



**FORECAST ISSUED:** 1800 Saturday, Aug 27th

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** High pressure will build aloft over the next few days with increasing temperatures and lower RH values. Very light winds out of the east and southeast during the night and early morning periods will switch to west and northwest in the afternoon while remaining light. Smoke will continue to be an annoyance as the light winds will do little to help scour it out. Some improvement may be seen from west to east late in the afternoon.

**WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY (SUNDAY):**

**WEATHER:** Sunny but smokey.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 79-85 degrees upper slopes and ridges. **24 HR Trend:** up 2-5°.  
85-92 degrees lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend:** up 2-5°

**MINIMUM HUMIDITY:** 34 - 39% upper slopes and ridges **24 HR Trend** down 5-8%.  
26 - 31% lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend** down 3-5%.

**20-FOOT WIND:**

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - Very light east wind early...becoming West or upslope 5-7 mph with gusts to 12 mph around 1300 PDT.

**RIDGETOP**- Very light south and southeast wind early...becoming west to northwest 3-5 mph increasing to 5-7 mph with gusts to 12 mph around 1300 PDT.

**INVERSIONS/STABILITY:** Weak to moderate morning inversion around 3000 feet eroding by 1300-1400 hours.

**SMOKE TRANSPORT WIND:** Southeast 5 mph early...Becoming northwest 7-10 mph after 1300 PDT.

**WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT (SUNDAY NIGHT):**

**WEATHER:** Haze through sunset then smoke settling across the fire overnight and ICP toward morning.

**MINIMUM TEMPERATURES:** 57-62 thermal belts above 3500 ft. 52-56 lower slopes. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

**MAXIMUM HUMIDITY:** 60-70% mid and upper slopes. 70-80% lower slopes and along the river. **24 HR Trend:** 5-10% Lower.

**20-FOOT WIND:**

**SLOPE/VALLEY** - West winds 7-10 mph along the ridges, diminishing to east 2-5 mph after 2200.

**RIDGETOP** - Northwest 5-10 mph with gusts up to 15 mph through 0200, diminishing to east 3-6 mph late.

**INVERSIONS/STABILITY:** Smoke settling over the fire and ICP with a moderate nighttime inversion around 3000 ft.

**EXTENDED FORECAST MONDAY - WEDNESDAY:**

A very dry and stable air mass will encompass the fire area over the next few days. This will be accompanied by a trend of increasing temperatures and lowering RH values. A return of light easterly winds during the late night and early morning hours can be expected...while light westerlies flow during the afternoon and evening periods.

### OUTPUTS

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

##### GENERAL:

Slightly higher humidity will still support active fire behavior once the inversion breaks. Expect low to moderate fire behavior under the inversion. Once the inversion lifts fire behavior will increase to moderate - active. Nighttime recovery will keep fire behavior low. The fires are burning in areas with no recent fire history and significant dead and down, resulting in abundant surface fuels. The fires are situated near the confluence of the main stem Trinity River and the S. Fork of the Trinity River, which will influence wind channeling and subsequently fire behavior – watch for erratic and eddy winds near the confluence and large bends in the river canyons.

**Ignition Receptiveness:** Probability of Ignition 35% shaded 57% sunshine Night 113% Spotting ¼ - ½ mile

**Dryness:** Dead and down fuel moistures :1 hour – 6-9%, 10 hour– 10%, and 1000 hour– 12%.

##### SPECIFIC:

##### Branch I - Divisions A, D, G, N and R.

Creeping and smoldering in Division A and D control lines have sufficient depth to make interior activity unlikely to compromise control lines. In Div. N, fire will continue to move upslope towards Lone Pine Ridge. Spotting can be expected on top of the Lone Pine Ridge. The head will keep moving southeast into Groves Prairie and south.

##### Branch X – Divisions U, W

Fire in Div. W and U No perimeter growth is expected. Spotting outside of the line continues to be viable but to a lesser extent with the predicated probability of ignition.

Night: Early on in the shift expect to see active fire behavior especially in the interior and in Division N area. Watch for any spotting that may have occurred throughout the day but went unnoticed in the Horse Range drainage. Activity should moderate around 2400 hours.

##### AIR OPERATIONS:

The inversion will limit air morning operations, during the afternoon hours air operations should not be limited.



*Common Denominators of fire behavior on tragedy fires:*

- *Most incidents happen on the smaller fires or on isolated portions of larger fires.*
- *Most fires are innocent in appearance before unexpected shifts in wind direction and/or speed results in “flare-ups” or “extreme fire behavior.” In some cases, tragedies occur in the mop-up stage.*
- *Flare-ups generally occur in deceptively light fuels, such as grass and light brush.*
- *Fires run uphill surprisingly fast in chimneys, gullies, and on steep slopes.*
- *Some suppression tools, such as helicopters or airtankers, can adversely affect fire behavior. The blasts of air from low flying helicopters and airtankers have been known to cause flare-ups.*

**Major Hazard and Risk:**

- **Hazard Tree Safety:** Hazard trees, both dead snags and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazards trees. **This includes your sleeping areas in camp! IRPG pg. 20**
- **Extended Extraction Times:** Be familiar with the medical plan. Develop a plan on how you would get an injured firefighter out timely. Factor in how smoke inversions will reduce the likelihood of utilizing helicopters for a medevac.
- **Hazardous Roads:** Narrow roads, steep drop offs, erratic drivers, and operator fatigue are all prevalent on this and other assignments. Watch out!
- **Heat Related Injuries:** Stay hydrated, eat properly, drink fluids in a 3:1 ratio of water to sports drink, take frequent breaks, and pay attention to your body.

Damaged items will be surrendered to the Supply Unit. Replacement for normal wear and tear is through home unit project funds.

# STAGE 1 Fire Suppression Repair Cheat Sheet

**Remember, if you have any doubts or questions about the ideal end state of these repairs, get in touch with a READ!**

**Overall Objective:** Repair damage caused by suppression activities, and thus minimize short and long-term environmental impacts. Impacts caused by the direct effects of fire will be mitigated or corrected during this repair phase, only those impacts caused by the *suppression* of the fire.

## **General Guidelines for Stage 1 Repair (consult signed Suppression Repair Plan (SR Plan))**

### **Dozer and Hand Lines:**

- Construct water bars and/or rolling dips where access is no longer needed and erosion is a concern. Knock down berms into the fire line. (see SR Plan page 13)
- Firelines that cross draws/channels will be cleaned of debris and recontoured (see SR Plan page 15)
- Remove suppression created fuels and logs from firelines via chipping, piling, lop & scatter, and decking, advised.
- Trench handlines should be pulled back and contoured.
- Obliterate hand lines where they intersect FS trails.
- Strategic firelines intended for future use should have suppression general debris chipped and little to no debris or brush scattered over them. Only pile after all other repair activities are complete.

### **Safety Zones, Drop Points, Helispots, Sling Sites, Staging Areas, etc:**

- Restore to pre-existing condition.
- Knock down berms, de-compact soil, and restore natural drainage flows.
- Only pull enough slash across the area to reduce erosion and prevent further impacts.
- Chip and pile debris, as advised.

### **Roads and Trails:**

- Clean ditches, side drains, rolling dips, and other drainage features along roads damaged by suppression activities (see SR Plan page 14).
- Where needed, water and grade surfaces and remove berms along roads impacted by suppression activities.
- Chip side-cast slash on roads, construct slash piles, lop and scatter, or deck logs, as advised.
- Repair damaged earthen barriers for Maintenance Level 1, decommissioned, and non-system roads (see SR Plan page 16).

### **Miscellaneous Resources:**

- Maintain the integrity of Wilderness, Inventoried Roadless Areas and Wild and Scenic River Corridor characteristics
- **SITES WITH YELLOW/BLACK FLAGGING: Sites:** *No repair work may commence without consultation with an assigned Archaeologist and the Hoopa Tribal Representative, and/or and the lead Resource Advisor to the fire.*
- Remove all equipment, gear, hose, flagging, and trash from firelines and dispersal sites following repair actions.

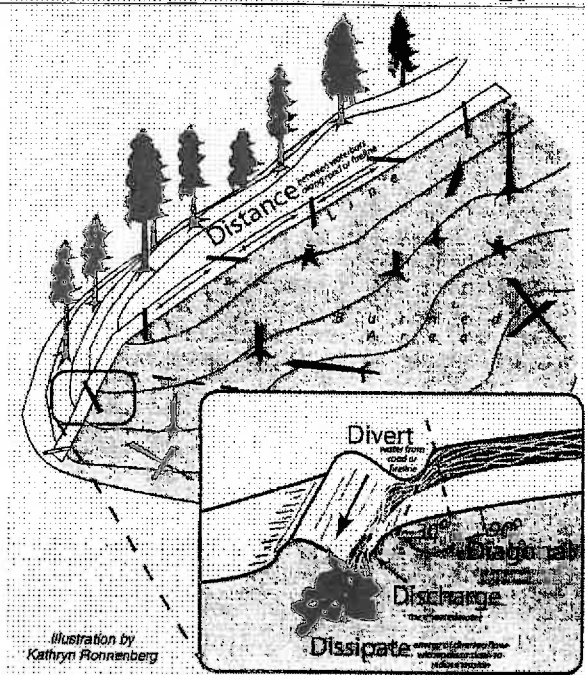
