FORECAST ISSUED: 1800 Sunday, Aug 28th, 2022

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Minimal changes. High pressure over the area will keep conditions stable through today. This morning's east-southeast winds will persist through 1100 when they turn westerly. The west wind will increase this afternoon with gusts up to 15 mph. Expecting the smoke inversion to develop after 0900 at around 2000 ft, although smoke will be moderate prior to the inversion intensifying. Smoke will be stubborn to erode but should lift after 1500. At lower elevations and in the valleys, smoke will likely linger longer. A drier airmass sits aloft which may mix down to the surface if winds increase. If this does occur, looking at humidity dropping to around 20%.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY (MONDAY):

WEATHER: Sunny, but smoky.

MAX TEMPERATURES: 79-83 degrees upper slopes and ridges. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.
87-93 degrees lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 25 - 30% upper slopes and ridges **24 HR Trend** minimal change.
19 - 28% lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend** down 2-4%.

20-FOOT WIND:

SLOPE/VALLEY - Very light east wind early...becoming west or upslope 5-7 mph with gusts to 12 mph around 1300 PDT.

RIDGETOP- Very light south and southeast wind early...becoming west to northwest 3-5 mph increasing to 5-7 mph with gusts to 12 mph around 1200 PDT.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Moderate inversion around 3000 feet eroding by 1300-1400 hours.

SMOKE TRANSPORT WIND: Southeast 5 mph early...Becoming northwest 7-10 mph after 1300 PDT.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT (MONDAY NIGHT):

WEATHER: Haze through sunset then smoke settling across the fire overnight and ICP toward morning.

MINIMUM TEMPERATURES: 57-62 thermal belts above 3500 ft. 55-60 lower slopes. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 60-70% mid and upper slopes. 70-80% lower slopes and along the river. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

20-FOOT WIND:

SLOPE/VALLEY - West-northwest winds 7-10 mph along the ridges, diminishing to southeast 2-5 mph after 2200.

RIDGETOP - Northwest 5-10 mph with gusts up to 15 mph through 0200, diminishing to east 3-6 mph late.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Smoke settling over the fire and ICP with a moderate nighttime inversion around 3000 ft.

EXTENDED FORECAST TUESDAY - THURSDAY: Tuesday and Wednesday have the potential to be very dry as the warm air mass persists aloft. With any stronger winds that may form, this could mix the dry air to the surface and lower relative humidity. The limiting factor will once again be smoke which remains a challenge to forecast.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Very little change in fire behavior is expected. Low to moderate fire behavior under the inversion with moderate to active above or outside of the inversion. The fires are burning in areas with no recent fire history and significant dead and down, resulting in abundant surface fuels. The fires are situated near the confluence of the main stem Trinity River and the S. Fork of the Trinity River, which will influence wind channeling and subsequently fire behavior – watch for erratic and eddying winds near the confluence and large bends in the river canyons.

Ignition Receptiveness: Probability of Ignition 39% shaded 65% sunshine Night 11% Spotting ¼ - ½ mile

Dryness: Dead and down fuel moistures :1 hour – 5-8%, 10 hour– 9%, and 1000 hour– 12%.

SPECIFIC:

Branch I - Divisions A, D, G, N and R.

Creeping and smoldering in Division A and D. Control lines have sufficient depth to make interior activity unlikely to compromise control lines. In Div. N, fire will continue to move upslope towards Lone Pine Ridge. Spotting can be expected on top of the Lone Pine Ridge. Division R the head will keep moving south. Division G fire will continue moving west and northwest.

Branch X – Divisions U, W

Fire in Div. W and U No perimeter growth is expected. Spotting outside of the line continues to be viable but to a lesser extent with the predicated probability of ignition.

Night: Early on in the shift expect to see active fire behavior especially in the interior and in Division N area. Watch for any spotting that may have occurred throughout the day but went unnoticed in the Horse Range drainage. Activity should moderate around 2400 hours.



The inversion will limit morning air operations, during the afternoon hours air operations should not be limited.



Be alert to indicators of extreme fire behavior:

- *Tree crowning out inside fireline*
- *Smoldering fires beginning to burn actively*
- *Approaching thunderheads with dark clouds beneath*
- *Presence of dust devils and whirlwinds*
- *Increased spotting*
- *Sudden calm*
- *High clouds moving fast in direction different from surface wind*



- **Extended Extraction Times:** Be familiar with the medical plan. Develop a plan on how you would get an injured firefighter out timely. Factor in how smoke inversions will reduce the likelihood of utilizing helicopters for a medevac.
- **Hazard Tree Safety:** Hazard trees, both dead snags and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazards trees. **This includes your sleeping areas in camp!**

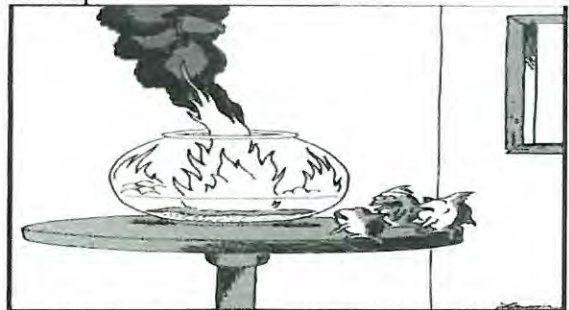

Common Denominators of Fire Behavior on Tragedy Fires

- On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires.
- In light fuels, such as grass, herbs and light brush
- When there is an unexpected shift in wind direction or in wind speed
- When fire responds to topographic conditions and runs uphill

STAGE 1 Fire Suppression Repair Cheat Sheet

Remember, if you have any doubts or questions about the ideal end state of these repairs, get in touch with a READ!

Overall Objective: Repair damage caused by suppression activities, and thus minimize short and long-term environmental impacts. Impacts caused by the direct effects of fire will be mitigated or corrected during this repair phase, only those impacts caused by the *suppression* of the fire.

General Guidelines for Stage 1 Repair (consult signed Suppression Repair Plan (SR Plan))

Dozer and Hand Lines:

- Construct water bars and/or rolling dips where access is no longer needed and erosion is a concern. Knock down berms into the fire line. (see SR Plan page 13)
- Firelines that cross draws/channels will be cleaned of debris and re-contoured (see SR Plan page 15)
- Remove suppression created fuels and logs from firelines via chipping, piling, lop & scatter, and decking, advised.
- Trench handlines should be pulled back and contoured.
- Obliterate hand lines where they intersect FS trails.
- Strategic firelines intended for future use should have suppression general debris chipped and little to no debris or brush scattered over them. Only pile after all other repair activities are complete.

Safety Zones, Drop Points, Helispots, Sling Sites, Staging Areas, etc:

- Restore to pre-existing condition.
- Knock down berms, de-compact soil, and restore natural drainage flows.
- Only pull enough slash across the area to reduce erosion and prevent further impacts.
- Chip and pile debris, as advised.

Roads and Trails:

- Clean ditches, side drains, rolling dips, and other drainage features along roads damaged by suppression activities (see SR Plan page 14).
- Where needed, water and grade surfaces and remove berms along roads impacted by suppression activities.
- Chip side-cast slash on roads, construct slash piles, lop and scatter, or deck logs, as advised.
- Repair damaged earthen barriers for Maintenance Level 1, decommissioned, and non-system roads (see SR Plan page 16).

Miscellaneous Resources:

- Maintain the integrity of Wilderness, Inventoried Roadless Areas and Wild and Scenic River Corridor characteristics
- **SITES WITH YELLOW/BLACK FLAGGING:** *Sites: No repair work may commence without consultation with an assigned Archaeologist and the Hoopa Tribal Representative, and/or and the lead Resource Advisor to the fire.*
- Remove all equipment, gear, hose, flagging, and trash from firelines and dispersal sites following repair actions.

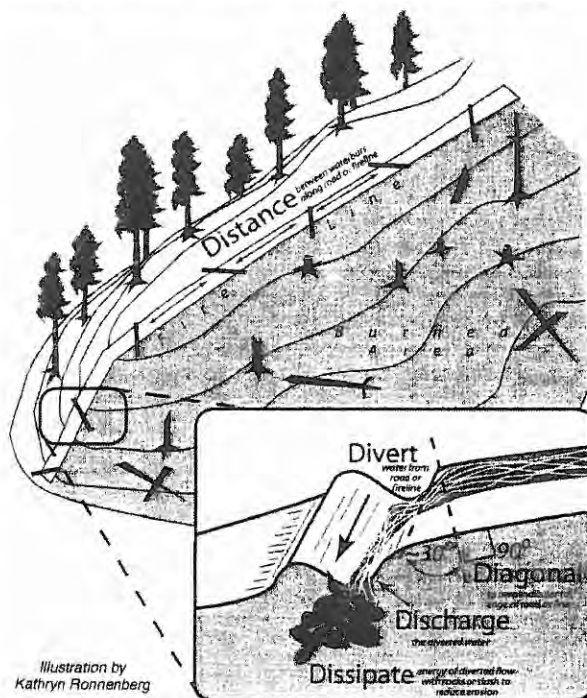
Fences and Gates:

- Repair any fences and gates damaged by suppression activities.

Water Sources:

- Remove dams, dikes, and other impoundments.
- Restore damaged stream banks to natural contours.
- Report fuel and oil spills.

8. MEDICAL EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

LINE "MEDICAL-EMERGENCY" PLAN:

- Crew Supervisor to contact Division Supervisor/Operations with:
 - Patient Complaint, Condition and Location via Tactical or Command frequency. Priority 1/Red- 2/Yellow, life threatening emergencies trigger Incident within Incident (IWI).
- Division Supervisor/Operation contacts South Communications:
 - Division Supervisor or POC* will run "Medical -Emergency" on the Command frequency.
 - All IWI's will go through Lightning Communications.
 - Division Supervisor or POC* to use "Medical Incident Report" worksheet on page 118-119 of the IRPG.

POC* (Point of Contact) and/or Operations

EMERGENCY DURING OPS. BRIEF 0700-0730:

- If you have an emergency while briefing is going on over the command channel. Wait for a break and transmit your emergency traffic.

LINE "NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT" PLAN:

- Crew Supervisor to contact Division Supervisor with:
 - Patient Complaint, Condition and Location via Tactical or Command frequency. Priority 3/Green patient will trigger an incident within an incident if they require transport to a medical facility.
- Division Supervisor contacts Communications:
 - Division Supervisor or POC* will run "Non-Emergency Incident" on the Command frequency.
 - Division Supervisor or POC* will use "Medical Incident Report" worksheet on page 118 -119 of the IRPG.

Medical Incident Report

FOR A **NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT**: WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A **MEDICAL EMERGENCY**: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE **"MEDICAL EMERGENCY"** TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS

Use the following items to communicate situation to communications/dispatch.

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)
 Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha, Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.
 Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree.
 Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.)
 "This will be the Trout Meadow Medical Incident, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
