

DISCUSSION. Persistent east winds will allow drier air to dominate today. Minimum RH values will likely hit sooner than the previous day, trending around one to three percent lower. This dry easterly push may delay the typical diurnal wind pattern by a couple hours, but upcanyon winds are still expected. Otherwise, expect smoke to moderate weather conditions once again. However, any clearing will likely lead to rapid changes in temperature and humidity and the consequent impacts to fire behavior.

FRIDAY: Sloshing smoke, dense at times. Areas of partial clearing.
CWR: 0% **LAL:** 1 **Stability:** Unstable afternoon

MAX TEMPERATURES: 81-91°F Ridges: mid 70s
MIN HUMIDITY: 12-24%
MIXING HEIGHT: 500 ft AGL increasing to 9,500 ft AGL in the afternoon

WEATHER SUMMARY: *** *Sloshing Smoke.... Warm and Dry....Again****

Persistent east winds will allow drier air to dominate early today. Minimum RH values will hit sooner, trending lower. This dry push will delay the typical upcanyon wind pattern by a couple hours. Expect smoke to moderate temperature and wind conditions again today.

Day

Max.Temperatures- 81°-91° Min. Humidity-12 to 24% Winds- ESE, then WNW to 10 mph, **Gusts 15-20 mph!**

Night

Min.Temperatures- 50°-60° Max. Humidity-30 to 80% Winds-Downslope 5 mph, ENE to 10 mph by sunrise

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

- Increased sun exposure predictably flips the switch on this fire... **Got "blue" skies?**
- Smoke and haze can hide spot fires until well established.... **Lookouts will be Tested!**
- Heavy fuels burning above, below or around you in steep terrain? **Make a plan for rollout!!**
- Accurately determine the "sweet spot" in your burn windows. **Monitor your weather trends!!**
- Winds will battle for dominance during the downcanyon transition, plan for multiple directions!!
- Expect drift smoke from regional fires to reduce your visibility....**AND** Situational Awareness!
- Wind has an exponential effect on fire behavior... **Twice the speed.... can have 4X the impact...**

SPECIFIC:

- **All Divisions: All Sizes of Fuels are very DRY, very AVAILABLE, very RECEPTIVE...**

Flame Lengths- 2-6 ft. in Grass, Up to 30 ft. in Brush/Understory...Diminishing after midnight

Rate of Spread- 20 chains/hour in Grass, Up to 80 chains/hour in Brush...Slowing overnight

Spotting Distances- Up to .25 miles from Grass/Brush, Up to 1 mile in Timber (From Torching)

Probability of Ignition- Up to 80% at the peak of the burn period, Diminishing to <40% overnight

AIR OPERATIONS:

Sunrise: 06:38

Sunset: 19:40

Expect poor smoke dispersion before the inversion "breaks" by late morning. Look for poorer dispersion the further east you go. Mixing heights start out at less than 500 feet; rise to 9,500 feet with daytime heating; then return to less than 500 feet after sunset. Anticipate terrain induced turbulence in the Trinity River corridor, especially during peak hours of afternoon heating.

For claims there are different forms needed based on the circumstances of the property loss or damage. Please contact me first to find out which forms are appropriate for your situation, and what additional information might be needed. This will expedite the process. Unserviceable items must be turned into COMP if you are unable to replace at Supply. If items are lost or damaged on the fire line, the fire suppression module must provide a copy of the module's standard inventory with the documentation of broken or unserviceable items.

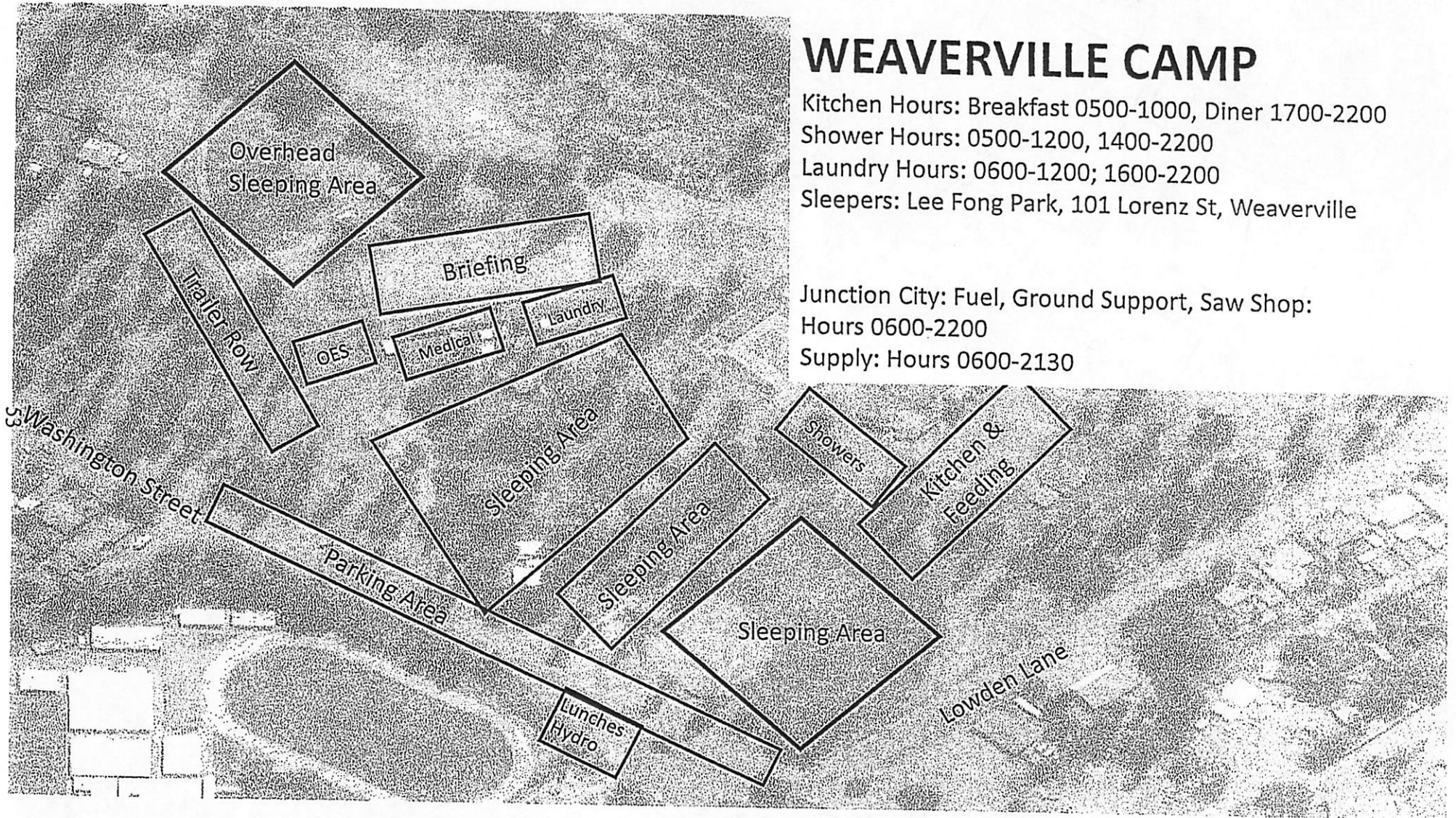

"RED IWI" MEDICAL-EMERGENCY PLAN:

- Contact Communications on Command and declare you have a **RED IWI**
- Following the 8-Line on the back of the IAP or page 118 of the 2018 IRPG
- Tell them **Who** you are, **Where** you are, **What** you have, and **What** you need.
- Update Communications once the patient has been transported.
- Close the loop with MEDL at the end of shift.

"Yellow or Green" NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL PLAN:

- Contact Division / Communications and declare you have a **"Non-Emergency Medical."**
- Complete the 8-line if needed and turn it in to the medical unit at the end of the shift

- Weaverville FOB -Frontline Medical
- Willow Creek FOB- Frontline Medical

Medical Incident Report

FOR A **NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT**: WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A **MEDICAL EMERGENCY**: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE "MEDICAL EMERGENCY" TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree.

Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.)

"This will be the Trout Meadow Medical Incident, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
