...Flash Flood Watch through Tuesday Evening for Potential Ash and Debris Flows from Heavy Rain...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A cold storm system will bring additional wetting rain showers and thunderstorms. General winds will be out of the southwest, with gusts to 12 mph over ridges. High humidity and cool temperatures in the 50s to low 60s are expected to continue. Locally heavy rain with thunderstorms will bring the potential for ash and debris flows in burned areas in the afternoon and evening. Periods of wet weather continue into Wednesday, with isolated thunderstorms possible in the afternoon.

Tuesday Weather: Mostly cloudy with showers and thunderstorms. There is the potential for ash flows and debris flows in steep burned areas from heavy rain in the afternoon.

TEMPERATURES: 56-63 below 2000 feet and 53-56 2000-5000 feet... Little change

MINIMUM HUMIDITY: 80-85%...Little change.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southeast 3 to 6 mph with gusts to 9 mph in the morning becoming southwest 4 to 8 with gusts to 12 mph in the afternoon.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Light upslope through midday then up canyon 4 to 6 mph gusts to 9 mph
In the afternoon.

INVERSION: Morning inversion lifting around 1100 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 3400 feet **LAL:** 2

Tuesday Night: Good humidity recovery. A chance of showers and thunderstorms. There is the potential for ash flows and debris flows in steep burned areas from heavy rain through the evening.

TEMPERATURES: 42-47...Little change.

MAXIMUM HUMIDITY: 90-100%...little change.

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - Southwest 4 to 8 mph with gusts to 12 through 1800, then northeast 3 to 5 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - Down canyon 4 to 9 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

OUTLOOK FOR WEDNESDAY Rain showers continue, with isolated thunderstorms possible in the afternoon. Southwest ridgetop winds 3 to 7 mph with gusts to 15 mph in the afternoon. Temperatures will be seasonably cool in the 50s to low 60s. Afternoon humidity 70-80% with night time recovery around 90%.

EXTENDED FORECAST: Dry and warmer weather returns by Thursday. High temperatures trend up into 70s and low 80s for the weekend, with humidity around 30% and southwest ridge winds. Little change expected early next week.

SPECIFIC:

Branch III / V / XX / XXV: No fire spread anticipated with expected weather event. Heavy fuels can retain heat for rekindle potential after weather system passes.

Branch X / XV: Little to no spread anticipated, mostly smoldering. Potential for minimal fire spread between pockets of showers, especially with wind gusts. As unlikely as it sounds, potential for isolated torching still exists due to low canopy base height. A lot of heat exists in heavy fuels – this can get into timber stringers, jackpots, and isolated pockets of fuels.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Limited visibility during periods of intense rain. Cloud cover.
 Mixing height: 3,400 ft. AGL, Transport winds: E 5 mph, Sunrise 0649, Sunset 1903.

SAFETY

Rocks slides and ash flow can occur, especially in chutes and drainages.

Thunderstorm Safety - IRPG Page 17

- Take shelter in a vehicle or building if possible.
- If outdoors, find a low spot away from tall trees, wire fences, utility lines and other elevated conductive objects. Make sure the place you pick is not subject to flooding.
- If in the woods, move to an area with shorter trees.
- If only isolated trees are nearby, keep your distance twice the tree height.
- If in open country, crouch low, with feet together, minimizing contact with the ground. You can use a pack to sit on, but never lie on the ground.
- If you feel your skin tingle or your hair stand on end, immediately crouch low to the ground. Make yourself the smallest possible target and minimize you contact with the ground.
- Don't group together.
- Don't stay on ridge tops, in wide open areas, or near ledges or rock outcroppings.
- Don't operate landline telephones, machinery, or electric motors.
- Don't handle metal hand tools or flammable liquids.

POWERLINES

Utility companies have re-energized powerlines in affected communities. Treat all downed powerlines as energized and make proper notifications to mitigate the hazard.

Repopulation

- Exercise caution when driving in an area where repopulation is occurring. Many residents will be stopping frequently and possibly making unannounced turns as they assess their community. Many pedestrians will be crossing streets.
- Exercise patience as traffic is increased. Do not use air horns and force your way through as it will confuse the public and could result in a reaction that could cause an accident.
- Use caution when passing cars that are parked on the side of the road. Slow down as you are representing the fire service.
- Determine routes that will not hamper evacuation of incident personnel or the public.

Back to the Basics

- 3-Points of contact when climbing out of apparatus and truck beds.
- Use handrails when stepping out of trailers or down ramps whether surface is dry or wet.
- Exercise safety and diligence when carrying tools on slippery surfaces. Anticipate where or who the tool will strike if footing is lost.
- Maintain dry feet. Blisters and foot rot are likely to occur with wet socks.
- Maintain safe following distances when traveling in group formation and allow time for a safe reaction to prevent losing traction on wet and oily surfaces.



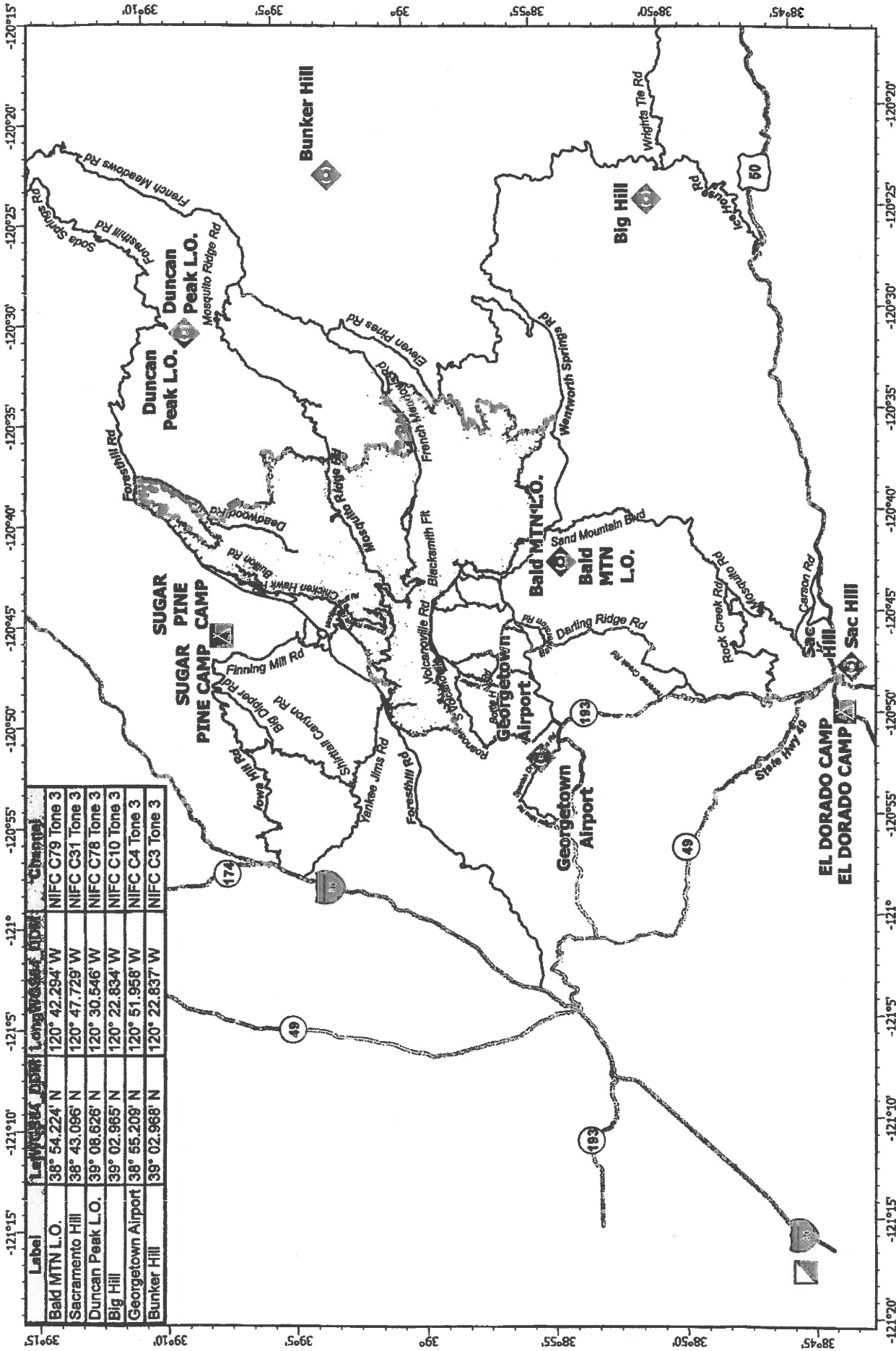

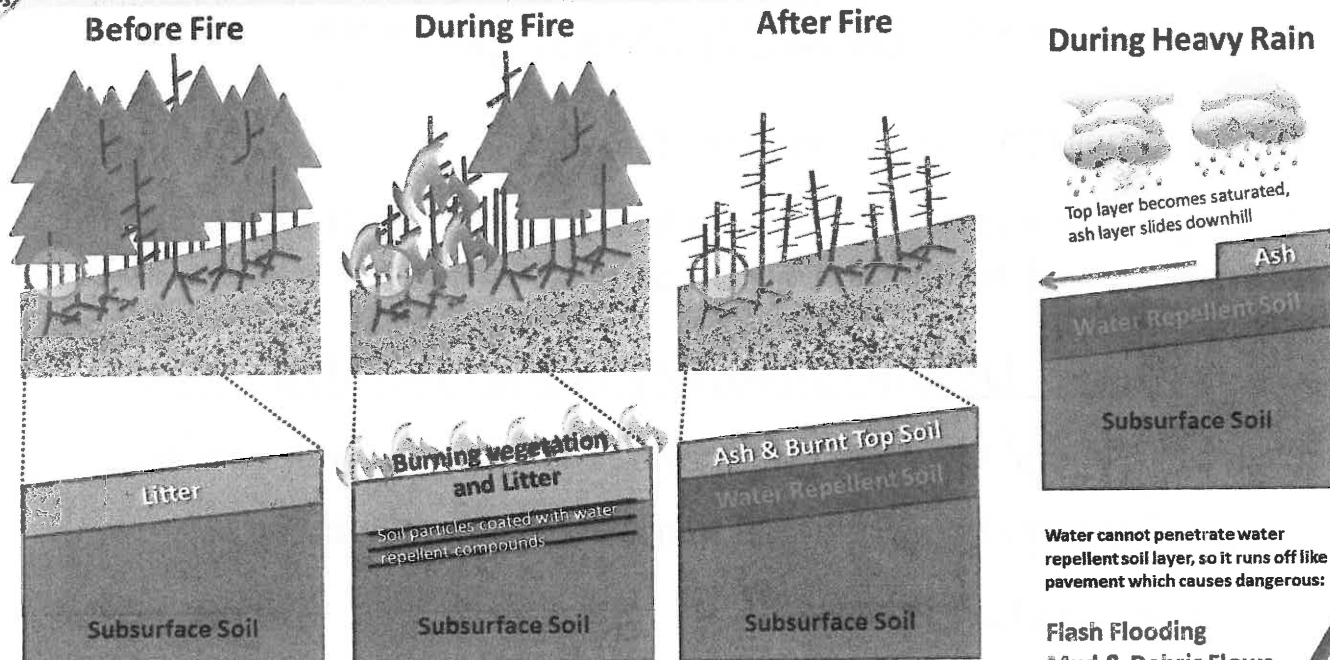

Litter: organic material such as needles, leaves, grass, brush, bark.

Water Repellent Soils: formed when organic material such as trees, scrubs, plants and litter burn at high intensity, water repellent compounds are vaporized, and condense on cooler soil layers below, which prevents soil from absorbing water.

Water cannot penetrate water repellent soil layer, so it runs off like pavement which causes dangerous:

Flash Flooding
Mud & Debris Flows
Mudslides



- You cannot outrun a debris flow, and debris flows can happen very quickly in burn areas with intense enough rainfall.
- Treat a National Weather Service “Flash Flood Watch” as a “Watch Out Situation.”
- A “Flash Flood Warning” means that flooding or debris flows are imminent.
- Intense rainfall is more important than total rainfall for triggering post-fire flooding and debris flows.
- If “Flash Flood Warning” is issued, or if intense rainfall occurs, avoid low areas where water can concentrate and avoid staging at or near watercourse crossings.
- Egress and access routes may be affected by flooding and debris flows.
