## OUTPUTS

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### GENERAL:

Slightly higher humidity will still support active fire behavior once the inversion breaks. Expect low to moderate fire behavior under the inversion. Once the inversion lifts fire behavior will increase to moderate - active. Nighttime recovery will keep fire behavior low. The fires are burning in areas with no recent fire history and significant dead and down, resulting in abundant surface fuels. The fires are situated near the confluence of the main stem Trinity River and the S. Fork of the Trinity River, which will influence wind channeling and subsequently fire behavior – watch for erratic and eddying winds near the confluence and large bends in the river canyons.

**Ignition Receptiveness:** Probability of Ignition 34% shaded 57% sunshine Night 9% Spotting ¼ - ½ mile

**Dryness:** Dead and down fuel moistures :1 hour – 6-9%, 10 hour– 11%, and 1000 hour– 12%.

#### SPECIFIC:

##### Branch I - Divisions G, N and R.

Interior fine fuels will continue to burn. In Division R, G and D control lines have sufficient depth to make interior activity unlikely to compromise control lines. In Div. N, fire will continue to move upslope towards Lone Pine Ridge. Spotting can be expected on top of the Lone Pine Ridge. The head will keep moving southeast into Groves Prairie.

##### Branch X – Divisions U, W

Fire in Div. W and U No perimeter growth is expected. Spotting outside of the line continues to be viable but to a lesser extent with the predicated probability of ignition.

**Night:** Early on in the shift expect to see active fire behavior especially in the interior and in Division N area. Watch for any spotting that may have occurred throughout the day but went unnoticed in the Horse Range drainage. Activity should moderate around 2400 hours.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

The inversion will limit air morning operations, during the afternoon hours air operations should not be limited.

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** A weak cold front and associated marine push will move over the fire area today. Temperatures will be slightly cooler than normal with increased humidity recoveries...especially in valleys and lower slopes. This trough will not be nearly as strong as the previous marine push that occurred earlier in the week. Breezier westerly winds will be slightly stronger than previous days along the highest ridges and peaks through the afternoon with localized gusts to 20 mph possible. Smoke will dissipate earlier - around 1200 - near the helibase.

**WEATHER FORECAST FOR SATURDAY:**

**WEATHER:** Dissipating smoke and haze in the morning.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 75-80 degrees upper slopes and ridges. **24 HR Trend:** down 2-5°.  
82-88 degrees lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend:** down 2-5°

**MINIMUM HUMIDITY:** 35-46% upper slopes and ridges **24 HR Trend** up 3-5%.  
30-35% lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend** up 3-5%.

**20-FOOT WIND:**

**INVERSIONS/STABILITY:** Weak to moderate morning inversion around 3000 feet eroding by 1200-1300 hours.

**SMOKE TRANSPORT WIND:** Northwest 7-10 mph.

**WEATHER:** Haze through sunset then smoke settling across the fire overnight and ICP toward morning.

**MINIMUM TEMPERATURES:** 55-62 thermal belts above 3500 ft. 53-60 lower slopes. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

**MAXIMUM HUMIDITY:** 75-85% mid and upper slopes. 80-90% lower slopes and along the river. **24 HR Trend:** 6-10% higher.

**20-FOOT WIND:**

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - West winds 7-10 mph along the ridges, weakening to 2-5 mph after 2200.

**RIDGETOP** - Northwest 5-10 mph with gusts up to 15 mph through 0200, easing to 3-6 mph late.

**INVERSIONS/STABILITY:** Smoke settling over the fire and ICP with a moderate nighttime inversion around 3000 ft.

---

**EXTENDED FORECAST SUNDAY-TUESDAY:** Lingering marine influence will keep temperatures seasonable, and humidity will be slightly higher than normal on Sunday. By Monday, the marine air will have dissipated and a more typical summer pattern will resume. Looking at a return of the easterly winds in the morning becoming westerly in the afternoon on both Monday and Tuesday. Temperatures will rise by a few degrees both Monday and again Tuesday, while humidity will slowly decline.

## SRF Lightning Complex Incident: Resource Advisor Message

### Fish Screens: Coho Salmon Critical Habitat

The Trinity River and tributaries are considered critical habitat for threatened Coho salmon, an anadromous fish (fish born in freshwater who spend most of their lives in saltwater and return to freshwater to spawn). Please ensure that any Mark 3 and Engine/Tender suction hoses have a fish screen attached when drafting. Fish screens are designed to minimize stress, injury or even death during the drawing and application process. Talk to a READ if you need a screen.



### Port Orford Cedar Root Disease: NO DRAFTING East Fork and Boise Creek CGs!!!

Some local drainages are infected with POC Root disease, which is a root rotting disease that spreads via water and mud. Infested waters within the fire perimeter include: the main stem of Willow Creek and small creeks to the north up to Hoopa, south side of Willow Creek (includes area in **Boise Creek Campground**) in East Fork of Willow Creek (includes area in **East Fork Campground**) and in most of the tributaries. **DO NOT DRAFT from East Fork Campground OR Boise Creek Campground.**

### **IMPORTANT:** Yellow/Black Striped flagging indicates resource **AVOIDANCE** areas.

- **Invasive Plant Species – PLEASE USE WEED WASH**



The area in and around the Lightning Complex, are home to many sensitive species. Infestations of highly invasive plant species, like yellow star thistle, are one of the largest threats to sensitive species populations here. Spread via vehicles and foot traffic as well as re-activation via fire is of high concern. To help protect these sensitive places, do not park in and try to avoid flagged areas. **Make sure to visit the WEED WASH at check-in to the incident and demob, located at ground support.**

### Cultural Resources:

There is a potential that undocumented cultural resources will be encountered while fighting fire. It is important when a potential cultural resource is encountered that they are not disturbed in any manner. GPS its location and take a photo, but do not remove or collect anything. Findings of cultural resources should not be reported over the radio. Work with your division to notify a resource advisor for recommendations on how to proceed.

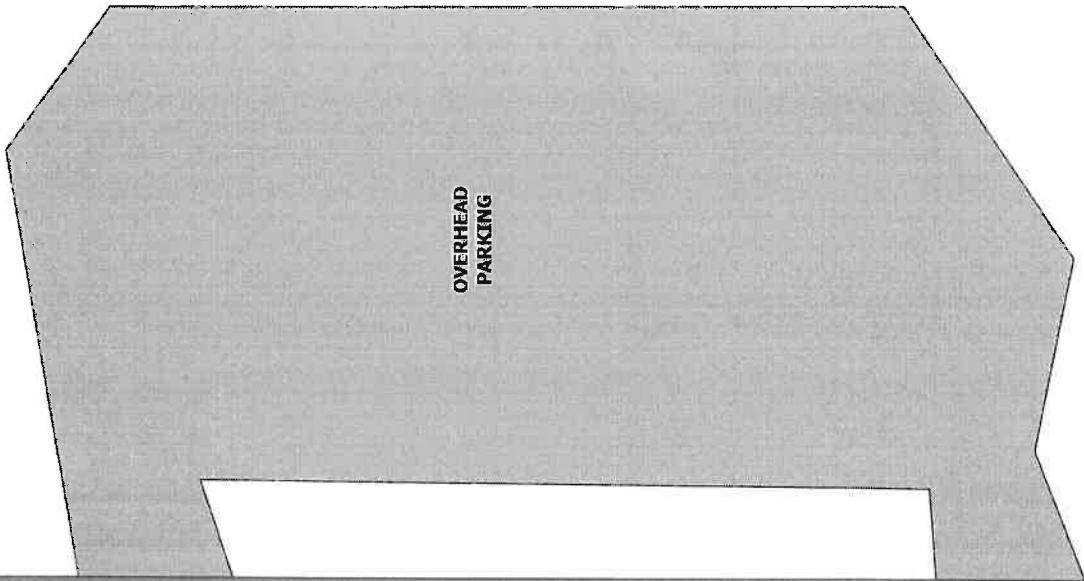

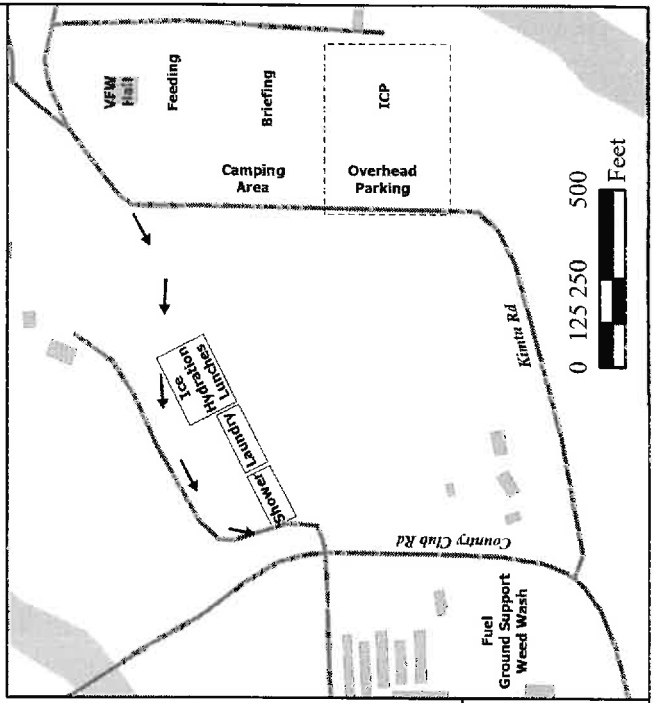

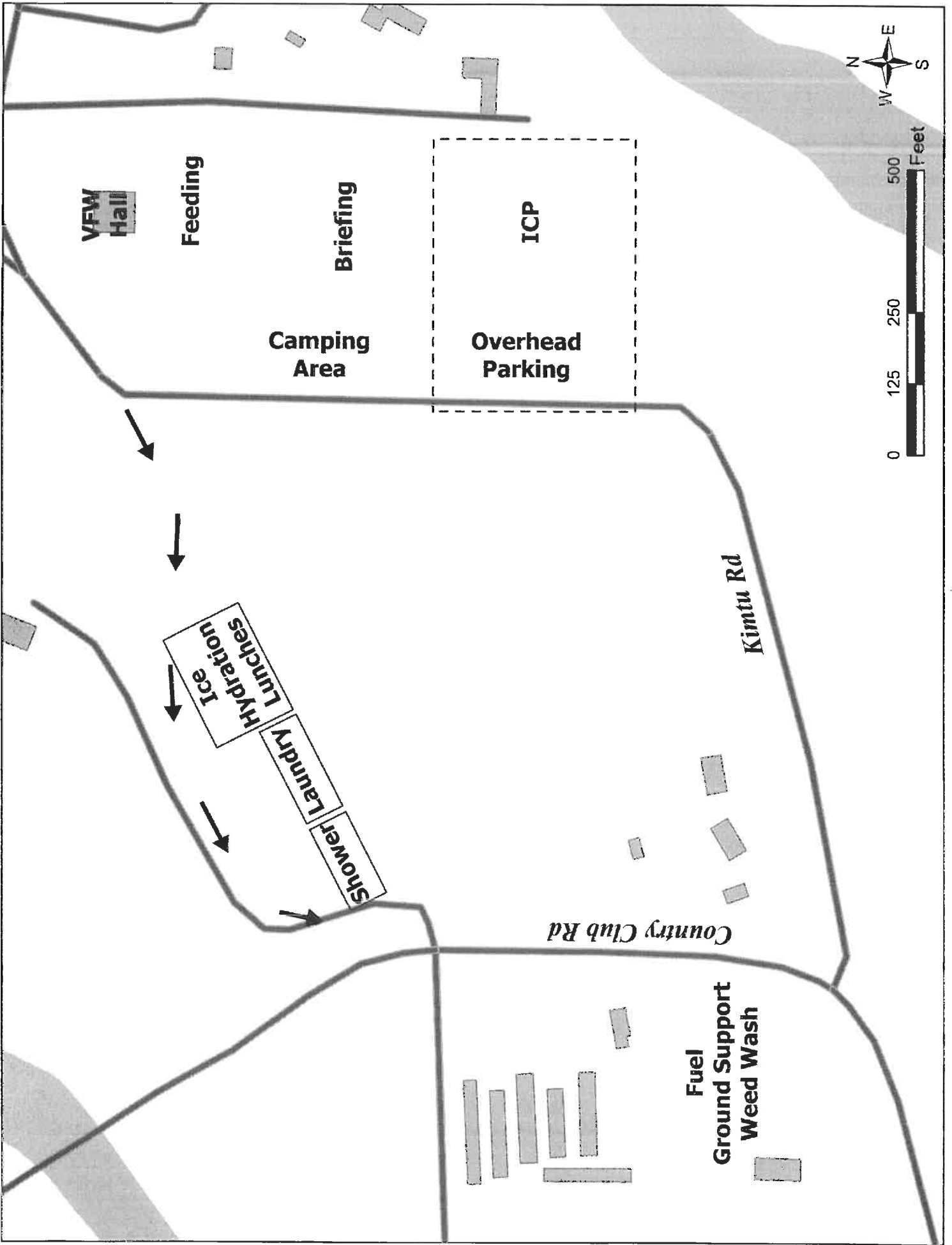

- Crew Supervisor to contact Division Supervisor/Operations with:
  - Patient Complaint, Condition and Location via Tactical or Command frequency. Priority 1/Red- 2/Yellow, life threatening emergencies trigger Incident within Incident (IWI).
- Division Supervisor/Operation contacts South Communications:
  - Division Supervisor or POC\* will run "Medical -Emergency" on the Command frequency.
  - All IWI's will go through Lightning Communications.
  - Division Supervisor or POC\* to use "Medical Incident Report" worksheet on page 118-119 of the IRPG.

POC\* (Point of Contact) and/or Operations

### EMERGENCY DURING OPS. BRIEF 0700-0730:

- If you have an emergency while briefing is going on over the command channel. Wait for a break and transmit your emergency traffic.

### LINE "NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT" PLAN:

- Crew Supervisor to contact Division Supervisor with:
  - Patient Complaint, Condition and Location via Tactical or Command frequency. Priority 3/Green patient will trigger an incident within an incident if they require transport to a medical facility.
- Division Supervisor contacts Communications:
  - Division Supervisor or POC\* will run "Non-Emergency Incident" on the Command frequency.
  - Division Supervisor or POC\* will use "Medical Incident Report" worksheet on page 118 -119 of the IRPG.
