<u>DISCUSSION</u>. Persistent east winds will allow drier air to dominate today. Minimum RH values will likely hit sooner than the previous day, trending around one to three percent lower. This dry easterly push may delay the typical diurnal wind pattern by a couple hours, but upcanyon winds are still expected. Otherwise, expect smoke to moderate weather conditions once again. However, any clearing will likely lead to rapid changes in temperature and humidity and the consequent impacts to fire behavior.

**FRIDAY**: Sloshing smoke, dense at times. Areas of partial clearing.

CWR: 0% LAL: 1 Stability: Unstable afternoon

MAX TEMPERATURES: 81-91°F Ridges: mid 70s

MIN HUMIDITY: 12-24%

MIXING HEIGHT: 500 ft AGL increasing to 9,500 ft AGL in the afternoon

### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

### **GENERAL:**

- Increased sun exposure predictably flips the switch on this fire... Got "blue" skies?
- Smoke and haze can hide spot fires until well established.... Lookouts will be Tested!
- Heavy fuels burning above, below or around you in steep terrain? Make a plan for rollout!!
- Accurately determine the "sweet spot" in your burn windows. *Monitor your weather trends!!*
- Winds will battle for dominance during the downcanyon transition, plan for multiple directions!!
- Expect drift smoke from regional fires to reduce your visibility.... AND Situational Awareness!
- Wind has an exponential effect on fire behavior... Twice the speed.... can have 4X the impact...

### SPECIFIC:

• All Divisions: All Sizes of Fuels are very DRY, very AVAILABLE, very RECEPTIVE...

Flame Lengths- 2-6 ft. in Grass, Up to 30 ft. in Brush/Understory...Diminishing after midnight

Rate of Spread- 20 chains/hour in Grass, Up to 80 chains/hour in Brush...Slowing overnight

Spotting Distances- Up to .25 miles from Grass/Brush, Up to 1 mile in Timber (From Torching)

**Probability of Ignition-** Up to 80% at the peak of the burn period, Diminishing to <40% overnight

AIR OPERATIONS: Sunrise: 06:38 Sunset: 19:40

Expect poor smoke dispersion before the inversion "breaks" by late morning. Look for poorer dispersion the further east you go. Mixing heights start out at less than 500 feet; rise to 9,500 feet with daytime heating; then return to less than 500 feet after sunset. Anticipate terrain induced turbulence in the Trinity River corridor, especially during peak hours of afternoon heating.

We can issue the form directly to the hospital or clinic, but we need full names and SSN for the required forms prior to being able to do that. The employee or supervisor should contact me as soon as possible or upon arrival at the hospital, whichever is convenient.

For claims there are different forms needed based on the circumstances of the property loss or damage. Please contact me first to find out which forms are appropriate for your situation, and what additional information might be needed. This will expedite the process. Unserviceable items must be turned into COMP if you are unable to replace at Supply. If items are lost or damaged on the fire line, the fire suppression module must provide a copy of the module's standard inventory with the documentation of broken or unserviceable items.




