DISCUSSION: UNSETTLED WEATHER CONDITIONS WITH SHOWERS, ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS AND EAST-SOUTHEAST WINDS GUSTING FROM 15 TO 25 MPH WILL OCCUR THROUGH TUESDAY. IN ADDITION, BELOW NORMAL TEMPERATURES AND HUMID CONDITIONS WILL PERSIST INTO WEDNESDAY AS AN EARLY SEASON STORM SYSTEM SLOWLY MOVES ACROSS THE AREA. DRIER AND WARMER CONDITIONS WILL THEN BECOME PROBABLE DURING LATE WEEK AS THE STORM SYSTEM EXITS EAST AWAY FROM THE REGION.

Safety Message

With the recent wet weather hypothermia can occurs when your core body temperature falls below normal. **Hypothermia** can also occur in moderately cool temperatures, particularly if coupled with dehydration. **People tend to forget to drink on cool, wet days, and can get hypothermic even when the temperature stays well above freezing.**

Symptoms of hypothermia include:

*Slurred speech.

*Weakness and loss of coordination.

*Confusion.

- *Irrational behavior.
- *Uncontrollable shivering (although, at extremely low body temperatures, shivering may stop).
- *Pale and cold skin.
- *Drowsiness especially in more severe stages.
- *Slowed breathing or heart rate.

You can avoid hypothermia with the following precautions:


- *Stay hydrated.
- *Avoid fatigue.
- *Avoid cold winds.
- *Change out of wet clothes.

*Be aware of the symptoms and act immediately upon their onset.

If you recognize hypothermia, take the following steps:

- *Move the patient to shelter.
- *Remove wet clothes and replace them with warm, dry garments.
- *If the victim is alert, give them food and warm liquids to drink.

Reporting Harassment

<u>Harassment</u> is defined as any form of unwelcome, pervasive, persistent, and unsolicited verbal, non-verbal, written, or physical conduct that is objectively offensive and could alter an individual's terms and conditions of employment.

Bullying is a form of harassment made up of repeated abusive behavior that is threatening, humiliating, or intimidating. It can be direct, indirect, verbal or physical, and can be by one or more persons against another.

Many employees don't formally report harassment for a variety of reasons. They may not want to cause trouble, they may not trust management to act, or they may fear retaliation. But, if the behaviors aren't reported, they likely won't get addressed.

If you or anyone around you is being mistreated or experiencing harassment or bullying, please reach out and let someone know. If you're uncomfortable reporting to your supervisors or working with HR here on the incident, we've also got a reporting center and you can call them 7 days a week, from 0700-2300 (EST): **(844) 815-8943**.
