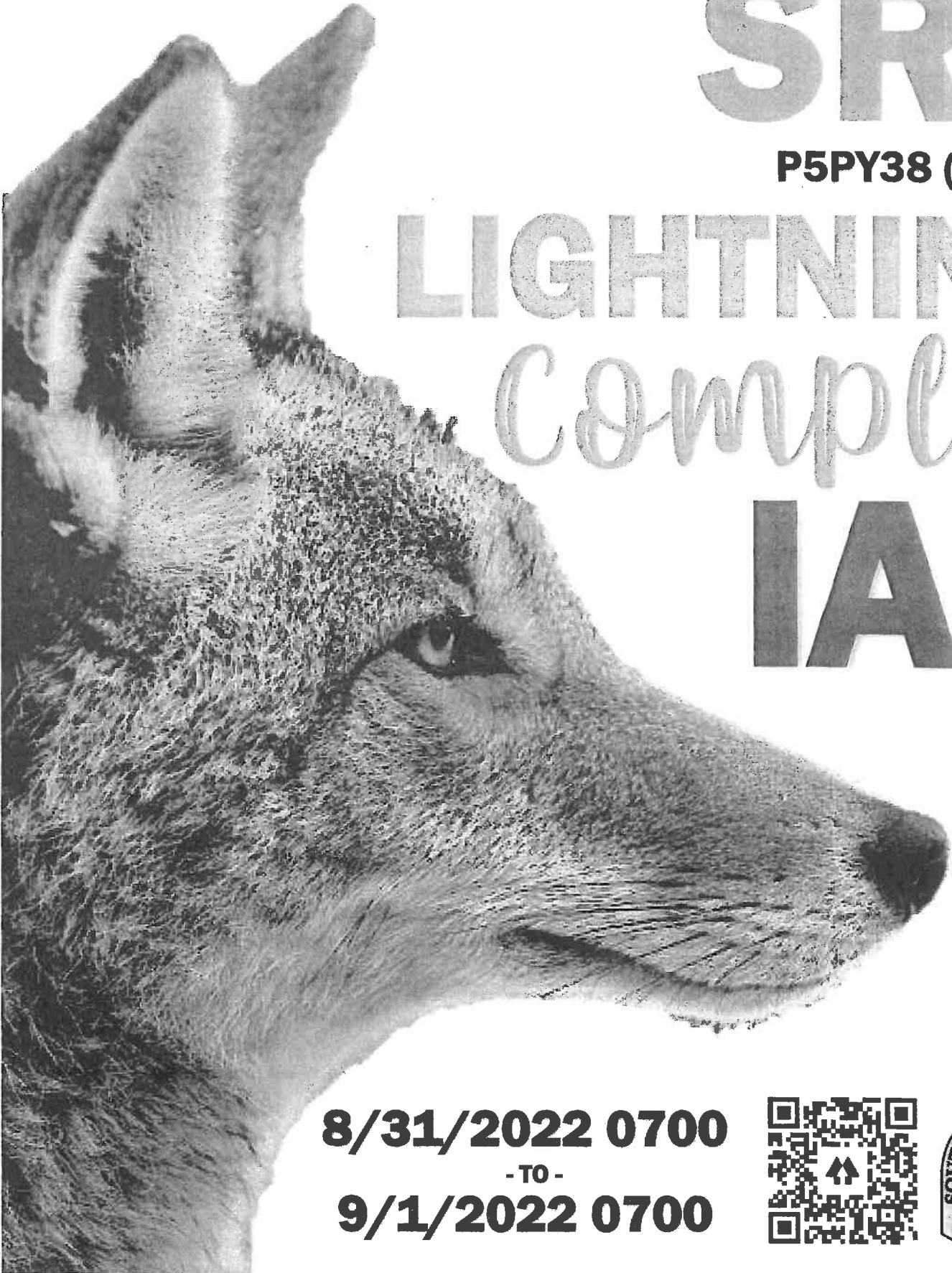

FORECAST ISSUED: 1800 Tuesday, Aug 30th, 2022

WEATHER DISCUSSION: High pressure remains over the fire area along with minimal marine influence promoting a continuation of very dry and stable conditions. Will continue to see a moderate inversion layer forming each morning and persisting until after 1300. Winds will remain southeast overnight, becoming westerly this afternoon. Smoke will persist and will remain moderate to heavy in the morning below the inversion...improving this afternoon into evening. Expecting another afternoon of critically low humidity however daytime winds should remain mainly light and westerly or terrain driven.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY (WEDNESDAY):

WEATHER: Sunny, but smoky. Moderate to heavy smoke below 2000 ft.

MAX TEMPERATURES: 80-89 degrees upper slopes and ridges. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.
92-99 degrees lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 21-25% upper slopes and ridges. **24 HR Trend** down 1-2%.
16 - 23% lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend** minimal change.

20-FOOT WIND:

SLOPE/VALLEY - Very light east wind early...becoming west or upslope 5-7 mph with gusts to 12 mph around 1200 PDT.

RIDGETOP- Very light south and southeast wind early...becoming west to northwest 3-5 mph increasing to 5-7 mph with gusts to 12 mph around 1200 PDT.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Moderate inversion around 3000 feet eroding by 1300-1400 hours.

SMOKE TRANSPORT WIND: South-southeast 15 mph.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT (WEDNESDAY NIGHT):

WEATHER: Haze through sunset then smoke settling across the fire overnight and ICP toward morning.

MINIMUM TEMPERATURES: 57-62 thermal belts above 3500 ft. 55-60 lower slopes. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 45-55% mid and upper slopes. 65-75% lower slopes and along the river. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

20-FOOT WIND:

SLOPE/VALLEY – West-northwest winds 7-10 mph along the ridges, diminishing to southeast 2-5 mph after 2200.

RIDGETOP - Northwest 5-10 mph with gusts up to 15 mph through 0200, diminishing to east 3-6 mph late.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Smoke settling over the fire and ICP with a moderate nighttime inversion around 3000 ft.

EXTENDED FORECAST THURSDAY - SATURDAY: Minimal change in the forecast as the high pressure ridge remains nearly stationary over the fire area through Thursday. Subtle improvement in relative humidity may be seen on Friday and into the weekend while winds remain quite light. The smoke will continue to be the main driver of weather through the remainder of the period.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

Another dry day will support active to extreme fire behavior with torching and spotting. Ridgetop winds will produce spots across the lines during the late afternoon and evening. Expect spotting out to ¼ mile. The potential exists for very active to extreme fire behavior if the inversion breaks. Rollouts will be a problem. The fires are burning in areas with no recent fire history and significant dead and down, resulting in abundant surface fuels. The fires are situated near the confluence of the main stem Trinity River and the S. Fork of the Trinity River, which will influence wind channeling and subsequently fire behavior – watch for erratic and eddying winds near the confluence and large bends in the river canyons.

Ignition Receptiveness: Probability of Ignition 56% shaded 90% sunshine Night 13% Spotting 3/4 mile

Dryness: Dead and down fuel moistures :1 hour – 3-6%, 10 hour– 9%, and 1000 hour– 11%.

SPECIFIC:

Branch I - Divisions A, D, G, J, N and R.

Creeping and smoldering in Division A and D control lines have sufficient depth to make interior activity unlikely to compromise control lines. In Div. J, fire will continue to move downslope and upslope closing the donut hole below Lone Pine Ridge. Division N the spot in Hawkins Creek will continue to grow to the south and east. Spotting to the east is likely. Division R any burnouts along the ridge will provide an opportunity for spotting to the east. Division G fire will continue to fill in the gap between the burnouts. Spotting to the north and west in the morning.

Branch X – Divisions U, W

Fire in Div. W and U No perimeter growth is expected. The possibility of spotting outside of the line continues. Creeping and smoldering otherwise.

Night Shift: Spots early in the shift have been happening over the last week. Watch for spots across the line. Activity should moderate around 0400 hours. Moderate to active fire behavior is expected.



Below the inversion air operations will be limited. Above the inversion the air may clear allowing for air operations.

- **Extended Extraction Times:** Be familiar with the medical plan. Develop a plan on how you would get an injured firefighter out timely. Factor in how smoke inversions will reduce the likelihood of utilizing helicopters for a medevac.
- **Hazard Tree Safety:** Hazard trees, both dead snags and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazards trees. **This includes your sleeping areas in camp!**

As we continue to deal with heavy smoke-

- **Be vigilant with your health. When driving, keep your lights on. Move into cleaner air if it makes operational sense to do so.**



Firing operations-

- Make a good plan
- Communicate that plan
- Be patient

Pay attention to fire behavior-

Base all actions on current and expected fire behavior

Due to the dynamic nature of fire behavior, intensity estimates are difficult to make with absolute certainty. It is imperative that firefighters consider the worst case and build contingency actions into their plan to compensate for the unexpected.



STAGE 1 Fire Suppression Repair Cheat Sheet

Remember, if you have any doubts or questions about the ideal end state of these repairs, get in touch with a READ!

Overall Objective: Repair damage caused by suppression activities, and thus minimize short and long-term environmental impacts. Impacts caused by the direct effects of fire will be mitigated or corrected during this repair phase, only those impacts caused by the suppression of the fire.

General Guidelines for Stage 1 Repair (consult signed Suppression Repair Plan (SR Plan))

Dozer and Hand Lines:

- Construct water bars and/or rolling dips where access is no longer needed and erosion is a concern. Knock down berms into the fire line. (see SR Plan page 13)
- Firelines that cross draws/channels will be cleaned of debris and re-contoured (see SR Plan page 15)
- Remove suppression created fuels and logs from firelines via chipping, piling, lop & scatter, and decking, advised.
- Trench handlines should be pulled back and contoured.
- Obliterate hand lines where they intersect FS trails.
- Strategic firelines intended for future use should have suppression general debris chipped and little to no debris or brush scattered over them. Only pile after all other repair activities are complete.

Safety Zones, Drop Points, Helispots, Sling Sites, Staging Areas, etc:

- Restore to pre-existing condition.
- Knock down berms, de-compact soil, and restore natural drainage flows.
- Only pull enough slash across the area to reduce erosion and prevent further impacts.
- Chip and pile debris, as advised.

Roads and Trails:

- Clean ditches, side drains, rolling dips, and other drainage features along roads damaged by suppression activities (see SR Plan page 14).
- Where needed, water and grade surfaces and remove berms along roads impacted by suppression activities.
- Chip side-cast slash on roads, construct slash piles, lop and scatter, or deck logs, as advised.
- Repair damaged earthen barriers for Maintenance Level 1, decommissioned, and non-system roads (see SR Plan page 16).

Miscellaneous Resources:

- Maintain the integrity of Wilderness, Inventoried Roadless Areas and Wild and Scenic River Corridor characteristics
- **SITES WITH YELLOW/BLACK FLAGGING: Sites:** *No repair work may commence without consultation with an assigned Archaeologist and the Hoopa Tribal Representative, and/or and the lead Resource Advisor to the fire.*
- Remove all equipment, gear, hose, flagging, and trash from firelines and dispersal sites following repair actions.

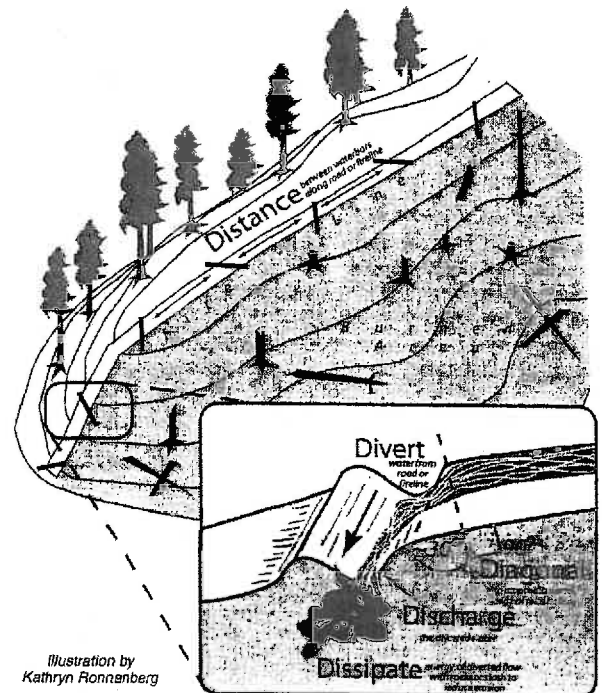

- Restore damaged stream banks to natural contours.

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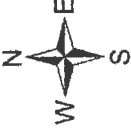
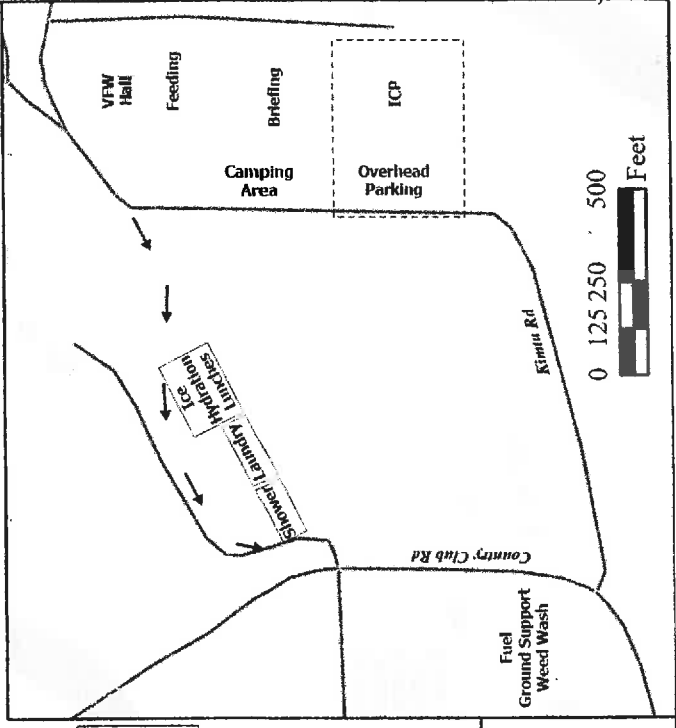
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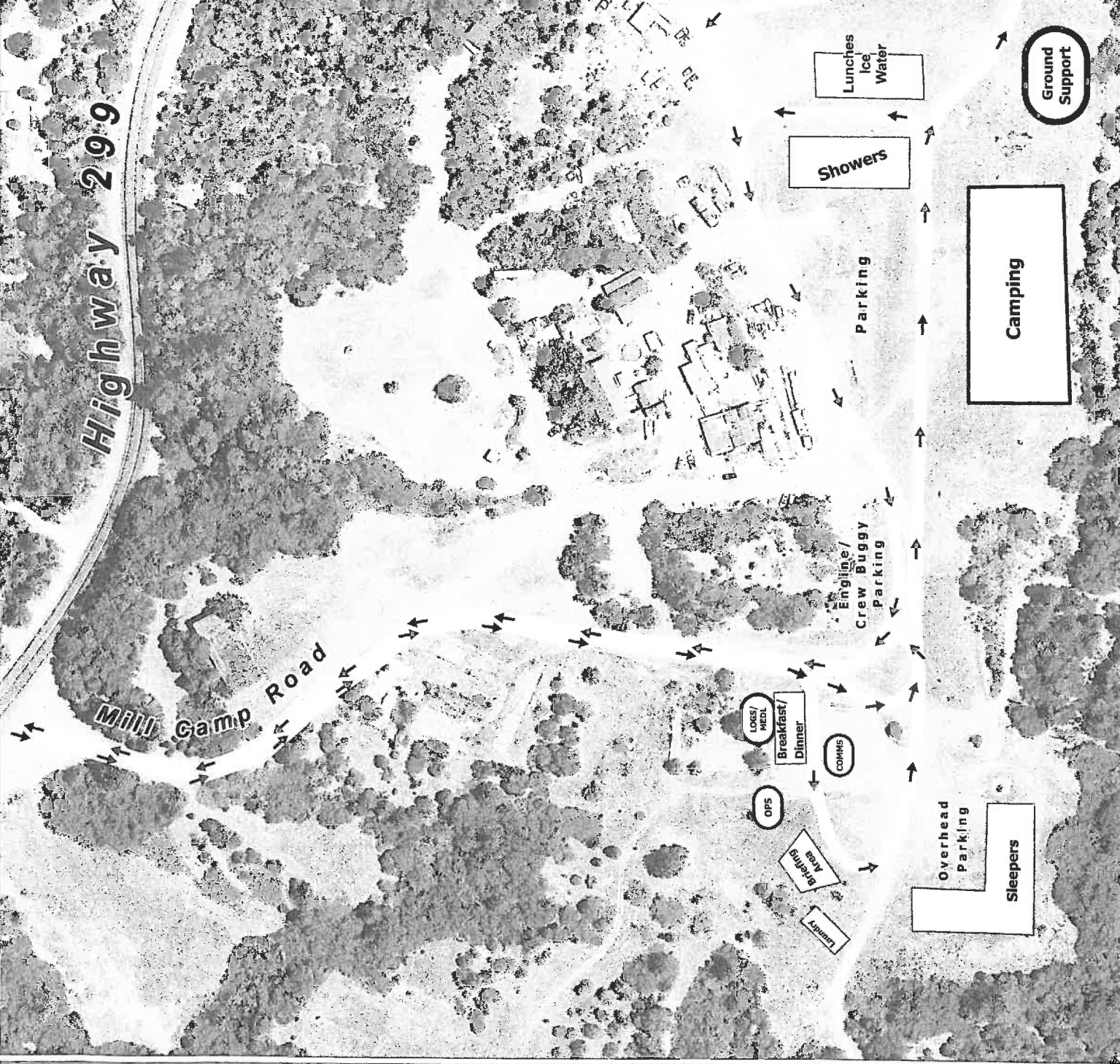
