

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A return to more seasonal temperatures will begin today with humidity values falling into the mid-teens. Temperatures and low humidity values will be moderated somewhat in areas of dense smoke. Winds are expected to remain westerly/up canyon today with gusty winds expected late in the afternoon through 0300. Terrain driven winds may be locally enhanced in areas with partial clearing and during the higher winds expected in the afternoon. Humidity values will begin a slow recovery shortly after sunset in lower elevations and after midnight along ridgetops.

FIRE BEHAVIOR:

GENERAL:

Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory issued 07-17-2021

Topography is steep and rugged ranging from 2000' in the valleys and 6000' on higher peaks. Slope in many instances is 100%. This terrain promotes fire growth through roll out and slope reversal. Many of the drainages align with predominant wind patterns for the region. The Trinity River corridor is a major drainage that funnels wind primarily East and West. There are major bends in the river that will create eddy's and swirling winds.

Fuels in the fire area range from timber and timber understory in higher elevations, heavy brush in mid elevations and grass oak woodland in valley bottoms. Extreme Drought this year has stressed fuels to critical fuel moistures. 1000 hr fuels recorded July 15 were 7%, LFM in brush was 93%. The dryness of the fuels in the area are a major contributor to the Monument Fire's growth.

Fires in this area commonly have large growth periods of 1 to 2 days usually aided by windy conditions. Following the large growth periods there are usually several days of slowed growth due to heavy smoke inversions. This has been the scenario for the Monument Fire. August is generally hot and dry with long burn periods that extend well into the night.

SPECIFIC:

Branch 20

Smoldering fire interior of the line. Monitor for roll out.

Branch 30

DIV NN – Minimal fire behavior under smoke inversion. Monitor Little Barker Creek for fire in the bottom to move up through the drainage with normal upslope winds. Fuels are light within the drainage, but movement is still possible.

DIV RR – Fire in the Little Creek Drainage was active yesterday. It crossed the upper Little Creek in several places and made upslope runs toward the Sims Gap Ridge. Firing operations along the 16-road ridge were planned for last night. If this occurred monitor closely for backing fire to make it to the creek. If the firing operation is today, expect West winds after mid-morning and clearing in the afternoon. Fuels are receptive with PIG 60-80% depending on shading. Post lookouts to monitor the bottom of the drainage closely for any entrainment of upslope winds.

South Zone Contingency

Be cautious operating equipment in critically dry fuels.

AIR OPERATION:

Smoke is expected to be over the fire area all day today.

SAFETY

Opposing or battling winds can often develop along ridgetops that are out of alignment with the general wind direction. The slopes will experience normal daytime heating and slope winds and once at the top those slope winds meet the opposing winds at the ridge top. When this occurs, they will battle for a time but at some point one will overcome the other.

Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory

Northern California

July 17, 2021



Subject: Potential for extreme fire behavior due to critically low live and dead fuel moistures, very dry conditions resulting from persistent drought, minimal snowpack and spring precipitation, and elevated fire danger rating values across much of northern California.

Discussion: Fires burning in northern California are exhibiting extreme fire growth based on critical fuel conditions. Fire spread is fuel driven and does not depend on wind to spread. Surface fuels are very receptive to embers. Long range spotting, area ignition, and group torching is occurring on large fires frequently.

Difference from normal conditions: Northern California is in a drought; currently with 90% at Extreme to Exceptional levels. The drought is expected to persist or intensify throughout the fire season. Deficient rainfall and snowpack with early melt off has resulted in fuels that are 4-6 weeks ahead of normal drying/curing rates.

Concerns to Firefighters and the Public:

- Energy Release Component (ERC) at numerous weather stations set record maximums already this
 year and are running at or above the 97th percentile in most cases. Expect increased fire intensity and
 spread rates in these areas. Early season extreme fire behavior has been observed in both light and
 heavy fuels. Anticipate increased spread rates, spotting, and active nighttime burning.
- The combination of persistent drought and record-low rainfall and snowpack amounts has led to very low live and dead fuel moistures. Low 1000-hour fuel moistures have been evidenced by complete consumption of dead fuels on recent fires. Live fuel moistures in grasses, shrubs and trees, have already reached critical levels in many areas of Northern California due to limited green-up this spring. Expect fires to ignite easier and spread faster. Do not expect fires to exhibit reduced fire behavior when entering areas of live fuels; anticipate increased spread rates and spotting.
- Direct attack is often not feasible under regular diurnal wind conditions with ground resources. And aviation utilization is often insufficient in moderating rate of spread without immediate heavy ground resource response. Anticipate higher resistance to control in all fuel types.
- Already this year, Northern California has experienced large fire activity and multiple team deployments. California will likely experience an extended fire season. It is important to be mindful of and manage fatigue for all resources. Everyone, every day, returns home safely.

Mitigation Measures:

- Local and inbound fire personnel need to be aware that fire behavior across the state is exceeding
 normal expectations for this time of the year. Local briefings need to be thorough and highlight
 specific fire environment conditions. These include but are not limited to local weather
 forecasts, Pocket Cards, ERC's, live and dead fuel moistures.
- Suppression actions need to be based on good anchor points, escape routes, and safety zones.
 Remember LCES. Experienced lookouts are essential under these conditions.
- Base all actions on current and expected behavior of the fire. Augment initial attack resources as incident activity dictates.

Area of Concern: Northern California except for the following Predictive Service Areas: North Coast and Bay Marine, west of Highway 101 in Mid-Coast to Mendocino and Diablo-Santa Cruz, and the north eastern portion of Far Eastside.

Weather/Environmental Conditions

Watch Out

- · Wind Increases and changing of direction causing erratic fire behavior
- · Cap Lifting, bringing hotter weather to ground levels of all divisions
- With some reduced fire activity on divisions, wildlife is repopulating the area.

Mitigation

- · Post lookouts in areas of concern drainages, creek beds, open fire line
- · Proper hydration throughout the day will help eliminate heat related injuries
- Be aware of wild animals within your area, communicate to your crews and divisions any hazardous wildlife – Bears, Mountain Lions etc.

Driving and Transportation

Watch Out

- Road networks within the divisions may be single lane making passing difficult
 - Distracted and Impaired driving could result in a vehicle accident
 - Unsafe vehicle operation can lead to accidents

Mitigation

- Stay with established traffic plans, use traffic controllers if possible, mark hazards
- Pull over if fatigued, utilize relief drivers, drive responsibly and defensibly
- Slow down, maintain a safe distance, turn on lights, allow for extra travel time

Communications

Watch Out

- · Crews being uninformed on strategies, tactics and hazards
- · Surge forces not being on proper tactical channel leads to confusion and missed directions
- · Radio communications on some branches may not be ideal, causing for dropped transmissions

Mitigation

- Ensure all incoming crews (day and night) receive a tailgate briefing
- Be familiar with the incident radio plan, make appropriate changes to your radios with movement
- Utilize human repeaters and relays if necessary.








ANDERSON FAIRGROUNDS MONUMENT FIRE FACILITIES MAP CA-SHF-001187











MONUMENT FIRE ANDERSON FAIRGROUNDS FACILITIES MAP CA-SHF-001187
