<u>DISCUSSION</u>. High pressure will begin to take hold over the region today, causing subsequent warming and drying conditions across the fire. ### Act Deliberately, Not Urgently

 When committing personnel to a fire, have a plan. Ensure that your plans are clearly communicated and that everyone clearly understands your intent and the hazards that are associated with your plan.

Do not be afraid to say no. Refer to page 19 in the I.R.P.G. for guidelines on properly refusing

risk. Do not act beyond the limits of your training or ability.

Ensure that escape routes and safety zones are clearly defined and made known to all fire
fighters. Post lookouts and ensure that you know what radio frequency you will be using for
tactics and command. Make sure LCES is in place prior to taking action.

• Review the "8-Line," Incident within and Incident plan in your IAP. Spend time during breakout briefings discussing possible scenarios involving an incident within an incident. Know who that

on-scene IC will be.

**Fire Fighter Fatigue:** Please continue to get enough rest. Take plenty of breaks and please continue to stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water. Ensure that all fire fighters meet the 2:1 work to rest ratio. Watch out for signs of fatigue in other fire fighters around you.

**Snags/Hazard Trees:** Maintain situational awareness and point out snags to others. Snags continue to fall in the burned area and near the fire line. Ensure that everyone is aware of the presence of snags and widow makers. Do not park vehicles under them. Use flagging tape to keep others out of the area.

#### Operational Leadership

- Take Charge of assigned resources.
- Anticipate changing conditions and potential emergencies.
- Motivate firefighters with a "can do safely" attitude.
- Demonstrate Initiative by taking action in the absence of orders.
- Communicate by giving specific instructions and asking for feedback!
- Supervise at the scene of the action.
- Follow-Up with feedback and suggestions for improvement.

## **Texting While Driving is Prohibited!**

- Texting while driving is against California State Law and is enforced by local and state law enforcement agencies.
- 25% of all auto accidents in 2020 were attributed to cellular phone use while driving. Taking your eyes off the road for 5 seconds while traveling 55 MPH, is equivalent to driving the length of 1 football field without looking at the road!

For federal employees associated with the Monument or Knob Fires, if you are injured, please contact the COMP UL for the Authorization for Treatment (CA-16). We can issue the form directly to the hospital or clinic, but we need full names and SSN for the required forms prior to being able to do that. The employee or supervisor should contact me as soon as possible or upon arrival at the hospital, whichever is convenient.

For claims there are different forms needed based on the circumstances of the property loss or damage. Please contact me first to find out which forms are appropriate for your situation, and what additional information might be needed. This will expedite the process. Unserviceable items must be turned into COMP if you are unable to replace at Supply. If items are lost or damaged on the fire line, the fire suppression module must provide a copy of the module's standard inventory with the documentation of broken or unserviceable items.





## "RED IWI" MEDICAL-EMERGENCY PLAN:

- Contact Communications on Command and declare you have a RED IWI
- Following the 8-Line on the back of the IAP or page 118 of the 2018 IRPG
- Tell them Who you are, Where you are, What you have, and What you need.
- Update Communications once the patient has been transported.
- Close the loop with MEDL at the end of shift.

#### "Yellow or Green" NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL PLAN:

- Contact Division / Communications and declare you have a "Non-Emergency Medical."
- Complete the 8-line if needed and turn it in to the medical unit at the end of the shift

#### **ICP/Camp Emergencies**

- Redding ICP- Dial 911
- Weaverville FOB -Frontline Medical
