



Alaska Team 1 Evacuation Process

Alaska Team 1 will communicate regularly with the county sheriff and cooperators regarding the fire status and potential for pre-evacuation/evacuations.

Pre-evacuation notices will be determined by the sheriff in coordination with line operations and liaison officer considering fire status and current and expected fire behavior.

1. The division/branch director will notify line operations when the fire is threatening and/or crossed an evacuation Management Action Point (MAP).
2. Line operations will verify the need for evacuations. Line operations will recommend evacuations for the threatened area/zone to the communications unit.
3. The communications unit will notify the liaison officer and IC.
4. The liaison officer will communicate the evacuation recommendation to the appropriate county sheriff.
5. The county sheriff will make the final determination on evacuations and implement those through the county's pre-identified process.
