- Provide timely and accurate information regarding fire activity and potential smoke impacts to the communities, cooperators, and stakeholders through personal contacts, meetings, social media, and working closely with the local media outlets.

- Keep the fire South of Foresthill Road.
- Keep the fire East of Drivers Flat Road.
- Keep the fire West of Eleven Pines.



...Rain Showers Today with Isolated Thunderstorms Possible...

...Flash Flood Watch Tuesday for Potential Ash and Debris Flows from Scattered Thunderstorms...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A cold storm system will bring wetting rain through the day with the potential for isolated thunderstorms. General winds will be out of the southeast, with gusts to 15 mph over ridges. High humidity and high temperatures in the 50s to low 60s are expected. Scattered thunderstorms are possible Tuesday. Locally heavy rain with thunderstorms will bring the potential for ash and debris flows in burned areas Tuesday afternoon and evening. Periods of wet weather continue into Wednesday.

Monday Weather:

TEMPERATURES: 55-62 below 2000 feet and 53-56 2000-5000 feet.

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 80-88%...30 percent higher.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southeast 4 to 7 mph with gusts to 12 mph in the morning becoming south 5 to 10 with gusts to 15 mph in the afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light upslope through midday then up canyon 4 to 8 mph gusts to 10 mph afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1100 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 2200 feet

Monday Night: Good humidity recovery.

TEMPERATURES: 43-48...Little change.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 90-100%...15 percent higher.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southeast 4 to 9 mph with gusts to 12 through 1900, then east southeast 4 to 8 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Down canyon 4 to 7 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak inversion setting up around 2300 below 2000 feet.

OUTLOOK FOR TUESDAYWetting rain showers continue, with scattered thunderstorms in the afternoon. There is the potential for ash flows and debris flows in steep burned areas. Southwest ridgetop winds with gusts to 15 mph in the afternoon. Temperatures will be seasonably cool in the 50 to low 60s. Afternoon humidity 70-80% with night time recovery around 100%.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Cool weather continues Wednesday, with scattered showers. Highs in the mid-50s to low 60s with southwest ridge winds gusting to 12 mph. Dry and warmer weather returns by Thursday. High temperatures trend up into 70s and low 80s for the weekend, with humidity around 30% and southwest ridge winds.

SPECIFIC:

Branch III / V / XX / XXV: No fire spread anticipated with expected weather event. Heavy fuels can retain heat for rekindle potential after weather system passes.

Branch X / XV: Little to no spread anticipated, mostly smoldering. Potential for minimal fire spread between pockets of showers, especially with wind gusts. As unlikely as it sounds, potential for isolated torching still exists due to low canopy base height. A lot of heat exists in heavy fuels – this can get into timber stringers, jackpots, and isolated pockets of fuels.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Limited visibility during periods of intense rain. Cloud cover.
 Mixing height: 2,200 ft. AGL, Transport winds: SE 7 mph, Sunrise 0648, Sunset 1905.

SAFETY

Snags/trees can burn in the upper portions. Look up! Just because there is no fire in the lower trunk doesn't mean it's safe.

Mission Analysis and Engagement

- What is the mission? What is the assignment? Who do I report to?
- Are all hazards identified and made known? Potential road wash outs?
- Is additional information needed? Travel routes? Identifiable landmarks?
Confirmed command and tactical channels?
- Situational Awareness – Perception of the elements in the environment!
Comprehension of the situation and think ahead.

Be sure all elements of your SAFETY PLAN and EXTRACTION PLAN are in place prior to engagement in inclement weather.

Five Communication Responsibilities

- 1. Briefings** – All resources require and have a right to a detailed briefing. Use briefing checklist in pocket guide.
- 2. Debrief Actions** – as necessary. Use pocket guide After Action Review to stimulate discussion, provide guidance, and what can be done better.
- 3. Communicate Hazards to Others** – Be responsible with information and be receptive to information.
- 4. Acknowledge messages** – Ensure message is accurate from the sender.
- 5. Ask if you do not know** – Ask questions in unfamiliar situations. The only dumb question is the one you did not ask.

Stay Fire Focused – COVID Aware

Protection from rain and cold weather can lead to more people to congregated together in smaller areas.

- Practice good hygiene by washing hands and/or using hand sanitizer often especially when contacting common touch areas.
- If not feeling well, remove yourself from congregate areas and notify your supervisor and medical unit. Think of the mission and the team.



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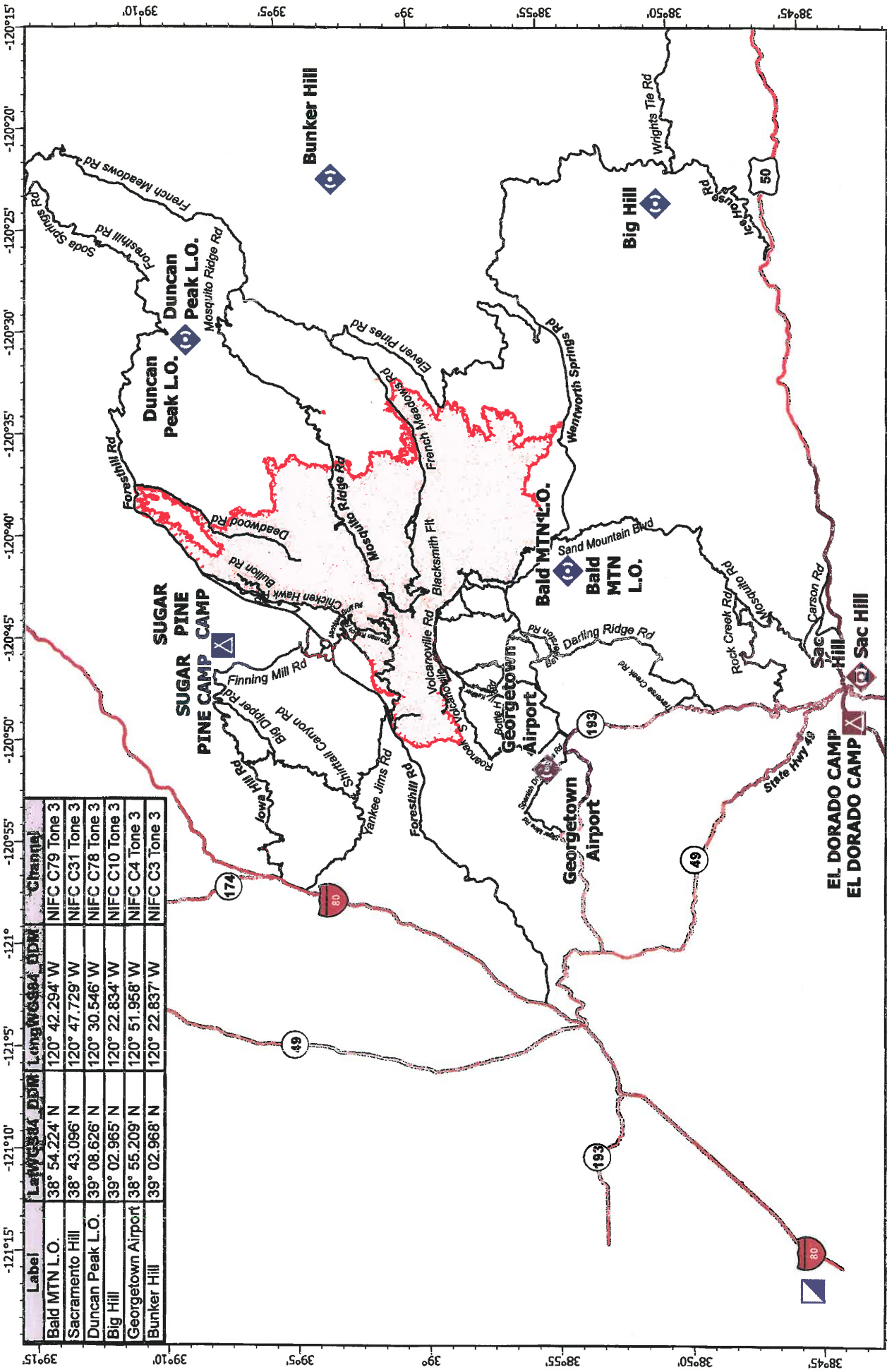

Instructions for Use of CDF 101 Property Certification of Location or Damage

Document Number: for use as a local number system or when attached to a FC-40 document.

Location / Incident Name: Enter the CDF facility property is assigned to. If submitting to an incident base, enter the Incident Name.

Incident Number: Enter the appropriate incident number

Unit: Enter the Unit the property is assigned to. If submitting to an incident base, enter the request number of the person certifying damage example E-320, C-14 or O-355.

Region: Enter the CDF Region where the property was assigned. If submitting to an incident base, enter the CDF Region responsible for the incident.

Date: Enter the date the P.L. or D. was completed.

The following items were: Enter either 'Broken', 'Left on Line', 'Damaged' or other status of the property.

Reminder, this form cannot be used in place of the STD-152 to certify Lost, Stolen, Worn Out or Damaged beyond repair property.

Date of Occurrence: Enter the date the property was broken, left on line or damaged.

Quantity: Enter the quantity for the line item.

Unit of Measure: Enter the unit of measure for the line item (example ea = each).

CDF Stock Number: Enter the PIN or stock number.

Description: Enter the description of the line item, indicate size, make, model and type. Clearly describe the item and provide adequate data to effectively identify equipment or property.

Property Number: Enter the CDF property number assigned to the line item, Capitalized or sensitive property must have their property number entered here.

Location of Items: Where is the property now (example, left on Division B night shift 8/1/04, Drop Point 2). A GPS coordinate, Station 22 or Unit Service Center may also be used to describe Location.

Remarks: Enter specific remarks here, how was the property damaged, what specifically is wrong with it.

Signature of Person Certifying Occurrence as Described:

Signature: The CDF Employee certifying the occurrence must sign.

Printed Name: Enter the printed name of the signature.

Title: Enter the title of the signature.

Date: Enter the date of the signature.

Unit Supervisors Approval:

If submitted on an incident this section must be completed by the supervisor of the property custodian. This may be the Strike Team Leader, Division Supervisor, Receiving and Distribution Manager, Supply Unit Leader, Logistics Section Chief, Agency Representative or Incident Commander.

If submitted at the home Unit this section must also be completed by the supervisor of the property custodian. This may be a Battalion or Division Chief.

Comments: Supervisors may enter comments of approval or disapproval.

Signature of Unit Administrator: Signature of Unit Supervisor reviewing the certification described.

Title: Title of the signature.

Date: Date of the signature.

Notes:

This document is NOT required if exchanging property at an incident base with the exception of capitalized or sensitive property assigned a CDF property number.

This document is required as certification when submitting an MRT to your local Service Center for replacement of property.

An OF-315 (Incident Replacement Requisition) is required as authorization to purchase fire replacement items at your local Unit. This document is required when submitting an MRT to your local Service Center for fire replacement items. A CDF-101 and/or A STD-152 are required for the certification of the status of property being requisitioned for replacement.

- Update Communications once the patient has been transported.
- Close the loop with **MEDL** at the end of shift.

"Yellow or Green" NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL PLAN:

- Contact Division / Communications and declare you have a **"Non-Emergency Medical."**
- Complete the 8-line if needed and turn it in to the medical unit at the end of the shift

Medical Incident Report

FOR A NON-EMERGENCY INCIDENT: WORK THROUGH CHAIN OF COMMAND TO REPORT AND TRANSPORT INJURED PERSONNEL AS NECESSARY.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: IDENTIFY ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER BY NAME AND POSITION AND ANNOUNCE **"MEDICAL EMERGENCY"** TO INITIATE RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS

1. CONTACT COMMUNICATIONS / DISPATCH (Verify correct frequency prior to starting report)

Ex: "Communications, Div. Alpha. Stand-by for Emergency Traffic."

2. INCIDENT STATUS: Provide incident summary (including number of patients) and command structure.

Ex: "Communications, I have a Red priority patient, unconscious, struck by a falling tree.

Requesting air ambulance to Forest Road 1 at (Lat./Long.)

"This will be the Trout Meadow Medical Incident, IC is TFLD Jones. EMT Smith is providing medical care."
