FIRE BEHAVIOR:

**GENERAL:** 

\*Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory issued 07-17-2021\*

Topography is steep and rugged ranging from 2000' in the valleys and 6000' on higher peaks. Slope in many instances is 100%. This terrain promotes fire growth through roll out and slope reversal. Many of the drainages align with predominant wind patterns for the region. The Trinity River corridor is a major drainage that funnels wind primarily East and West. There are major bends in the river that will create eddy's and swirling winds.

Fuels in the fire area range from timber and timber understory in higher elevations, heavy brush in mid elevations and grass oak woodland in valley bottoms. Extreme Drought this year has stressed fuels to critical fuel moistures. 1000 hr fuels recorded July 15 were 7%, LFM in brush was 93%. The dryness of the fuels in the area are a major contributor to the Monument Fire's growth.

Fires in this area commonly have large growth periods of 1 to 2 days usually aided by windy conditions. Following the large growth periods there are usually several days of slowed growth due to heavy smoke inversions. This has been the scenario for the Monument Fire. August is generally hot and dry with long burn periods that extend well into the night.

### SPECIFIC:

#### Branch 20

Smoldering fire interior of the line. Monitor for roll out. North Northwest winds will increase winds along Dutch Creek rd today.

#### Branch 30

Winds will become more northerly today. Aligned drainages in NN such as Carr Creek, Alder Gulch, Garden Gulch and Little Barker creek will have an enhanced opportunity for battling winds at the ridges and possible downslope winds late in the afternoon. The SW portion of RR will get another dose of battling wind at the ridge top. Winds will be parallel with the West dozer line at times, monitor for spots. Group torching and short-range spotting observed yesterday. Post a look out to monitor fire activity in BR 40 DIV Z.

## **South Zone Contingency**

Be cautious operating equipment in critically dry fuels.

#### AIR OPERATION:

Smoke is expected to be over the fire area all day today.

#### SAFFTY

Moisture content in dead fuels is a key component to fire spread. 1 hr time-lag fuels are the easiest to estimate in the field. A good rule of thumb is to divide the observed relative humidity by 5. That value is the approximate fuel moisture of fine dead fuels. Annual grass does not carry fire well when it is above 11%. Using this rule of thumb, we can estimate that the fuel moisture of annual grass on a 25% rh day will be approximately 5% and will readily carry fire. Take observations often and apply them to your situational awareness.

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Warming temperatures will be moderated today by the return of areas of dense smoke. A northwesterly flow will remain over the fire, however winds will generally be terrain driven. These terrain driven winds may be locally enhanced in areas with partial clearing. Humidity values will fall into the mid-teens with higher values expected under dense smoke. 
# MONUMENT FIRE ANDERSON FAIRGROUNDS FACILITIES MAP CA-SHF-001187


