- Implement a full suppression strategy on the Mosquito Fire. Values at risk include human safety, private timberlands, communities, critical infrastructure, and associated improvements. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of firefighter safety and success.

**Leaders Intent**

Provide the highest level of customer service to all involved with or impacted by the Mosquito Fire. Ensure transparent, timely, and accurate communication at all levels of the incident; and strengthen relationships with stakeholders and cooperators. All assigned personnel shall be prepared to take appropriate action regarding:

- Personnel safety and the safety of others; including driving slowly and defensively.
- Fatigue management by maintaining work/rest cycles, taking breaks, and being fit for duty.
- Minimization of risk and exposure to infectious disease through implementation of Center of Disease Control, California Department of Public Health, and agency guidelines.
- Professional behavior, conduct, and timely/effective communication.

**Management Objectives**

- Provide for firefighter and public safety through hazard recognition and application of the risk management process.
- Coordinate suppression activities, suppression repair, and hazard tree abatement with assigned incident resource advisors to minimize impacts on natural and cultural resources.
- Provide initial attack assistance to both the Eldorado and Tahoe National Forests.





## Mosquito Fire Weather Forecast

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Today will bring together both above normal temperatures and very dry RH values. The area of high pressure over the area remains dominant and continues to dry out the airmass. Overnight recoveries last night were limited and will set the stage for RH values to once again fall towards the low teens. Winds will remain relatively light and slope-driven today. Saturday will bring very little change in temperatures or RH. Instability will increase slightly for the weekend.

**Friday Weather:** Mostly sunny and very dry. Slight increase in instability.  
**TEMPERATURES:** 85-88 below 3000 feet and 80-85 3000-5000 feet...1 degree warmer.

**MINIMUM HUMIDITY:** 12-18%...little change.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** - Northeast to southeast 4 to 8 mph through 1100, becoming southwest to west 5 to 7 with gusts to 13 mph.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Down canyon 3 to 6 through 1000, then up canyon 5 to 7mph, with gusts to 8 mph through the afternoon.

**INVERSION:** Morning inversion lifting around 1200 hours. **MIXING HEIGHT:** 6000 feet **LAL:** 1

**Friday Night:** Partly cloudy. Poor humidity recovery.

**TEMPERATURES:** 57-64...no change.

**MAXIMUM HUMIDITY:** 18-25%...Down 15 percent.

**20 FT WINDS:**

**RIDGETOP** – Southwest 5 to 7 mph through 1900, then east 4 to 6 mph overnight.

**SLOPE/VALLEY** – Up canyon 3 to 6 mph early, becoming light and variable, then becoming down canyon 4 to 7 mph at 2200.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Moderate inversion setting up overnight. **LAL:** 1

**OUTLOOK FOR SATURDAY:** Saturday will continue to see warm and dry conditions. Temperatures will once again be well into the 80s with RH values dropping to near 15% for most of the fire. As high pressure slowly weakens, instability will increase. This could allow for slightly higher gusts along the ridges in the afternoon.

**EXTENDED FORECAST:** Sunday will start a very subtle cooling and moistening trend. With a few weather systems clipping near the area, gusts along the ridges could increase some each day. By Wednesday, there are some indications winds could shift out of the E-NE with stronger speeds as an area of low pressure tries to move over the fire.

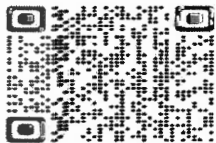

## OUTPUTS

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL AREA:** (In the event fire spots outside the line or we support a new IA) **Surface Fire activity. Expect slow to moderate rates of spread unless fire lines up with slope and wind especially in areas with continuous grass and brush, if this occurs, torching is possible. Review pocket cards to track trends and thresholds for the area.**  
Fine dead fuel moistures support fire spread, break point is FDFM <5. Rates of spread generally 1-8ch/hr. If fire gets established in an open area aligned with wind and slope, spread rates increase to 8-22ch/hr.  
Torching possible. Spotting distances will be short range less than 3/10 of a mile max (wind speed dependent).  
Fire activity continues in areas of the fire that are inaccessible as heavy fuels and duff layers continue to hold heat. Expect hot spots to show themselves in the afternoon.

### SPECIFIC:

**Branch 10:** Existing containment lines are expected to hold. Smoldering and creeping fire. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Isolated inaccessible areas still hold heat.

**Branch 25:** Smoldering and creeping fire. Containment lines expected to hold. Minimal fire spread/growth in the forecast. Isolated inaccessible areas still hold heat.

### AIR OPERATIONS:

Moderate inversion sets up overnight, light smoke settling in drainages in the AM.  
See daily weather forecast for specifics.

## SAFETY

On relatively small fires or deceptively quiet areas of large fires. (IRPG Common Denominators)  
Fire weakened timber poses overhead hazards. Stump holes will continue to hold heat.



## Health & Safety Message

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**ATV/UTV Safety:** UTV & ATV's are great fireline tools to expedite equipment and personnel movement around more remote areas of the fire, HOWEVER there are regulations that govern the operation and safety of the vehicles. Operators (drivers) must have had the appropriate level of training by their agency. Also, per Forest Service regulation:

*FS – UTV Helmet (for fire use) – must meet the policy within the Safety Handbook (6709.11), Chapter 70, 71.12; Exhibit 01 states “Specialized Equipment, such as ATVs, UTVs, Dirt Bikes, Snowmobiles (Department of Transportation-approved helmet).” **Wearing hardhats while driving or riding on a UTV is not allowed.** Forest Service policy provides no exception to the helmet requirement for low speeds, smooth travel surfaces, or administrative use. UTV Helmet (for fire use) requirements are the same as ATV use. Helmets must meet Snell, or DOT ANSI certification. A 3/4 face model meeting Snell or DOT certification is acceptable for use. Use of half “shorty” helmets requires a JHA/RA for fireline use approved by the Incident Commander or relevant Line Officer and must include justification for its use.*

# Safety Alert

August 10, 2022

**SUBJECT:** CHAIN SAW CUTS TO SWAMPERS

**AREA OF CONCERN:** Chain Saw Operations

**DISTRIBUTION:** All Agency Chain Saw Operators, Module Leaders, Fire Safety Officers, Forest Safety Managers

**DISCUSSION:** There has been a marked increase in injuries to swampers involving chain saw strikes and struck-by incidents (i.e., when the swamper is hit by the tree or parts of the tree being felled) this 2022 fire and field season.

During saw operations involving saw teams the sawyer may need to operate the chain saw in close proximity to the swamper. This presents unique safety considerations.

Each year, there are swampers who receive lacerations to their hands, arms, or legs by working too close to a running chain saw. Chain saw cuts are not simple cuts like that made by a knife; they are significant and complex wounds that happen extremely quickly. Chain saws shred flesh and can quickly remove muscles, tendons, and bone.

The sawyer and the swamper have a shared responsibility to each other's safety, as well as that of other firefighters in the area.

**MITIGATION MEASURES:** To reduce risk of injuries due to chain saw strikes, the sawyer and swamper need to be aware of and avoid the strike zone. The strike zone is a 360-degree radius around a sawyer at a distance equivalent to the sawyer's arm length plus the length of the chain saw and bar. This is a minimum, and may need to be expanded due to other factors such as fatigue, experience, etc.

During tree felling operations, the sawyer is responsible for cutting area control. This means not allowing anyone within a distance of 2 1/2 the height of the tree being felled - including the swamper.
