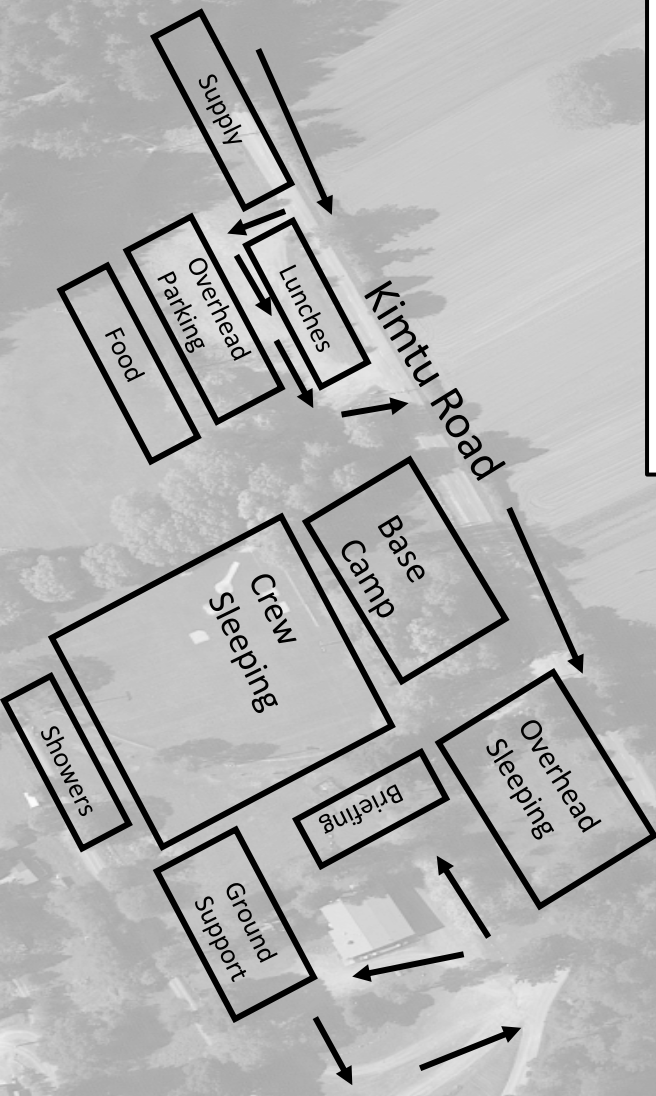
