DISCUSSION. Persistent east winds will allow drier air to dominate today. Minimum RH values will likely hit sooner than the previous day, trending around one to three percent lower. This dry easterly push may delay the typical diurnal wind pattern by a couple hours, but upcanyon winds are still expected. Otherwise, expect smoke to moderate weather conditions once again. However, any clearing will likely lead to rapid changes in temperature and humidity and the consequent impacts to fire behavior.

We can issue the form directly to the hospital or clinic, but we need full names and SSN for the required forms prior to being able to do that. The employee or supervisor should contact me as soon as possible or upon arrival at the hospital, whichever is convenient.

For claims there are different forms needed based on the circumstances of the property loss or damage. Please contact me first to find out which forms are appropriate for your situation, and what additional information might be needed. This will expedite the process. Unserviceable items must be turned into COMP if you are unable to replace at Supply. If items are lost or damaged on the fire line, the fire suppression module must provide a copy of the module's standard inventory with the documentation of broken or unserviceable items.





"RED IWI" MEDICAL-EMERGENCY PLAN:

- Contact Communications on Command and declare you have a RED IWI
- Following the 8-Line on the back of the IAP or page 118 of the 2018 IRPG
- Tell them Who you are, Where you are, What you have, and What you need.
- Update Communications once the patient has been transported.
- Close the loop with MEDL at the end of shift.

"Yellow or Green" NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL PLAN:

- Contact Division / Communications and declare you have a "Non-Emergency Medical."
- Complete the 8-line if needed and turn it in to the medical unit at the end of the shift

- Redding ICP- Dial 911
- Weaverville FOB -Frontline Medical
- Willow Creek FOB- Frontline Medical

Notify MEDL and SOF for "Red or Yellow" in camp IWI

Medical Incident Report

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT: WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure. Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree. Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.) "This will be the Trout Meadow Medical Incident, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."

☐RED / PRIORITY 1 Life or limb threatening injury or illness. Evacuation need is IMMEDIATE Severity of Emergency Ex: Unconscious, difficulty breathing, bleeding severely, 2° - 3° burns more than 4 palm sizes, heat stroke, disoriented. AND □YELLOW / PRIORITY 2 Serious Injury or illness. Evacuation may be DELAYED if necessary.
