Narrative:

Increased Winds-With front approaching fire area Thursday evening and Friday there is predicted to be an increase in wind speeds. Monitor wind conditions and mitigate associated hazards such as ceasing felling operations if affected. Be aware of fire weakened trees that can fall on their own with increased winds. Make sure all personnel are clear of those areas that have not had hazard trees mitigated.

Potential for Precipitation- Predicted chance of precipitation over fire area for Saturday and Sunday with snow levels possible at or above 4000 ft. elevation. There is additionally another cold front predicted for next Tuesday or Wednesday. Depending on amount of precipitation we receive could affect operations and driving conditions. Pre-plan for worst case scenarios with positioning equipment and personnel in locations that would be safe to egress from if roads become slippery and unsafe to drive on. Consider setting trigger points of when to disengage/reengage resources or modify operations if warranted. Monitor weather conditions. Have all decisions communicated on appropriate tactical channel to all resources affected. Coordinate actions with other affected resources or divisions.

Driving hazards –Drive defensively at all times. Watch out for vehicles and personnel working along the roads on the incident. Reduce driving speeds as warranted by weather and road conditions. Utilize road guards and pilot vehicles when appropriate. Communicate when driving on narrow roads to allow other drivers a heads up of your intention to drive from point to point. Clear roads when moving equipment on transports. When unassigned personnel enter division notify division supervisor of your presence and permission to proceed. Notify division when clear of area. Heads up for wildlife on Highway 96 when driving especially when it's dark.
