#### 2022 SRF Lightning Complex Fire Weather Forecast

FORECAST ISSUED: 1800 Thursday, September 1st, 2022

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Minimal changes as high pressure remains over the fire area. The ridge of high pressure will intensify over the next several days maintaining a trend of dry and warm temperatures. Slightly cooler today as a weak marine disturbance pushes northeast of the Pacific. Not expecting marine stratus and relative humidity will increase a few percent...especially along higher slopes. Will maintain the weak southeast winds through this morning becoming northwesterly this afternoon, as well as the inversion sitting at 2000 ft. Will likely see a return of moderate smoke which may improve in the afternoon. Will see improved humidity recoveries overnight.

#### WEATHER FORECAST FOR TODAY (FRIDAY):

WEATHER: Sunny, but smoky. Moderate to heavy smoke below 2000 ft.

MAX TEMPERATURES: 80-87 degrees upper slopes and ridges. 24 HR Trend: minimal change.

90-96 degrees lower slopes and drainages. 24 HR Trend: minimal change.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 21-25% upper slopes and ridges. 24 HR Trend down 1-2%.

19 - 25% lower slopes and drainages. **24 HR Trend** minimal change.

20-FOOT WIND:

**SLOPE/VALLEY -** Very light east wind early...becoming west or upslope 5-7 mph with gusts to 14 mph around 1200 pp.T.

**RIDGETOP-** Very light south and southeast wind early... becoming west to northwest 3-5 mph increasing to 5-7 mph with gusts to 14 mph around 1200 PDT.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Moderate inversion around 3000 feet eroding by 1300-1400 hours.

SMOKE TRANSPORT WIND: South-southeast 15 mph.

#### **WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT (FRIDAY NIGHT):**

WEATHER: Haze through sunset then smoke settling across the fire overnight and ICP toward morning.

MINIMUM TEMPERATURES: 58-63 thermal belts above 3500 ft. 55-60 lower slopes. 24 HR Trend: minimal change.

**MAXIMUM HUMIDITY:** 50-58% mid and upper slopes. 65-75% lower slopes and along the river. **24 HR Trend:** minimal change.

20-FOOT WIND:

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – West-northwest winds 7-10 mph along the ridges, diminishing to southeast 2-5 mph after 2200.

RIDGETOP - Northwest 5-10 mph with gusts up to 15 mph through 0200, diminishing to east 3-6 mph late.

INVERSIONS/STABILITY: Smoke settling over the fire and ICP with a moderate nighttime inversion around 3000 ft.

<u>EXTENDED FORECAST SATURDAY - MONDAY:</u> Minimal change in the forecast as the high pressure ridge remains nearly stationary over the fire area through Monday. Subtle overnight humidity recovery, with slightly higher daytime humidity.

#### **INPUTS**

#### **WEATHER SUMMARY:**

Weather: Minimal changes as high pressure remains over the fire area.

Max Temp: 80°-87° (upper elevations), 90°-96° (lower slopes) Min Temp: 55°-63°

Min RH: 21%-25% (upper elevations), 19%-25% (lower slopes)

20 foot winds: light easterly winds early, becoming west to northwest 5-7 mph around 1200

#### **FUELS SUMMARY:**

The Campbell and Ammon fires resulted from a lightning event that occurred in the early morning hours of August 5<sup>th</sup>. Although the area has seen 50-75% of normal precipitation in the current rain year, the relatively mild spring and early summer conditions had the fuel and fire danger indices near historical averages during the initial stages of the fires. Current conditions are reflective of an additional month of drying with all fuels and fire danger indices above the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile. The primary carrier of fire at lower elevations is timber litter with a substantial hardwood dead and down component resulting from an ice/snow event this past winter.

#### **OUTPUTS**

#### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

#### **GENERAL:**

The fire is burning in a very complex fire environment, which includes steep slopes and rugged terrain limiting access, heavy ground fuel loads, and large drainages impacting winds speeds and direction. Factors influencing fire behavior have been roll-out, uphill runs when fuel and topography become aligned, and moderate range spotting from torching trees. Expect fire behavior to increase each afternoon as the wind shifts from southeasterly to northwesterly and the smoke thins out.

#### SPECIFIC:

**Branch I:** Continue to aggressively secure the line and take advantage of opportunities to increase the depth of the firing operation that occurred adjacent to Cedar Creek in Div. G. The best opportunities in this area will likely occur during the overnight hours. The main threat of perimeter growth across both fires will be from roll-out below the mid-slope road control feature in Div. R and from spot fires near Happy Camp Mountain in Div. N.

**Branch X:** There has been limited fire behavior on the Ammon fire for the last 10+ days. Heat remains in the inaccessible area above Madden Creek, so lookouts who can access potential of increased activity in this area will need to continue.

Initial Attack: Increased initial attack activity is expected across the state as fire danger increases heading into the holiday weekend

#### **AIR OPERATIONS:**

Sunrise 0644, Last Light 1947 (Daylength: losing 2 min, 36 sec)

Heavy smoke will continue to impact air operations for most of the operational period, with clearing occurring after 1400.

#### SAFETY

Slow down and drive defensively when on the steep, narrow, dirt roads in and around the fire area. This is critical in the smoky conditions and after dark. Take the time to plan your travel routes and coordinate traffic patterns where necessary.


- Hazard Tree Safety: Hazard trees, both dead snags and live green trees, are one of the most common risks encountered on the fireline. All firefighters should frequently survey their work area for potential hazards trees. This includes your sleeping areas in camp!
- Extended Extraction Times: Be familiar with the medical plan. Develop a plan on how you would get an injured firefighter out timely. Factor in how smoke inversions will reduce the likelihood of utilizing helicopters for a medevac.
- > Hazardous Roads: Narrow roads, steep drop offs, erratic drivers, and operator fatigue are all prevalent on this and other assignments. Watch out!
- ➤ Heat Related Injuries: Stay hydrated, eat properly, drink fluids in a 3:1 ratio of water to sports drink, take frequent breaks, and pay attention to your body.

## STAGE 1 Fire Suppression Repair Cheat Sheet

Remember, if you have any doubts or questions about the ideal end state of these repairs, get in touch with a READ!

Overall Objective: Repair damage caused by <u>suppression activities</u>, and thus minimize short and long-term environmental impacts. Impacts caused by the direct effects of fire will be mitigated or corrected during this repair phase, only those impacts caused by the *suppression* of the fire.

#### General Guidelines for Stage 1 Repair (consult signed Suppression Repair Plan (SR Plan))

#### **Dozer and Hand Lines:**

- Construct water bars and/or rolling dips where access is no longer needed and erosion is a concern. Knock down berms into the fire line. (see SR Plan page 13)
- Firelines that cross draws/channels will be cleaned of debris and re-contoured (see SR Plan page 15)
- Remove suppression created fuels and logs from firelines via chipping, piling, lop & scatter, and decking, advised.
- Trench handlines should be pulled back and contoured.
- Obliterate hand lines where they intersect FS trails.
- Strategic firelines intended for future use should have suppression general debris chipped and little to no debris or brush scattered over them. Only pile after all other repair activities are complete.

# Safety Zones, Drop Points, Helispots, Sling Sites, Staging Areas, etc:

- Restore to pre-existing condition.
- Knock down berms, de-compact soil, and restore natural drainage flows.
- Only pull enough slash across the area to reduce erosion and prevent further impacts.
- Chip and pile debris, as advised.

#### Roads and Trails:

- Clean ditches, side drains, rolling dips, and other drainage features along roads damaged by suppression activities (see SR Plan page 14).
- Where needed, water and grade surfaces and remove berms along roads impacted by suppression activities.
- Chip side-cast slash on roads, construct slash piles, lop and scatter, or deck logs, as advised.
- Repair damaged earthen barriers for Maintenance Level 1, decommissioned, and non-system roads (see SR Plan page 16).

#### Miscellaneous Resources:


- Maintain the integrity of Wilderness, Inventoried Roadless Areas and Wild and Scenic River Corridor characteristics
- SITES WITH YELLOW/BLACK FLAGGING: Sites: No repair work may commence without consultation with an assigned Archaeologist and the Hoopa Tribal Representative, and/or and the lead Resource Advisor to the fire.
- Remove all equipment, gear, hose, flagging, and trash from firelines and dispersal sites following repair actions.


#### Fences and Gates:

Repair any fences and gates damaged by suppression activities.

#### Water Sources:

- Remove dams, dikes, and other impoundments.
- Restore damaged stream banks to natural contours.
- Report fuel and oil spills.




